Recover lost ROAS by sending real purchase data directly to Google Ads

What CAPI Shield Does

Bypasses iOS privacy restrictions and ad-blockers by sending verified purchase data directly from your server to Google Ads. No fragile browser pixels.

Expected Results:

- Recover 15–25% of previously lost conversions
 - Lower reported CPA
 - Improve ROAS accuracy
 - Enable smarter Google Ads bidding

Step 1 — Select “Fix My Ad Tracking Free

On StackArchitect.xyz, select **CAPI Shield** card or click below to open the blueprint:

- Log in to your Make.com account (Free tier works).
 - Click 'Use this Scenario' to copy it into your workspace.
 - Connect your Google Ads account.

Step 2 — Create the Import Conversion in Google Ads

- Go to Google Ads → Goals → Conversions.
 - Click 'New Conversion Action'.
 - Select Import → Other data sources or CRMs → Track conversions from clicks.
 - Name it exactly: CAPI_Shield.
 - Set value to 'Use different values for each conversion.'

Step 3 — Final Mapping in Make.com

- Select your Customer ID.
- Choose Conversion Action: CAPI_Shield.
- Map Google Click ID (gclid).
- Map Conversion Value.
- Turn Scheduling ON.

You Are Now Server-Side

Google Ads now receives verified server conversions even when browsers block pixels. Your campaigns optimize on real revenue — not partial data.

Stocky Swap

Remove App Fees for Free

Replace paid inventory apps with your own real-time automation stack.

Most Shopify stores are **paying \$50–\$350/month just to sync data they already own**. Stocky Swap eliminates that “App Tax” and gives you **full control** of your order ledger.

What Stocky Swap Does

- Syncs live Shopify order data to your private Google Sheets database
- Removes recurring inventory app subscriptions
- Gives you a clean, auditable master ledger
- Runs server-side — not dependent on fragile apps

This is infrastructure, not another plugin.

Step 1 — Click “Remove App Fees (Free)”

On StackArchitect.xyz, select the **Stocky Swap** card or click below to open the blueprint:

Then:

- Log in to Make.com (Free tier works)
- Click “Use this Scenario” to copy the automation
- Open the first module (Webhook)

- Click "Add" → Name it **Shopify Hook**
- Copy the unique Webhook URL (keep this tab open)

You've now created your private intake endpoint.

Step 2 — Build Your Master Ledger

Open a new Google Sheet. This becomes your owned inventory database.

Create these headers in Row 1:

Order Number

Item Name

SKU

Quantity

Date

Now return to Make.com:

- Open the Google Sheets module
- Connect your Google account
- Select your new spreadsheet
- Map Shopify fields to the correct columns (e.g., "Order Name" → "Order Number")

You now control the structure.

Step 3 — Connect Shopify

In Shopify Admin go to:

Settings → Notifications → Webhooks (bottom of page)

1. Click **Create Webhook**
2. Event: **Order Creation**
3. Format: **JSON**
4. URL: Paste your Webhook URL from Step 1

5. Click **Save**

Return to Make.com and flip **Scheduling → ON**

You Now Own Your Inventory Sync

Orders flow directly into your private ledger.

No inventory apps.

No recurring fees.

No subscription creep.

The Autocrat Quota Fix

Remove Execution Limits for Free

Part of **The \$0 Automation Stack** by Stack Architect

Run automations reliably without quota crashes or "Too Many Executions" failures.

If you rely on Autocrat or Google-based automations, quota errors aren't random. You're competing for shared API capacity.

This fix gives you your own lane.

What The Autocrat Quota Fix Does

- Stops "Service invoked too many times" errors
- Eliminates execution-based downtime
- Moves your workflow off public script limits
- Creates a dedicated API connection
- Stabilizes document generation at scale

This is not a workaround. It's a structural upgrade.

Step 1 — Deploy The Private API Bridge

On [Stackarchitect.xyz](https://stackarchitect.xyz) go to the **Autocrat Quota Fix** card or click below to open the blueprint:

Then:

- Log in to [Make.com](https://make.com) (Free tier works)
- Click "Use this Scenario"

- Open the Google Sheets module
- Click “Show Advanced Settings”
- You will see fields for **Client ID** and **Client Secret**
- Leave this tab open

You're now preparing the tunnel.

Step 2 — Open Your Private API Lane (Google Cloud)

Go to [Google Cloud Console](#) (free tier).

1. Create Project → Name it: **Logic Bridge**
2. Enable APIs:
 - Google Sheets API
 - Google Drive API
3. Go to **Credentials** → **Create Credentials** → **OAuth Client ID**
4. Select **Web Application**
5. Add Authorized Redirect URI:

<https://www.integromat.com/oauth/cb/google/>

This authorizes Make.com to use your dedicated API connection.

Step 3 — Activate The Bypass

1. Copy your **Client ID** and **Client Secret**
2. Paste them into the Advanced Settings in Make.com
3. Click Authorize and sign into Google

Turn Scheduling → ON

You Now Run on a Dedicated API

You are no longer sharing a public lane with thousands of other users.

No quota crashes.
No random execution failures.
No document downtime.

Your automation now runs on a private API tunnel.

Infrastructure, not guesswork.
