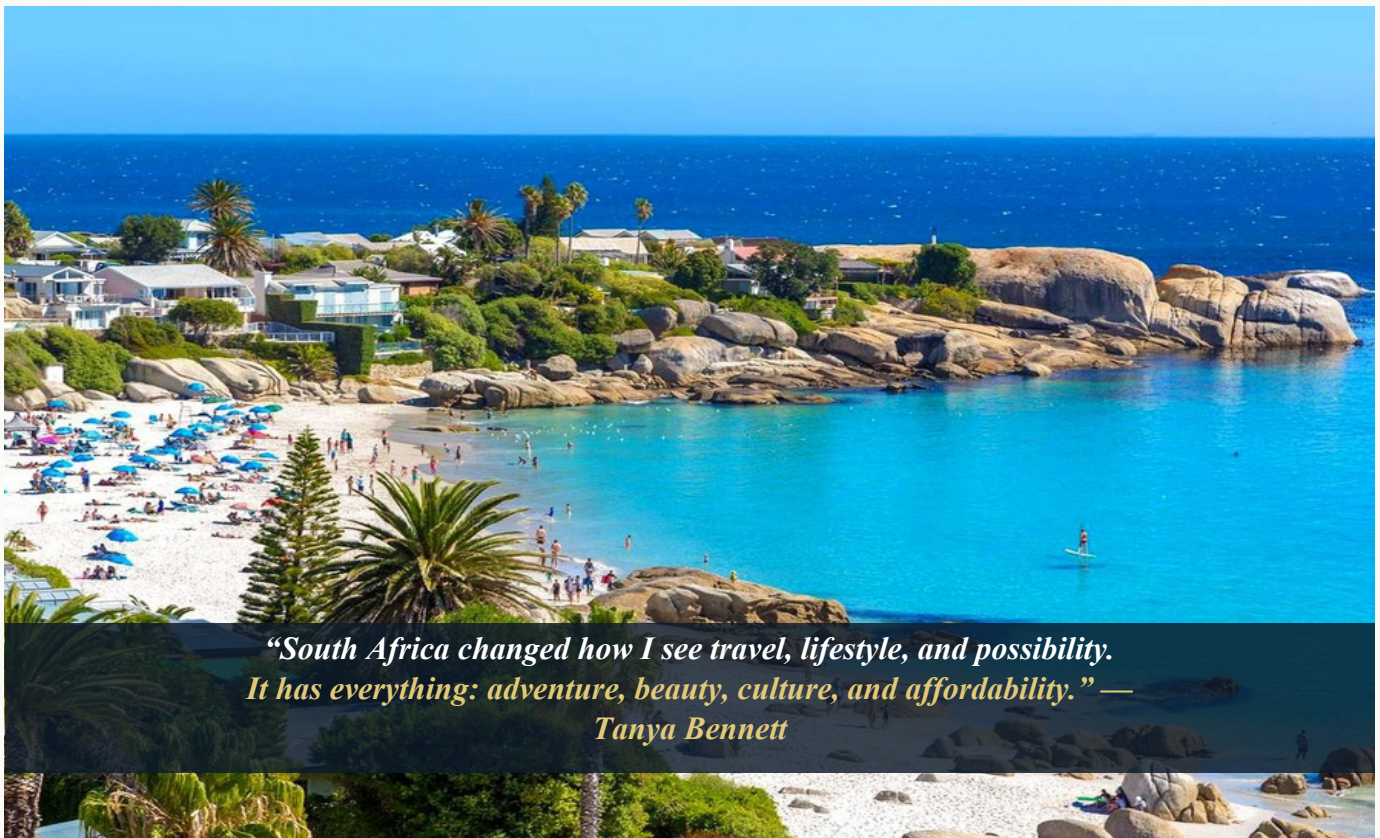
My Personal Experience

Top Places to Visit

*South Africa is vast, diverse, and endlessly captivating.
Here are the six destinations every visitor should experience.*

■ CAPE TOWN

The crown jewel of South Africa, Table Mountain, Camps Bay Beach, the V&A Waterfront, Bo-Kaap, world-class restaurants, and breathtaking coastal drives. This city alone is worth the flight.

■ KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

One of earth's great safari destinations. The Big Five roam nearly 2 million hectares of untouched wilderness. Seeing a lion at dawn or elephants at a watering hole will change you forever.

■ DURBAN

Golden beaches, warm Indian Ocean waters, and a rich cultural fusion of African and Indian heritage. Durban is laid-back, colorful, and full of incredible food and surf culture.

■ JOHANNESBURG

Living in South Africa

One of the most eye-opening discoveries for American travelers is just how far their dollar stretches in South Africa. The Rand exchange rate gives U.S. visitors extraordinary purchasing power, making luxury genuinely accessible.

Average Monthly Costs — South Africa (Major Cities)

EXPENSES	AVERAGE COST (USD)
Apartment Rent (desirable area)	\$600 – \$2,000 / month
Dinner at a Nice Restaurant	\$10 – \$25 per person
Uber Rides Around the City	\$3 – \$10 per trip
Monthly Groceries	40–60% less than the U.S.
Domestic Flight (Cape Town–JHB)	\$50 – \$120 round trip
Coffee at a Café	\$1 – \$3
Monthly Gym Membership	\$20 – \$40 / month
Private School (for families)	50–70% less than U.S.

ESSENTIAL PREPARATION

Travel Tips

A little preparation goes along way. Here are the essentials to know before you board your flight.

BEFORE YOU GO

- Passport must be valid for 6+ months beyond your travel dates
- U.S. citizens do not need a visa for stays under 90 Days
- Notify your bank and credit cards before you travel
- Purchase comprehensive travel insurance for every international trip
- Book accommodation early, peak season runs December through February

GETTING AROUND

- Uber is safe and widely available in Cape Town, Johannesburg, and Durban
- Rent a car for wine country and scenic Cape Peninsula drives
- Domestic flights are very affordable, FlySafair, Airlink, and Lift are top choices
- South Africa drives on the LEFT side of the road

WHAT TO PACK

- Universal power adapter, South Africa uses Type M 3-round-pin plugs
- Layered clothing, Cape Town weather can shift quickly from warm mornings to cool evenings
- High-SPF sunscreen, the African sun is powerful, especially in summer
- Safari-friendly neutrals like khaki, beige, or olive green for game drives and excursions
- Comfortable walking shoes for hiking, markets, and coastal sightseeing

STAY SMART. TRAVEL SAFE.

Safety Tips

With the right awareness, millions of visitors explore South Africa every year and return home with nothing but extraordinary stories. Preparation is everything.

GENERAL SAFETY

- Stay in well-reviewed, recommended neighborhoods and tourist areas
- Avoid walking alone after dark in unfamiliar parts of the city
- Use Uber rather than walking long distances at night
- Keep phones, cameras, and jewelry discreet in public
- Ask your hotel or travel advisor which areas are safe to explore
- Carry photocopies of your passport and travel documents

WHILE DRIVING

- Keep car doors locked and windows up in city areas
- Never leave valuables visible inside a parked vehicle
- Stay alert at traffic lights, called "robots" locally
- Use GPS navigation at all times in unfamiliar areas
