She smiled. "Ahhh, this one is just right!"





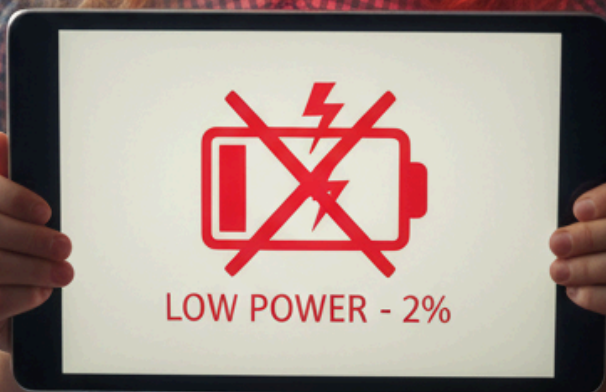
Goldilocks played the story game and learned about kindness, sharing, and taking turns.
