

# 14 PREGNANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

## IDEAS





Prepare his usual coffee and stick a small note under the mug that reads "You're going to be a Dad!" Serve it exactly as you always do so nothing feels suspicious. When he lifts the mug to take a sip or to set it down, he'll see the message. You can add a tiny heart or the due date on the note and keep your phone nearby to capture his reaction.



Write a sweet note—"Good morning! You're going to be a Dad!"—and place it on his pillow before he wakes up. Keep the bedroom lighting soft so the note is the first thing he notices. For an extra touch, add a tiny pair of baby socks beside the note. Enjoy the quiet, intimate moment together.



Place a tiny pair of baby shoes in the shoe drawer he opens most often. Tuck a small tag inside one shoe with the due date or "Coming Soon." When he reaches for his shoes, the mini pair will stand out and deliver the surprise. It's simple, visual, and adorable.



Put a small custom label around his water bottle that says: "Drink up, Daddy-to-Be!". Make the design simple and stick it in the exact spot where he usually holds the bottle, so he'll notice it right away when he takes a sip. It's an easy, fun idea that guarantees he won't miss the surprise.



Slide a sticky note between the keyboard keys or place one on the trackpad that reads "Loading... Baby 50%." Close the laptop gently so it stays in place. When he opens it for work, the playful message will pop up first.



Tuck a tiny note into the pocket of his favorite shirt or pants. Keep it brief—"Check the other pocket, Daddy!"—and place the main message in the second pocket for a fun two-step reveal. He'll smile as he pieces it together.





Tape a slim note to the TV remote that says "Big news... press play, Daddy!" If you want to level it up, preload a simple slideshow on the TV that shows "We're having a baby." The note will guide him to the reveal.



Change his phone wallpaper to a clean image that reads "You're going to be a Dad!" Use a neutral background so the text is obvious. Hand him his phone casually—he'll unlock it and see the news instantly.



Rename his morning alarm to "Wake up, Daddy-to-Be!" Set it for his usual wake-up time and make sure the screen shows the label when it rings. It's a gentle, private reveal that starts the day with a smile.





Slip a folded note into his wallet or work bag that says "Open me" on the outside and "We're having a baby!" inside. Choose a pocket he opens early in the day so he finds it naturally. Keep the note neat and simple, and consider adding a small ultrasound icon or doodle.



Use a dry-erase or chalk marker to write "Daddy-to-Be" on the bathroom mirror. Keep it short, bold, and centered at eye level so he spots it while brushing his teeth.



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Stick a small, readable note on the upper corner of the car's interior mirror that says "Careful... Daddy-to-Be on board!" Make sure it doesn't block visibility or distract from safe driving. Ask him to check the mirror before starting the car—he'll spot the message right away.



Hang a tiny baby onesie or shirt with the words 'You're going to be a Dad!' on the laundry line, right between the regular clothes. Keep it casual so it doesn't stand out too much. Then, ask your partner to bring in the laundry like it's just another normal day. Make sure your phone or camera is secretly recording. When he notices the little outfit among the clothes, that's the exact moment his surprise and joy will be captured forever.
