and broken phones.

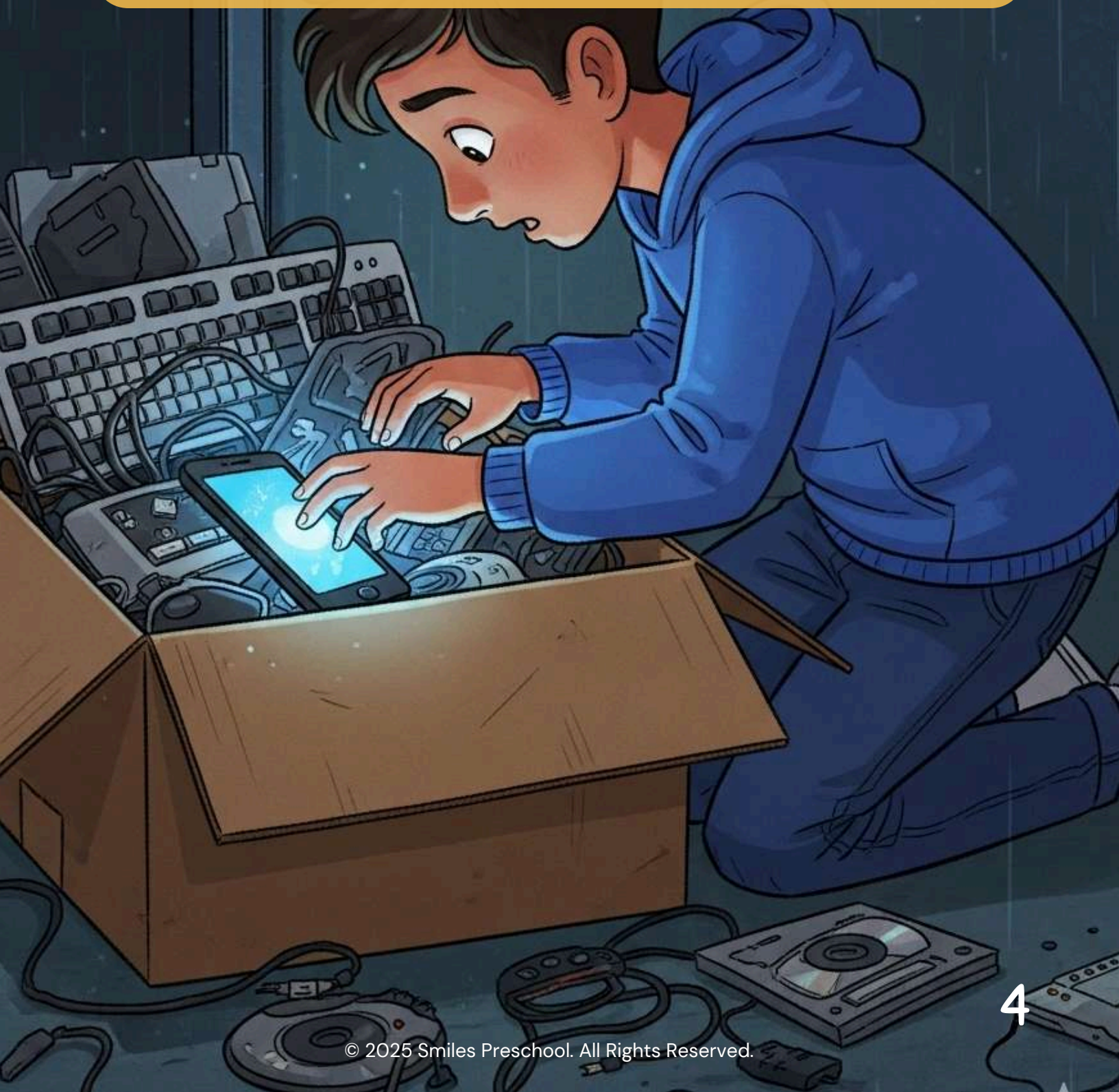
He lived with his kind uncle in

gadgets like other kids.

