



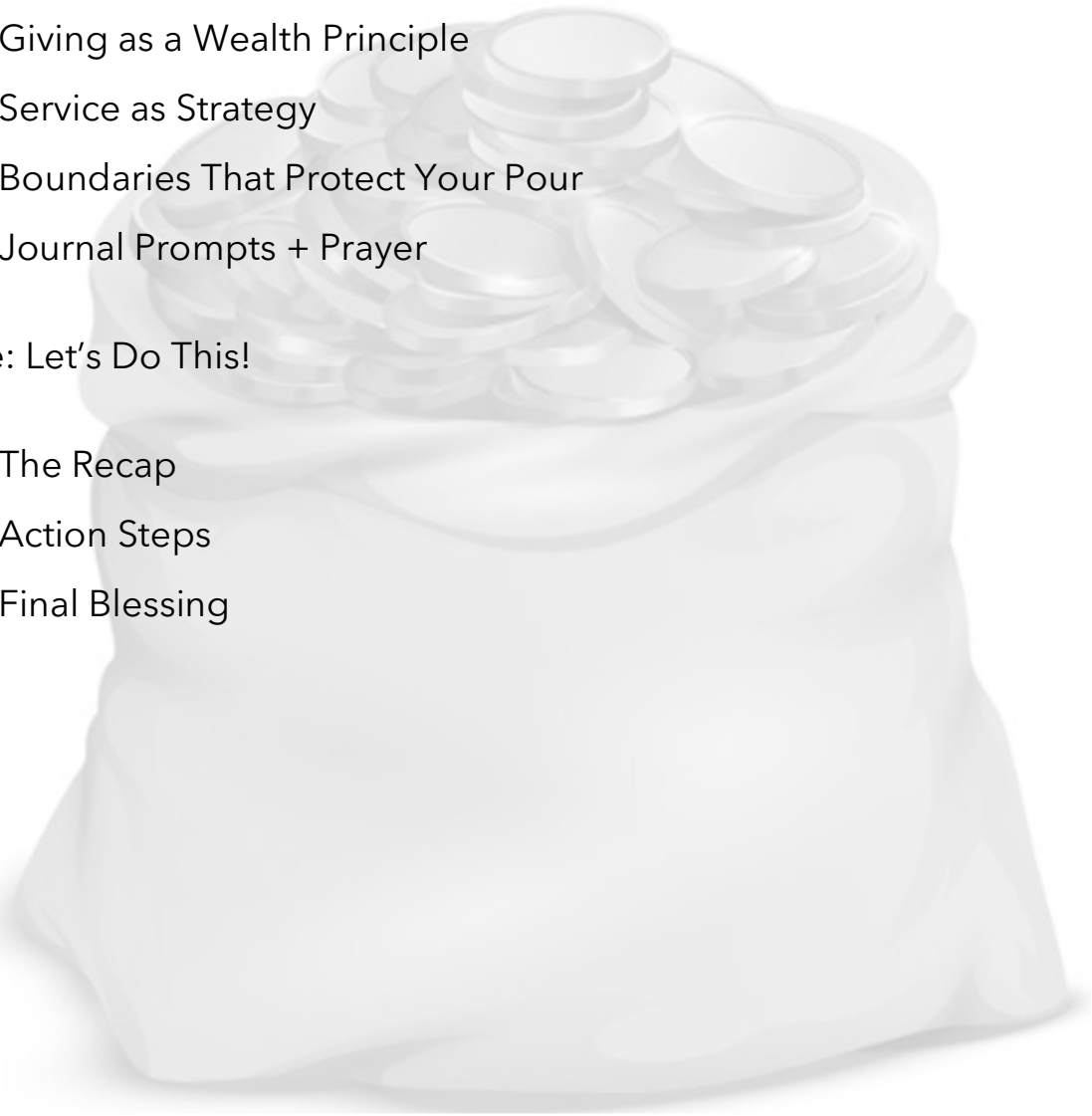

# CHAPTER 1:



## My Why

The Reason I'm Writing To You...is because one thing many of us know about money is that it's absolutely necessary to have. We know we can't eat without money. We can't get around town, back and forth to work without money. We can't live in a sheltered space of our choosing without money. We won't have adequate healthcare without some form of financial provision. The list goes on and on. By profession, I'm an educator and by calling... an ordained minister and Christian Life Coach with a five-fold ministry.

