

The Seven Signs of Jesus

John 20:30-31

³⁰ Now Jesus did many other **signs** in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;

³¹ but **these** are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

#1	Water into Wine (2:1-11)	This, the first of his signs , Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him. (2:11)
	<i>Cleansing Temple</i> (2:13-22)	Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs that he was doing. (2:23)
#2	Healing Official's Son (4:46-54)	This was now the second sign that Jesus did when he had come from Judea to Galilee. (4:54)
#3	Healing Crippled Man (5:1-15)	And a large crowd was following him, because they saw the signs that he was doing on the sick. (6:2)
#4	Feeding Five Thousand (6:1-15)	When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, "This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!" (6:14)
	<i>Walking on Water</i> (6:16-21)	
#5	Healing Blind Man (9:1-7)	Some of the Pharisees said, "This man is not from God, for he does not keep the Sabbath." But others said, "How can a man who is a sinner do such signs ?" And there was a division among them. (9:16)
#6	Raising Lazarus (11:1-44)	⁴⁵ Many of the Jews therefore, who had come with Mary and had seen what he did, believed in him, ⁴⁶ but some of them went to the Pharisees and told them what Jesus had done. ⁴⁷ So the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered the council and said, "What are we to do? For this man performs many signs . (11:45-47) The reason why the crowd went to meet him was that they heard he had done this sign . (12:18)
#7	Jesus' Resurrection (20:1-29)	¹⁸ So the Jews said to him, "What sign do you show us for doing these things?" ¹⁹ Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." (2:18-19)

Jesus' Signs Resulting in Belief

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#1	Water into Wine (2:1-11)	This, the first of his signs, Jesus did at Cana in Galilee, and manifested his glory. And his disciples believed in him . (2:11)
	<i>Cleansing Temple</i> (2:13-22)	Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs that he was doing. (2:23)
#2	Healing Official's Son (4:46-54)	⁵³ The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live." And he himself believed , and all his household. ⁵⁴ This was now the second sign that Jesus did when he had come from Judea to Galilee. (4:53)
#3	Healing Crippled Man (5:1-15)	
#4	Feeding Five Thousand (6:1-15)	When the people saw the sign that he had done, they said, "This is indeed the Prophet who is to come into the world!" (6:14)
	<i>Walking on Water</i> (6:16-21)	
#5	Healing Blind Man (9:1-7)	³⁵ Jesus heard that they had cast him out, and having found him he said, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" ³⁶ He answered, "And who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" ³⁷ Jesus said to him, "You have seen him, and it is he who is speaking to you." ³⁸ He said, "Lord, I believe ," and he worshiped him. (9:35-38)
#6	Raising Lazarus (11:1-44)	Many of the Jews therefore, who had come with Mary and had seen what he did, believed in him . (11:45) ⁹ When the large crowd of the Jews learned that Jesus was there, they came, not only on account of him but also to see Lazarus, whom he had raised from the dead. ¹⁰ So the chief priests made plans to put Lazarus to death as well, ¹¹ because on account of him many of the Jews were going away and believing in Jesus . (12:9-11)
#7	Jesus' Resurrection (20:1-29)	²⁸ You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I will come to you.' ... ²⁹ And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe . (14:28, 29) ²⁷ Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe ." ²⁸ Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God! (20:27-28)

Emphasis on BIG, Impressive Numbers or Precise Details
John 21:25

*Now there are also many other things that Jesus did.
Were every one of them to be written,
I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.*

#1	Water into Wine (2:1-11)	Now there were six stone water jars there for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. (2:6)
	<i>Cleansing Temple</i> (2:13-22)	The Jews then said, “It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?” (2:20)
#2	Healing Official’s Son (4:46-54)	⁵² So he asked them the hour when he began to get better, and they said to him, “Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.” ⁵³ The father knew that was the hour when Jesus had said to him, “Your son will live.” And he himself believed, and all his household. (4:52-53)
#3	Healing Crippled Man (5:1-15)	One man was there who had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. (5:5)
#4	Feeding Five Thousand (6:1-15)	Jesus said, “Have the people sit down.” Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, about five thousand in number. (6:10) So they gathered them up and filled twelve baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves left by those who had eaten. (6:13)
	<i>Walking on Water</i> (6:16-21)	When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. (6:19)
#5	Healing Blind Man (9:1-7)	As he passed by, he saw a man blind from birth. (9:1)
#6	Raising Lazarus (11:1-44)	Jesus said, “Take away the stone.” Martha, the sister of the dead man, said to him, “Lord, by this time there will be an odor, for he has been dead four days.” (11:39)
