“The first angel blew his trumpet, and there followed hail and fire, mixed with blood, and these were thrown upon the earth. And a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.” (8:7)	#1	“The first angel went and poured out his bowl on the earth, and harmful and painful sores came upon the people who bore the mark of the beast and worshiped its image.” (16:2)
“The second angel blew his trumpet, and something like a great mountain, burning with fire, was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood. ⁹ A third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.” (8:8b-9)	#2	“The second angel poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became like the blood of a corpse, and every living thing died that was in the sea.” (16:3)
“The third angel blew his trumpet, and a great star fell from heaven, blazing like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water ... A third of the waters became wormwood, and many people died from the water, because it had been made bitter.” (8:10, 11)	#3	“The third angel poured out his bowl into the rivers and the springs of water, and they became blood.” (16:4)
“The fourth angel blew his trumpet, and a third of the sun was struck, and a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of their light might be darkened, and a third of the day might be kept from shining, and likewise a third of the night.” (8:12)	#4	“The fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and it was allowed to scorch people with fire.” (16:8)
“ ¹ And the fifth angel blew his trumpet, and I saw a star fallen from heaven to earth, and he was given the key to the shaft of the bottomless pit ... from the shaft rose smoke ... and the sun and the air were darkened with the smoke... ³ Then from the smoke came locusts on the earth ... ⁵ They were allowed to torment them for five months, but not to kill them” (9:1-3, 5)	#5	“The fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness.” (16:10)
“ ¹³ Then the sixth angel blew his trumpet, and I heard a voice ... “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.” ¹⁵ So the four angels ... were released to kill a third of mankind. ¹⁶ The number of mounted troops was twice ten thousand times ten thousand” (9:13-16)	#6	“ ¹² The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, to prepare the way for the kings from the east. ¹³ ...three unclean spirits... ¹⁴ ...who go abroad to the kings of the whole world, to assemble them for battle on the great day of God the Almighty... ¹⁶ And they assembled them at the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon.” (16:12-14, 16)
¹⁵ Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord” ... ¹⁹ Then God’s temple in heaven was opened ... There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail. (11:15, 19)	#7	¹⁷ The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple, from the throne, saying, “It is done!” ¹⁸ And there were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, and a great earthquake ... ²¹ And great hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, fell from heaven on people (16:17-18, 21)
