

Stocky Swap

Remove App Fees (Free)

Part of The \$0 Automation Stack

Replace paid inventory apps with your own real-time automation stack.

Most Shopify stores are paying \$50–\$350/month just to sync data they already own. Stocky Swap eliminates that “App Tax” and gives you full control of your order ledger.

What Stocky Swap Does

Processes line items: breaks down bulk orders into individual rows using the iterator engine.

Removes subscriptions: eliminates recurring inventory app costs.

Owned ledger: builds a clean, auditable master database in google sheets.

Server-side power: runs via webhook—zero lag, zero fragile plugins.

This is infrastructure, not another plugin.

Step 1 — The Intake (webhook)

On StackArchitect.xyz, select **Stocky Swap** and click:

[Remove App Fees \(Free\)](#)

Then:

- Log in to [Make.com](https://make.com) (Free tier works)
- Open the first module labeled **webhooks [6]**.
- Click **add** → name it **shopify hook**.
- **Copy the unique webhook url** (e.g., <https://hook.eu1.make.com/...>).
- Click **run once** at the bottom. the engine is now "waiting for data."

You've now created your private intake endpoint.

Step 2 — The Processor (Iterator)

This is the "brain" that handles orders with more than one product.

- Open the **iterator [7]** module.
- In the **array** box, paste: `{{6.line_items}}` (or map the green **line items** bubble from the webhook).
- Click **ok**. this ensures every item in a shopify cart gets its own row in your sheet.

You now control the structure.

Step 3 — The Ledger (Google Sheets)

Open a new Google Sheet and create these headers in row 1: sku, quantity, source id.

Return to make.com:

- **Open the Google Sheets [8] module and connect your account.**
- **Select your spreadsheet and sheet name.**
- **Map the purple variables (from the iterator):**
 - **sku (b):** paste `{{7.sku}}`
 - **change amount (c):** paste `-{{7.quantity}}`
 - **source id (d):** paste `{{6.id}}` (this is the green bubble from the webhook).
- **Click OK.**

Step 4 — The Shopify Bridge

in [Shopify admin](#) go to: [settings](#) → [notifications](#) → [webhooks](#)

1. **Event:** Order creation.
2. **Format:** JSON.
3. **Url:** Paste your webhook url from step 1.
4. **Save & flip the switch:** Go back to make.com and toggle scheduling → on.

You Now Own Your Inventory Sync

Orders flow directly into your private ledger.

No apps.

No recurring fees.

No subscription creep.
