Materials

Hook: 4.0Mm

Scissors & Yarn Needle

Stuffing (polyfil)

Yarn: Size 4 (worsted Weight)

Color 1: Red,

Color 2: Black,

Color 3: Yellow,

Color 4: Orange

Abbreviations

SC-Single Crochet

CH-CHain

SLST-Slip Stitch

CC-Change Color

Fo-Fasten Off

Head Pieces

Face Piece: (make 1)

Start with CH 13, in Red

R1: CH 13, in 2nd Ch from hook put sc across, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R2: 12 sc in red, ch 1 & turn, (12)

- in r3 you will attach black to make the face*

R3-4: 3 sc in red, 2 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 2 sc in black, 3 sc in red, ch 1 & TURN, (12)

R5-6: 3 sc in red, 6 sc in black, 3 sc in red, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R7: 4 sc in red, 4 sc in black, 4 sc in red, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R8-10: 1 sc in red, 3 sc in black, 4 sc in red, 3 sc in black, 1 sc in red, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R11-12: 12 sc in red, ch 1 & turn, (12),

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing

Head pieces

Make X5

start with ch 13, in red only

R1: ch 13, in 2 nd ch from hook sc across, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R2-12: sc in each st across, (12)

fasten off & leave a tail for sewing

Chest panel - front piece

colors needed, black, red, yellow, orange

Start with ch 13, in black

R1: ch 13, in 2nd ch from hook in black, sc across, (12)

you will be changing colors often in the next few rows

R2: 3 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 2 sc in black, 2 sc in orange, 3 sc in black, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R3: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in yellow, 2 sc in black, 2 sc in orange,
2 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn, (12)

R4: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 2 sc in black, 2 sc in orange, 2
sc in black, 2 sc in yellow, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R5: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in yellow, 2 sc in black, 3 sc in
orange, 3 sc in red, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R6: 1 sc in black, 3 sc in red, 3 sc in orange, 2 sc in black,
2 sc in yellow, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R7: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in yellow, 2 sc in black, 3 sc in
orange, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn
(12)

R8: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in orange,
1 sc in black, 4 sc in yellow, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R9: 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in orange,
1 sc in black, 4 sc in yellow, 1 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R10: 3 sc in black, 2 sc in yellow, 2 sc in black, 2 sc in
orange, 3 sc in red, ch 1 & turn (12)

R11: 3 sc in red, 3 sc in orange, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in orange, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, ch 1 & turn (12)

R12: 5 sc in black, 1 sc in yellow, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in orange, 1 sc in black, 2 sc in red, ch 1 & turn (12)

R13: 2 sc in red, 1 sc in black, 1 sc in orange, 8 sc in black, ch 1 & turn (12)

R14: 8 sc in black, 1 sc in orange, 2 sc in black, 1 sc in red, ch 1 & turn (12)

R15: 12 sc across in black, ch 1 to fasten off

fasten off and leave a tail for sewing

Chest Panel Back Piece

Start with CH 13 in black only,

R1: Ch 13, SC across, CH 1 & turn (12)

R2-15: SC across, (12)

Fasten off and leave tail for sewing!

Chest Panel Side Pieces X2

Start with Ch 6,

R1: Ch 6, SC across, Ch 1 & turn (5)

R2 - 15: SC across Ch 1 & turn, (5)

Fasten Off and Leave tail for sewing

Chest Pieces Top and Bottom X2

Start with Ch 13,

R1: Ch 13, SC across Ch 1 & turn, (12)

R2 - 15: SC across, (12)

Fasten Off and leave tails for sewing!

Arms & Leg Pieces

Make 16

Starting with red, Ch 1 & turn at the end of
each row

R1: Ch 6, SC across, (5)

R2: SC across, finish last stitch in black (5)

R3-12: SC across, (5)

Fasten off and leave tail for sewing!

Arms & Leg Pieces

Top & Bottom

Make 4 in Red, 4 in Black

Start with Ch 6, Ch 1 & turn

R1: Sc across, (5)

R2-5: Sc across, (5)

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing!

Sewing Pieces together

Head Pieces

Sew the head pieces in the shape of a cube, along the edges, trying to stuff as a you go, while also keeping the shape of the cube in tacked. Make sure to keep the face on the front side of your project.

Arms and Legs

Sew the arms and legs the same way as the head, along the edges, while stuffing as you go keeping the shape of it looking square, trying not to over stuff,

Sewing Pieces together

Chest Pieces

Sew the chest pieces together, while keeping the front piece in line with the face, stuff as you go, while keep your shape, do not over stuff
