### The 30-Second Coach Evaluation

Can a Coach Evaluate Your Athlete—or Do They Get Skipped?

#### WHAT THIS EVALUATES

This scorecard evaluates your athlete's **Recruiting Resume**—the complete picture college coaches piece together when deciding whether to recruit your athlete. **What coaches look at (in order):** **1. Recruiting Profiles** (Hudl, FieldLevel, NCSA, BeRecruited, CaptainU, PrepHero, SportsRecruits, RecruitMe) Your athlete's recruiting resume. Coaches check stats, film, academics, measurables, and contact info here first. Different sports favor different platforms, but the function is the same: centralized recruiting information. **2. Highlight Video Quality & Access** Can they evaluate full plays, decision-making, and role? Or just see flashy clips? Under 3 minutes matters. **3. Academic & Contact Clarity** GPA, NCAA eligibility, email/phone. If coaches have to hunt for this, they move on. **4. Social Media as Discovery** (X/Twitter, Instagram) How coaches FIND athletes through hashtags, location tags, and coach follows. Not the whole process—just the entry point. **The reality:** These work TOGETHER. A great Instagram post means nothing if your recruiting profile is empty. A strong highlight video doesn't matter if coaches can't find your contact info.

**Here's the reality:** College coaches spend 15–30 seconds deciding if your athlete stays on their list or gets skipped. Not because of talent—because of **clarity**. This assessment reveals whether coaches can *evaluate* your athlete fast enough to stay interested. Answer honestly. The gaps you find are costing you opportunities.

**HOW TO USE THIS:** Circle your answers. Count how many times you selected the FIRST option (the best answer). That's your score out of 10.

#### SECTION 1: THE 5-SECOND TEST (INSTANT CLARITY)

Can a coach immediately tell WHO your athlete is and WHERE they fit?

##### 1. Position, role, and level of play instantly clear?

(Example: "6'2" Guard, Varsity Starter, 6A" vs "Plays basketball")

■ All 3 obvious   ■ 2 of 3   ■ Have to guess   ■ Missing

##### 2. Graduation year visible at first glance?

(Coaches sort by class year—if they can't find yours, you're skipped)

■ Obvious   ■ Have to search   ■ Buried somewhere   ■ Not listed

##### 3. Highlight film accessible within 1 click?

("Clicks" = how much work it takes. More clicks = more friction = less interest)

■ One click   ■ 2-3 clicks   ■ Multiple platforms   ■ Can't find it

#### 4. Basic academic info visible (GPA range or honors)?

*(Coaches need to know you're academically eligible before investing time)*

■ Upfront ■ Mentioned vaguely ■ Have to ask ■ Not listed

## SECTION 2: THE 30-SECOND TEST (EVALUABILITY)

Can a coach actually EVALUATE talent and fit—or just see highlights?

#### 5. Film shows full plays (setup, execution, result)?

*("Evaluability" = Can they see decision-making and IQ, not just made shots?)*

■ Full plays ■ Some full plays ■ Mostly highlights ■ Only highlights

#### 6. Can a coach see your athlete's ROLE and decision-making?

*(Are they a primary scorer? Facilitator? Defender? Role clarity = fit clarity)*

■ Very clear ■ Somewhat clear ■ Hard to tell ■ Can't evaluate

#### 7. Stats include context (competition level, team record, role)?

*("15 PPG, 6A playoffs, starting PG" tells a story. "15 PPG" tells nothing)*

■ Full context ■ Some context ■ Just numbers ■ No stats

#### 8. Contact info (email/phone) easy to find?

*(If coaches have to DM or search, many won't. Make it easy.)*

■ One click ■ Findable ■ DM only ■ No clear path

#### 9. Film is under 3 minutes and starts with best clips?

*(Coaches watch 20-30 seconds. Hook them fast or lose them)*

■ Yes, both ■ One of two ■ Too long or weak start ■ No film

#### 10. Growth story visible (freshman stats → current progress)?

*("Projection" = Can they see upside? Development trajectory matters)*

■ Clear trajectory ■ Some growth shown ■ Static snapshot ■ No context

### SECTION 3: COMMON REASONS COACHES MOVE ON

Even talented athletes get skipped when evaluation takes too much work.

- Too many clicks to see film or stats
- No context for stats ("15 PPG" against who? What role?)
- Highlight film doesn't show full plays or decision-making
- Can't tell position, role, or how they'd fit the system
- No clear contact path (email/phone not visible)
- Academic eligibility unclear or missing
- Everything feels generic or template-based (no personality)

**COACH BRAXTON TIP:** *I had 250+ emails a day during peak recruiting season. If I had to click 3+ times to see film, search for contact info, or guess at academic eligibility, I moved on. Not because the athlete wasn't talented—because 47 other profiles were already clear.*

# YOUR SCORE: WHAT IT MEANS

## 8-10: RECRUIT-READY

Your athlete's profile is clear and evaluable. Coaches can make decisions quickly without friction. Focus now shifts to targeting the RIGHT schools and executing consistent, personalized outreach.

**NEXT STEP:** Power 60 targeting strategy + coach communication system.

## 5-7: FIXABLE GAPS

Foundation is there, but **friction is slowing coaches down**. You're creating extra work for them—extra clicks, missing context, unclear film. That friction costs you opportunities. Film quality, clarity, or contact paths need work.

**NEXT STEP:** Recruiting profile audit + evaluability fixes.

## 2-4: REBUILD NEEDED

Coaches are **skipping your athlete**—not because of talent, but because evaluation is too hard. Missing film, buried contact info, no academic clarity. This is costing you real opportunities right now.

**NEXT STEP:** Complete profile overhaul before any outreach.

## 0-1: START HERE

Your athlete's recruiting resume isn't working yet. Coaches can't evaluate what they can't see. Before any outreach happens, you need a **recruit-ready foundation**: profile setup, film strategy, contact clarity.
