A	¹¹ Therefore remember that at one time you Gentiles in the flesh, called “the uncircumcision” by what is called the circumcision, which is made in the flesh by hands	2:11
B	¹² remember that you were at that time separated from Christ,	2:12a
C	alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise,	2:12b
D	having no hope and without God in the world.	2:12c
E	¹³ But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.	2:13
F	¹⁴ For he himself is our peace,	2:14a
G	who has made us both one	2:14b
H	and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility	2:14c
H	¹⁵ by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances,	2:15a
G	that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two,	2:15b
F	so making peace, ¹⁶ and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility.	2:15c-16
E	¹⁷ And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near.	2:17

B	²⁰ built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone,	2:20
A	²¹ in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. ²² In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.	2:21-22
