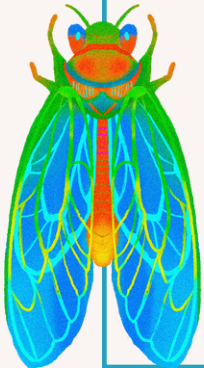



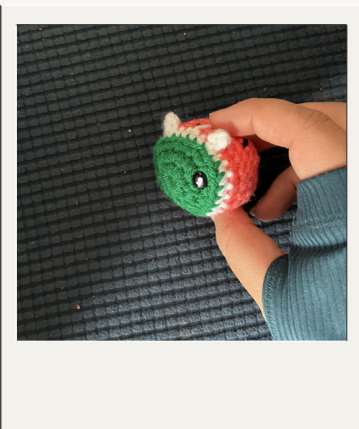

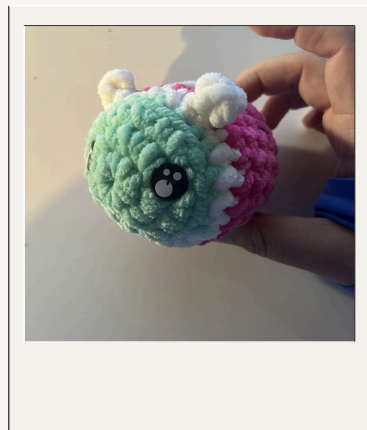

Yarn: Red Heart
Supersaver
Hook: 3.5MM



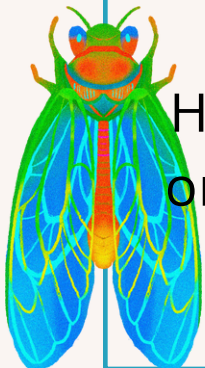
Meduim

or Posh Purl
Hook: 4.5MM



Large
Sweet Snuggles or
Demi Purl
Hook: 7MM-10MM



Hook size depends on your tension, go up
or down depending on your crochet style.



Materials

Hook: Jumbo(10MM), Medium(4.5MM),
Small(3.5MM)

Scissors & Yarn Needle

Stuffing & Safety Eyes

Stitch Marker

Yarn: Sweet Snuggle, Worsted Weight

Colors: Green, White, Pink

Abbreviations

MR-Magic Ring

SC-Single Crochet

SLST-Slip Stitch

FLO-Front Loop Only

BLO-Back Loop Only

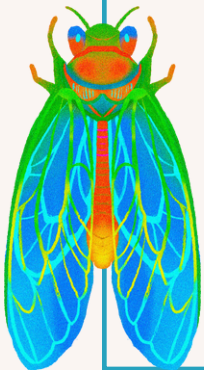
INC-Increase

INV DEC-Invisible Decrease

ST-Stitch

P-Picot (CH 3, SLST into 3rd CH from
hook, then SLST into the same ST)

CH-Chain



Start with MR,

Row 1: 8 SC in MR, (8)

Row 2: INC around, (16)

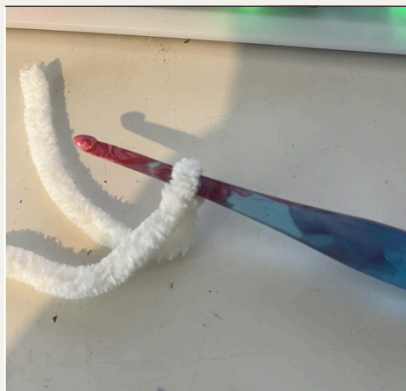
Row 3: SC, INC around, (24)

****Cut Color A(Green) and attach Color B(White)**

Join with a SC in the BLO**

Row 4: 1 SC in the BLO next 9STS (10 in total including where you joined), P, 5 SC, P, 9 SC, then SLST into first ST, (24)

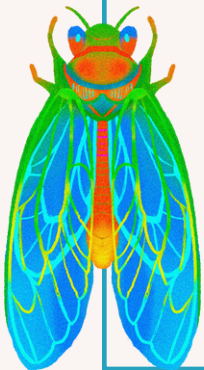
****Cut Color B(White), attach Color C(Pink) with SC****




Row 5-9: SC in each ST around, working around the P(antennas), making sure you pull them to the front, (24)

Place safety eyes between row 2&3, trying to make them even and line up with the antenna






Row 10: SC, INV DEC, repeat around, (18)

