Watch Out For

If you just upload generic planners or slogans, you'll be buried in the noise. You need to go niche and think like the buyer. Make your product solve a very specific need in a particular business. Example: "Editable Loyalty Card Template for Independent Coffee Shops" is far better than just "Loyalty Card Template."

Pro Tip For Success

Bundle multiple items together to increase price and perceived value. For example, instead of just offering a restaurant menu, create a full pack: menu + drinks list + thank-you card + booking sign + social media post templates.

Also, try and focus on businesses with repeat product needs and low design budgets. Think: market stalls, tradespeople, salon owners, yoga teachers, Airbnb hosts.

Bottom Line

This is one of the simplest digital businesses to start. The products are small and easy to create with AI. Plus there's a hungry market of people who are willing to pay money in order to make it easier to run their businesses.

Micro Income Machine #11: AI Stock Images

Generate a Passive Income From Online Photo Libraries

What Is It?

Bottom Line

What Is It?

Examples:

- “How to Start a Side Hustle as a Carer”
- “Weight Loss Tips for Women Over 50 with Knee Problems”
- “How to Plan a Vegan Wedding on a Budget”

Pro Tip For Success

Use this 3-part filter before choosing a topic:

1. **Problem-focused** – Does it solve something urgent or emotional?
2. **Audience-specific** – Is it written for a niche group with shared needs?
3. **Outcome-driven** – Does it promise a clear result or transformation?

If you can say yes to all three, you're onto a winner.

Bottom Line

Writing an eBook might sound daunting. But this isn't about becoming the next Stephen King or J.K. Rowling. It's about creating useful, bite-sized guides that help real people fix real problems-and get paid over and over again for the value you've packaged.

AI handles the hard part. Amazon delivers the customers. You just need to press publish.

You just need a strong idea and the willingness to generate helpful content every week. As a result you can get paid for sharing information directly by your readers without the need to sell them products.

1. Create a separate Instagram and TikTok account just for comping (recommended).

- #instagiveaway

3. Search TikTok for similar hashtags:

4. Follow brands, influencers, and prize pages that regularly post comps.

5. When you see a comp, enter by doing what they ask – usually:

- Like the post
- Tag 1–3 friends

6. Keep a simple record of what you've entered

A notes app, spreadsheet or AI tracker can help.

Consistency is how you tip the odds of winning in your favour.
