Dan. 7:25	He shall speak words against the Most High, and shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and shall think to change the times and the law; and they shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.	time = 1 year, 360 days times = 2 years, 720 days half = ½ year, 180 days 1,260 days
Dan. 8:13b-14	“For how long is the vision concerning the regular burnt offering, the transgression that makes desolate, and the giving over of the sanctuary and host to be trampled underfoot?” 14 And he said to me, “For 2,300 evenings and mornings. Then the sanctuary shall be restored to its rightful state.”	From the appointment of Menelaus as high priest [171 BC] to the rededication of the temple under Judah Maccabee [164] = 1,150 morning sacrifices and 1,150 evening sacrifices
Dan. 9:27	And he shall make a strong covenant with many for one week, and for half of the week he shall put an end to sacrifice and offering.	1 week = 7 years ½ week = 3.5 years = 1,260 days
Dan. 12:6b-7	“How long shall it be till the end of these wonders?” 7 ... it would be for a time, times, and half a time, and that when the shattering of the power of the holy people comes to an end all these things would be finished.	1,260 days
Dan. 12:11	And from the time that the regular burnt offering is taken away and the abomination that makes desolate is set up, there shall be 1,290 days.	30 additional days: perhaps including the judgment of the nations after Christ’s return? (Matt. 25:31-46)
Dan. 12:12	Blessed is he who waits and arrives at the 1,335 days.	Another 45 days: establishing the Messianic kingdom?
Tribulation Timing in Revelation		
Rev. 11:1-3	Then I was given a measuring rod like a staff, and I was told, “Rise and measure the temple of God and the altar and those who worship there, 2 but do not measure the court outside the temple; leave that out, for it is given over to the nations, and they will trample the holy city for forty-two months. 3 And I will grant authority to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.”	42 months = 12 + 12 + 12 + 6 1yr 1yr 1yr ½yr 3.5 years = 1,260 days
Rev. 12:4b-6	And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she bore her child he might devour it. 5 She gave birth to a male child, one who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, but her child was caught up to God and to his throne, 6 and the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, in which she is to be nourished for 1,260 days.
