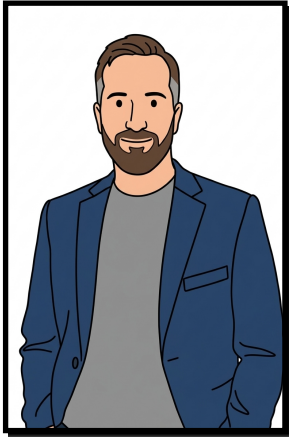

FOR PARENTS

For children 3 to 6 years old, I recommend parent coaching (or behavioral parent training*). For parents of kids 6 and older, I recommend parent coaching* and behavioral therapy*.

FOR TEENS

For teens and older kids, I recommend executive function coaching, which is rarely covered by insurance. Visit my website to learn more about how families of teens pay, which includes a sliding scale and benefits for foster families.

FOR ADULTS

For adults, I recommend executive function coaching as well. My approach is not only built on the science of applied behavior analysis, but deeply rooted in acceptance and commitment therapy.
