Genesis 1—3	Revelation 20—22
In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. (1:1)	Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth (21:1)
And God made the two great lights—the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night (1:16)	And the city has no need of sun or moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and its lamp is the Lamb. (21:23)
God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. (1:5)	and there will be no night there (21:24; cf. 22:5)
A river flowed out of Eden to water the garden (2:10)	Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life ... flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb ² through the middle of the street of the city (22:1)
¹⁰ A river ... divided and became four rivers. ¹¹ The name of the first is the Pishon. It ... flowed ... where there is gold. ¹² And ... bdellium and onyx stone are there. (2:10-12)	¹⁹ The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with every kind of jewel ... ²⁰ onyx ... and the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass. (21:19-21)
The tree of life was in the midst of the garden (2:9)	on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit (22:2)
Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, “Did God actually say...?” (3:1)	and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire (20:10)
they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day ... the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden (3:8)	Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (21:3)
in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die (2:17)	death shall be no more (21:4)
I will surely multiply your pain in childbearing (3:16)	neither shall there be ... pain anymore (21:4)
to guard the way to the tree of life. (3:24)	they may have the right to the tree of life (22:14)
cursed is the ground because of you (3:17)	No longer will there be anything accursed (22:3)
He drove out the man ... east of the garden of Eden (3:24)	They will see his face (22:4)
he placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way (3:24)	its gates will never be shut by day (21:25)
subdue [the earth], and have dominion over ... every living thing that moves on the earth (1:28)	and they will reign forever and ever (22:5)