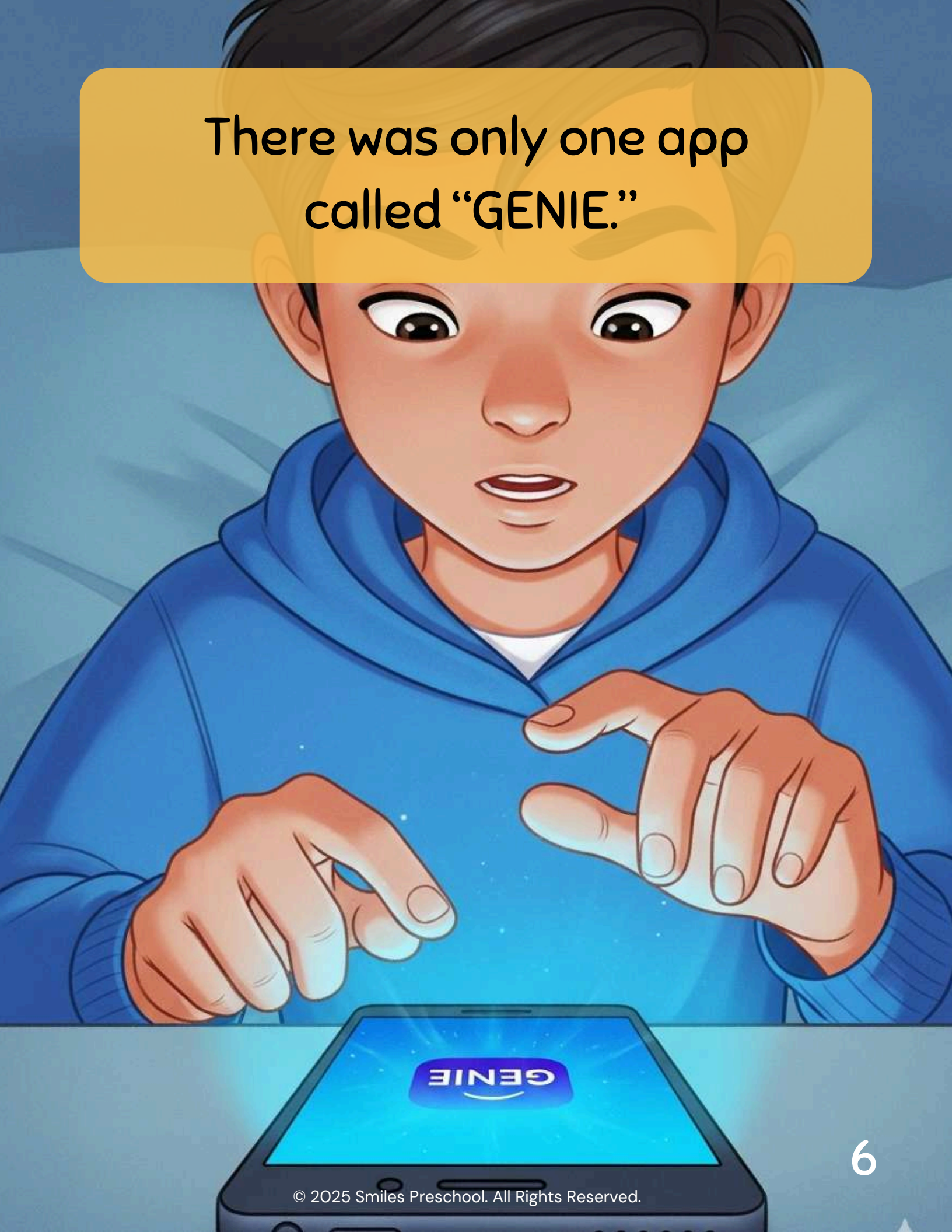
One day, he found a glowing phone in a junk box.