Begin to stuff your project

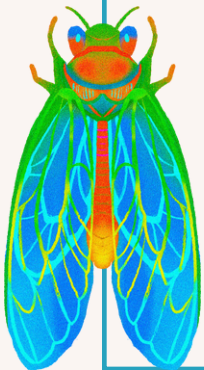
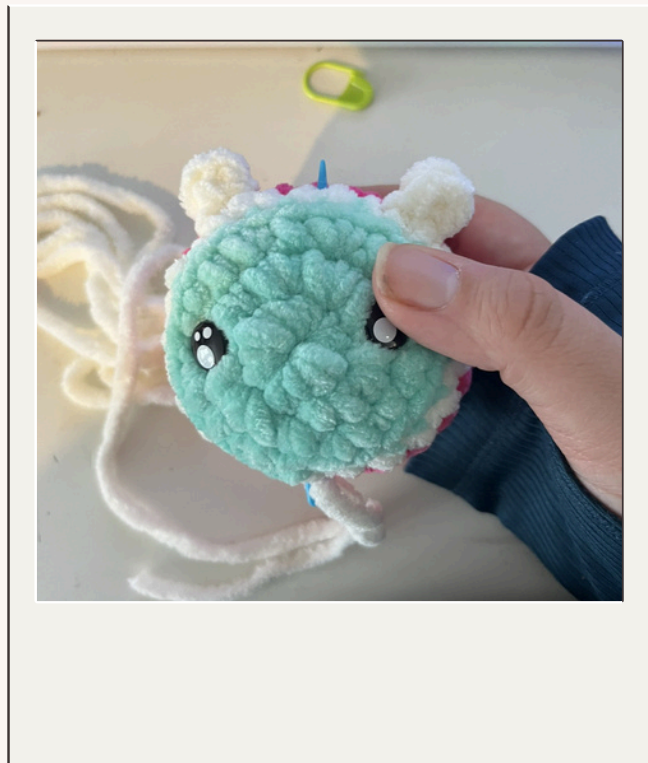
Row 11: INV DEC around, (8)

Fasten off and close hole and weave in ends



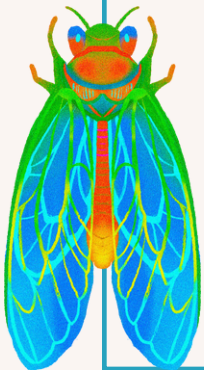
Back Details

Step 1: Grab a strand of white yarn, thread on to your needle and go through the underside in the white yarn part and come out directly above between the antenna (trying to be in the middle),



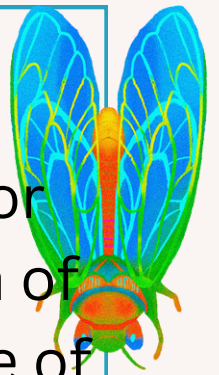
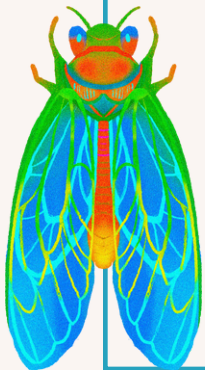
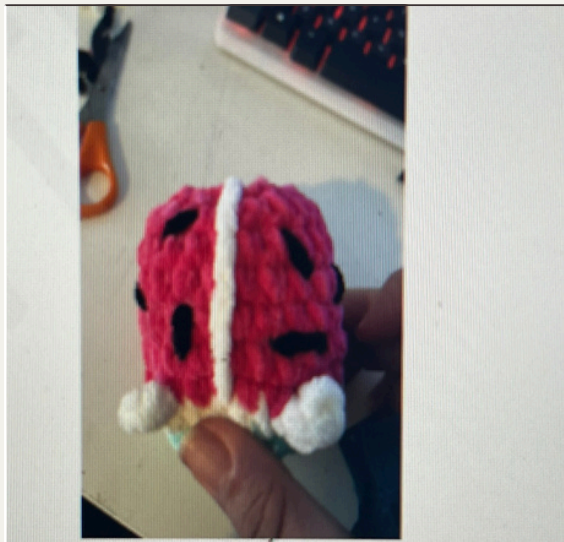
Back Details

Step 2: Now take the yarn and place down the back of the bug in the middle and put the yarn needle in the hole where you closed and make it come out where you started and tie it off in a double knot and cut the tails short and stuff inside.



Back Details

Step 3: Grab a strand of black yarn for your seeds, going through the bottom of your project and come out on one side of the white line and place your yarn needle 1 stitch away and make it come out in a different place to make your seeds, continue doing this until you have at least 3 seeds, do the same on the other side of the white line and when finishing the last seed make the yarn come out the same place you started, tie off and stuff inside.
