4:21		And the LORD said to Moses, “When you go back to Egypt, see that you do before Pharaoh all the miracles that I have put in your power. But I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go.”	<i>The Lord will harden Pharaoh's heart</i>
7:3		¹ And the LORD said to Moses ... ² You shall speak all that I command you, and ... shall tell Pharaoh to let the people of Israel go out of his land. ³ But I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and though I multiply my signs and wonders in the land of Egypt, ⁴ Pharaoh will not listen to you. Then I will lay my hand on Egypt and bring my hosts, my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great acts of judgment.”	<i>The Lord will harden Pharaoh's heart</i>
7:13-14		¹² For each man cast down his staff, and they became serpents. But Aaron's staff swallowed up their staffs. ¹³ Still Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he would not listen to them, as the LORD had said. ¹⁴ Then the LORD said to Moses, “Pharaoh's heart is hardened; he refuses to let the people go. ¹⁵ Go to Pharaoh in the morning, as he is going out to the water....”	<i>Pharaoh's heart “was hard”</i>

#1	7:22	So Pharaoh's heart remained hardened, and he would not listen to them, as the LORD had said.	<i>Pharaoh's heart “was hard”</i>
#2	8:15	But when Pharaoh saw that there was a respite, he hardened his heart and would not listen to them, as the LORD had said.	<i>Pharaoh hardened his own heart</i>
#3	8:19	But Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he would not listen to them, as the LORD had said.	<i>Pharaoh's heart “was hard”</i>
#4	8:32	But Pharaoh hardened his heart this time also, and did not let the people go.	<i>Pharaoh hardened his own heart</i>
#5	9:7	But the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.	<i>Pharaoh's heart “was hard”</i>
#6	9:12	But the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh, and he did not listen to them, as the LORD had spoken to Moses.	<i>The Lord hardened Pharaoh's heart</i>
#7	9:34-35	³⁴ But when Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunder had ceased, he sinned yet again and hardened his heart, he and his servants. ³⁵ So the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people of Israel go, just as the LORD had spoken through Moses.	<i>Pharaoh hardened his own heart</i>

14:8		⁸ And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued the people of Israel while the people of Israel ... all Pharaoh's horses and chariots and his horsemen and his army, and overtook them encamped at the sea	<i>The Lord hardened Pharaoh's heart</i>