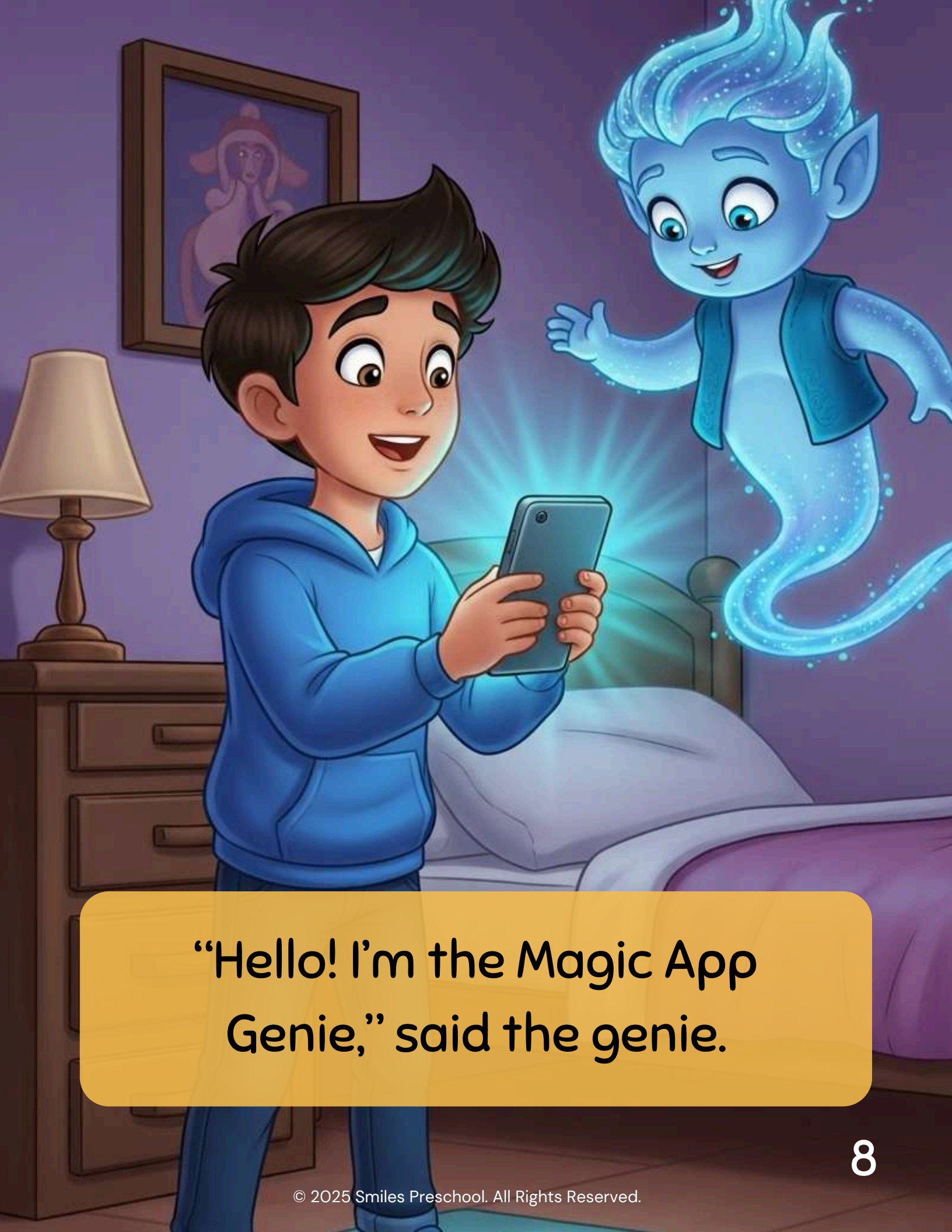
The screen turned on with a

with his new bike.




But Max said, “You’re only cool because of your stuff.”

