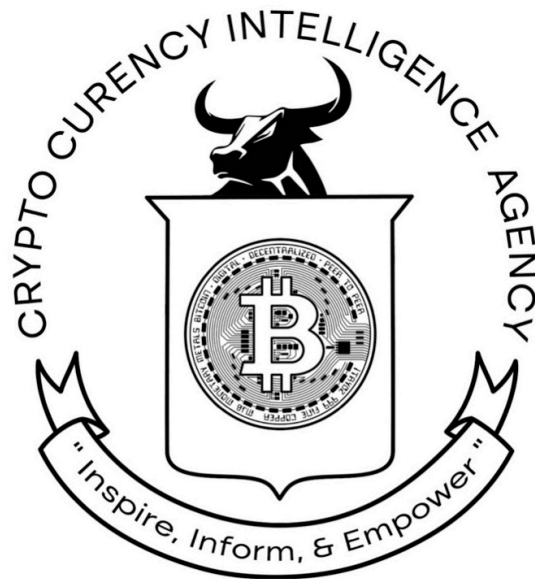

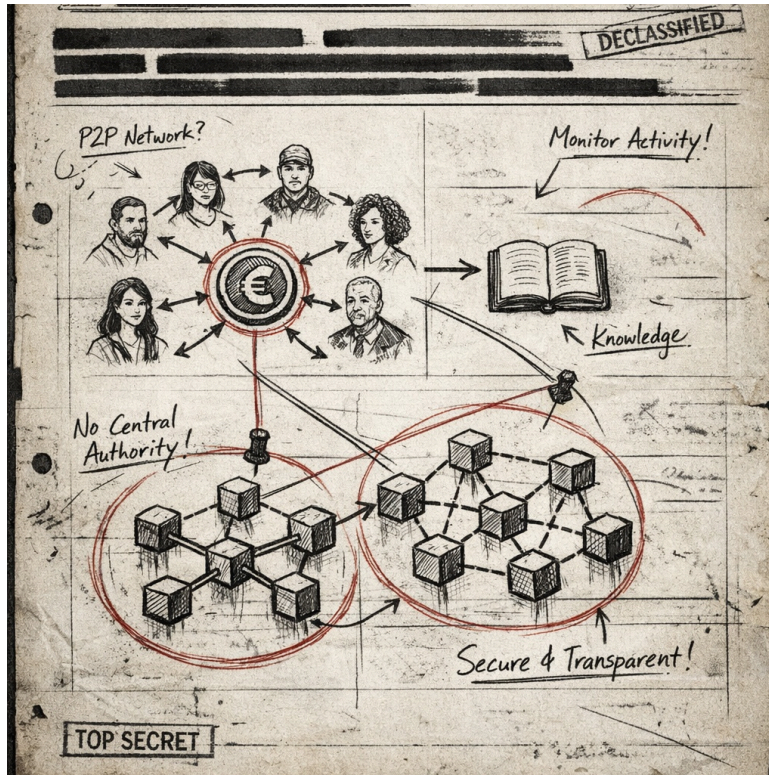

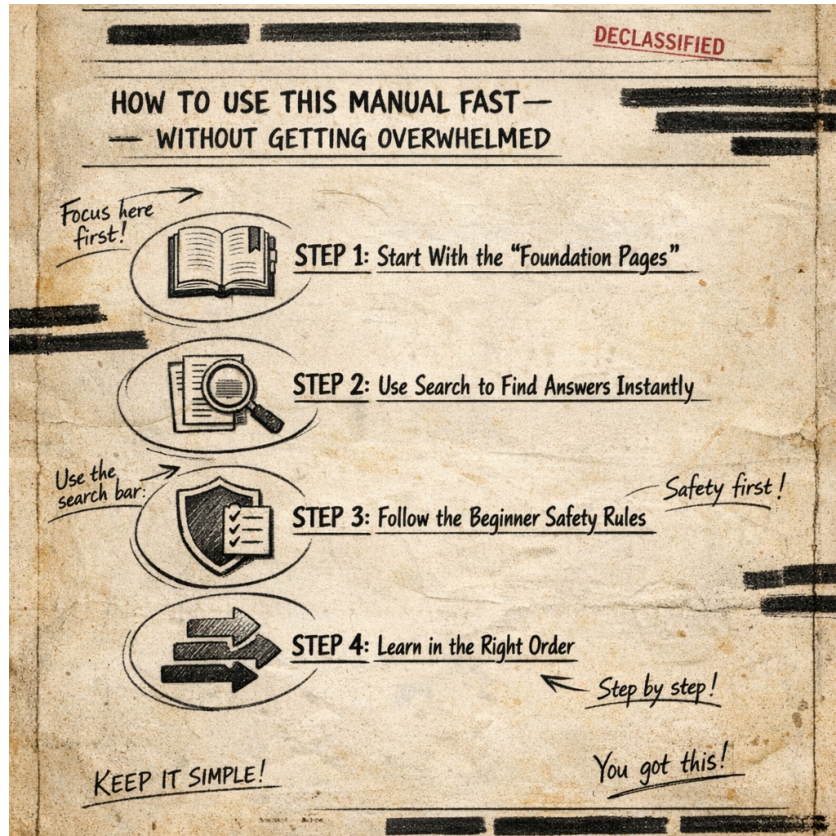

STEP 1: Start With the “Foundation Pages”

STEP 2: Use Search to Find Answers Instantly

This manual is built to be searchable.

Instead of scrolling, use the **Find/Search** feature:

On Computer

- **Windows:** Ctrl + F
- **Mac:** Command (⌘) + F

On Phone

- Tap the screen → use the **Search / Find** option (🔍)

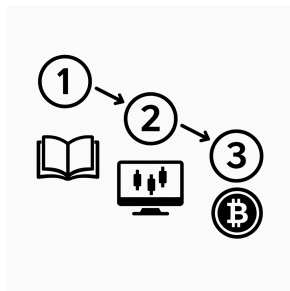


STEP 3: Follow the Beginner Safety Rules

Before buying or interacting with any token:

- Verify the **contract address**
- Confirm the **correct blockchain network**
- Avoid links from **private messages**
- Never share your **seed phrase / recovery phrase**
- Don't rush due to hype, urgency, or "limited time" claims

Reminder: Blockchain transactions are irreversible.



STEP 4: Learn in the Right Order

Crypto becomes easier when you learn it in sequence:

Wallet → Network → Token → Contract Address → Risk

If one of these is unclear, pause and search the term before moving forward.

FINAL NOTE

This manual is not meant to make you rich fast.

It is meant to make you **accurate**.

In crypto, accuracy protects you more than speed.
