Revelation 6		Matthew 24	Mark 13 Luke 21
1 st	And I looked, and behold, a white horse! And its rider had a bow, and a crown was given to him, and he came out conquering, and to conquer. (6:2)	For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray. (24:5)	Mark 13:6 Luke 21:8
2 nd	And out came another horse, bright red. Its rider was permitted to take peace from the earth, so that people should slay one another, and he was given a great sword. (6:4)	⁶ And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. ⁷ For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom... (24:6-7a)	Mark 13:7-8a Luke 21:9-10
3 rd	And I looked, and behold, a black horse! And its rider had a pair of scales in his hand. ⁶ And I heard what seemed to be a voice in the midst of the four living creatures, saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius, and do not harm the oil and wine!" (6:5-6)		
4 th	And I looked, and behold, a pale horse! And its rider's name was Death, and Hades followed him. And they were given authority over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by wild beasts of the earth. (6:8)	...and there will be famines (24:7b)	Mark 13:8c There will ... famines and pestilences. (Luke 21:11b)
5 th	⁹ When he opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the witness they had borne. ¹⁰ They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" (6:9-10)	Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake. (24:9)	Mark 13:9-13 Luke 21:12-17
6 th	¹² When he opened the sixth seal, I looked, and behold, there was a great earthquake, and the sun became black as sackcloth, the full moon became like blood, ¹³ and the stars of the sky fell to the earth as the fig tree sheds its winter fruit when shaken by a gale. ¹⁴ The sky vanished like a scroll that is being rolled up, and every mountain and island was removed from its place. (6:12-17)	...and earthquakes in various places. (24:7) Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (24:29)	Mark 13:8b Luke 21:11a And there will be terrors and great signs from heaven. (Luke 21:11c) Mark 13:24-25 Luke 21:25-26