**“I wish to be the most famous kid online!” he said.**

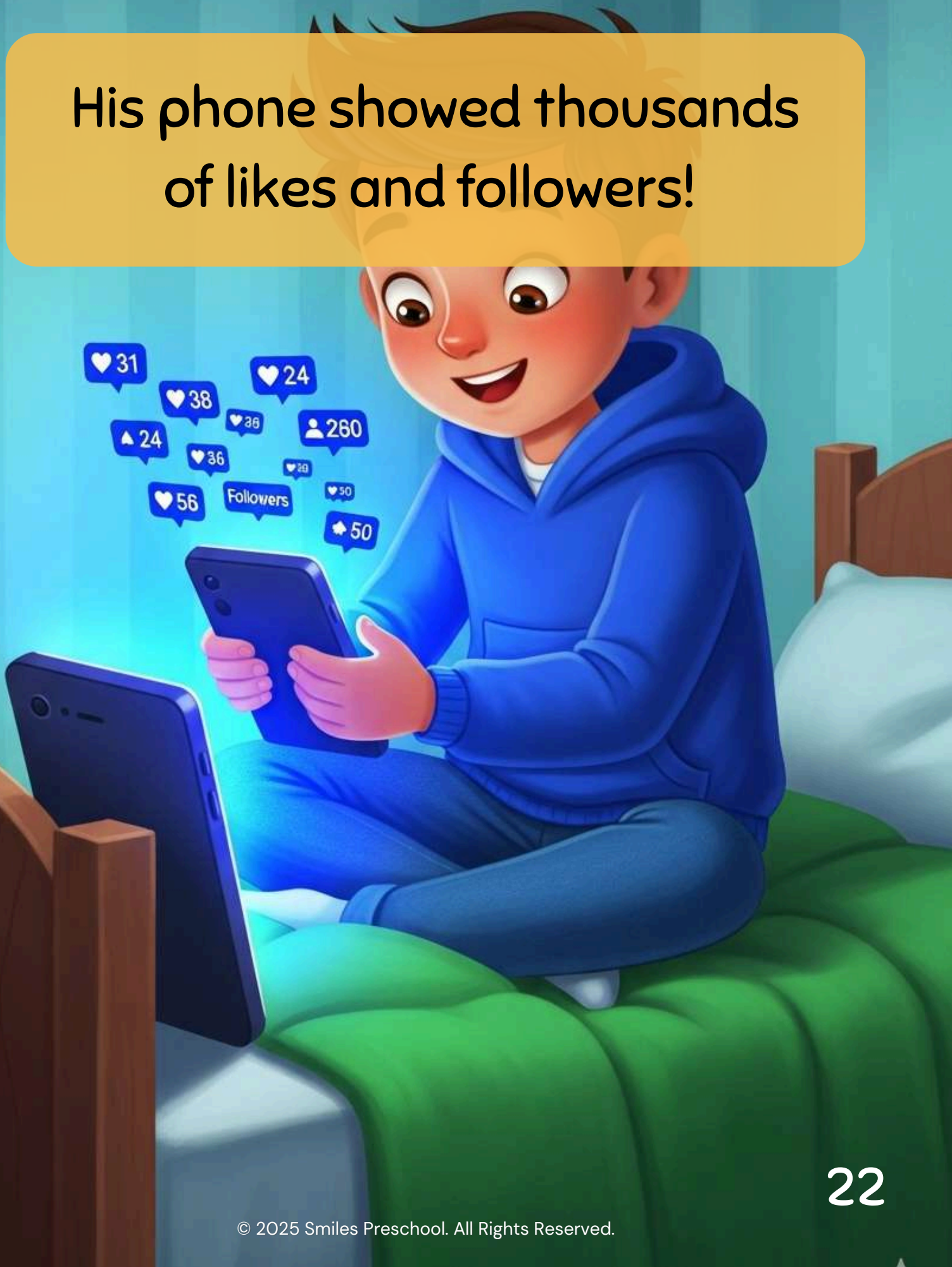


The genie turned small and warned, "Fame uses a lot of power."

His phone showed thousands of likes and followers!

