Encourage him, for he shall cause Israel to inherit it.”	The LORD has said to me, ‘You shall not go over this Jordan’ ... Joshua will go over at your head, as the LORD has spoken ... ⁷ Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, “Be strong and courageous, for you shall go with this people into the land ... and you shall put them in possession of it ... ¹⁴ And the LORD said to Moses, “Behold, the days approach when you must die.
