All dogs are required to have updated vaccinations.

The vaccinations we require are:

- > Rabies
- > Parvovirus
- > Parainfluenza
- > Hepatitis/Adenovirus
- > Distemper
- > Bordetella (Highly recommended)

If requirements are not met then we cannot let your pet stay in our home. We also highly recommend they be on flea and tick preventatives.