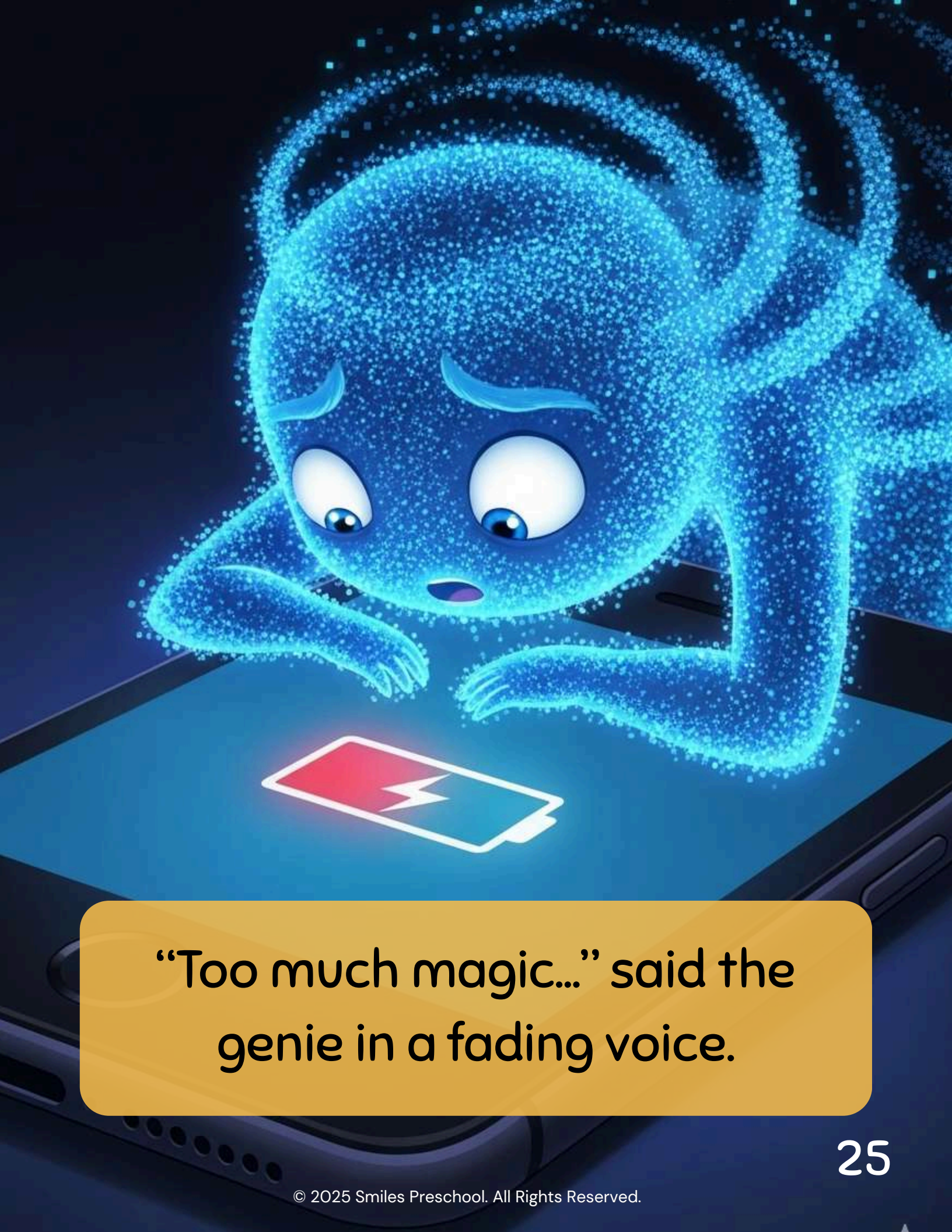




But soon, his room began to glitch like a video game.

He missed his uncle, his friends, and real laughter.

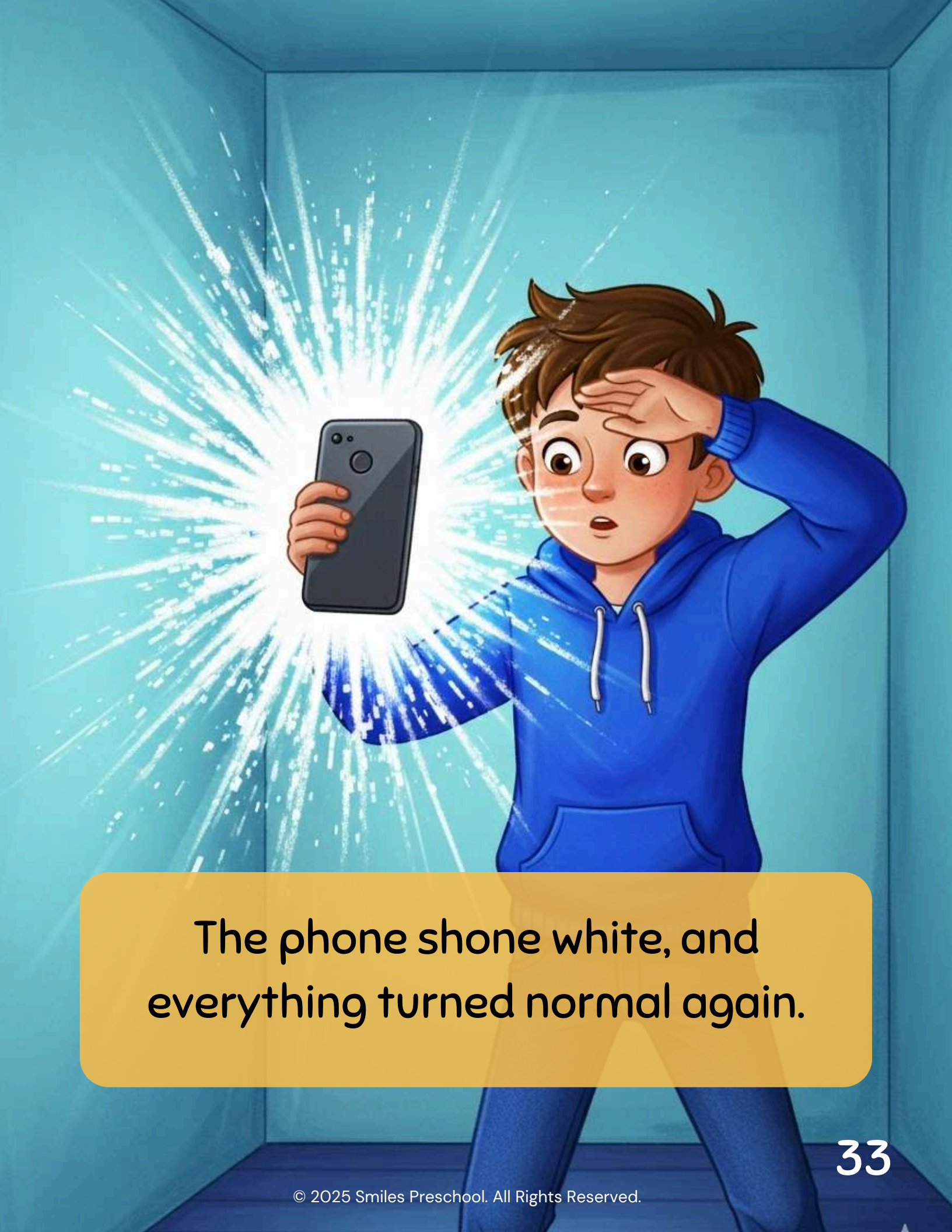


WISH

His phone blinked: “Real magic comes from you.” Aladdin smiled.



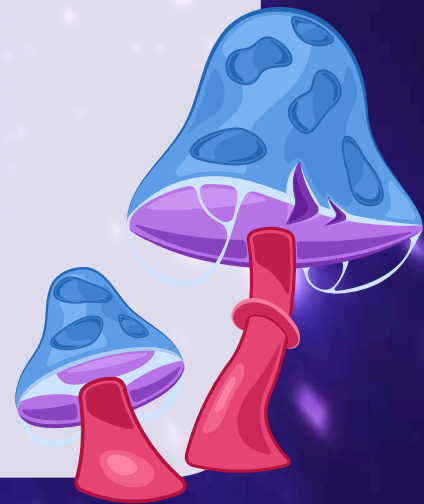
# REFLECTION