Growing up, I never had examples in front of me that showed me I could run my own business or businesses. Even the church taught the LOVE of money was the root of all evil. The old adage of: "do good in school, get into college, keep your grades up, graduate, land a great job with benefits and stay to retirement" was all I had seen. So, I followed the blueprint, somewhat. I saw myself slipping a bit early on in high school and made a major shift from sophomore through senior years. I graduated with magnet honors in science and was set on becoming a

physician. I even applied to the colleges of my choice as a pre-med student. Girl, I was ready! I began college fresh out of high school, one month after graduation to be exact. Being in another city, I enjoyed the freedom but was caught up in young adult Greek Life... "Team No Sleep". Unsurprisingly, my grades began to sink like "The Titanic". Being reared by a family of educators and college graduates, which did not sit well and I had to return home. My folks were NOT having it at all. Once I returned, I jumped right into school. About a year after I "began again", I decided to join the United States Marine Corps. Yes...it was in the middle of my college experience. Why? Because it was a challenge. I hated being told that I wasn't good enough or that I couldn't do something. I always wanted to be the one to shut up the naysayers and felt that I was meant to be a member of the armed forces. Unfortunately, I got injured during basic training in Parris Island, SC. and had to leave boot camp.

Fast forward to months after bootcamp, I continued college. Honey, I got married and had my daughter a little over a year after going back to school. Life was moving fast. This time, I changed my major from pre-med to sociology. I had a professor that knew I had a love for medicine, education and counseling. He pulled me to the side to explain to me the many facets of the major and I was sold! What I didn't know (which did hurt me) was that I couldn't really use that degree without obtaining another. As years have gone on...now it requires another advanced degree to earn a lifestyle changing income from a social science degree. I did go on to receive a Masters in Secondary Education, but I still didn't feel I had obtained enough...enough to feel seen as a true professional in the field and validated in my career.

As life would have it, years passed and the unexpected happened. The marriage came to an end after almost 17 years. The energy it took to sustain the little that was left in the latter years was depleting me. However, moving forward, still going after my purpose was nonnegotiable. I knew I owed it to my three children, to those that poured into my life to ensure that I would one day walk in fruitfulness and abundance. I knew God had a plan for my life. I gave myself time to heal, grew closer to the Lord and was back at it trying to shape my career with

the degrees I had now acquired. However, I could never get out of the \$25K bracket. Sis...that right there was an ego killer for real. I wrestled with how "*college educated me*" couldn't find work because I was considered overqualified, but when something came along, it was paying little to nothing. I had to *SERIOUSLY* budget. My ex-husband was not reliable for additional support with the children, and I knew I needed something more. I used to be angry at times that I depended on his help at one time, angry that I didn't feel accomplished enough to stand alone and provide for myself and the children. I hated the fact that I felt stuck in the places where I taught because I was barely making it. Although I loved my students like my own babies and knew I was needed there, I felt like a liar. I felt like a liar for pushing education on them knowing that it would take more than a good traditional education to set you up for long term success. It is absolutely true that education adds value, but there are certainly other ways to acquire financial success. Kingdom Principles.

Over the years, I've noticed how there are so many people that have followed "the old school blueprint" for success and end up working "check to check" (struggling to cover basic financial needs), a log of payment arrangements and as a single parent... children's financial needs can make a savings account seem close to nothing. There's always, physicals, sports fees, uniform equipment fees, money to attend the games to support your child, money for clothes and food as they constantly grow, classroom donations for supplies, before and/or after school care because you have to work long hours AND so on.

IF YOU ARE READING THIS, ITS BECAUSE YOU ARE TIRED JUST LIKE I WAS TIRED. I was tired of trying to understand how "sophisticated and well-rounded me" with a bachelors degree, a masters and a doctorate...was still renting, still pinching pennies, still not living the life of abundance that God promised His children. After one too many threats of eviction, a repossession and a "life support" credit score from a 750... to 400s. I woke up and decided I would never be broke another day in my life. I shifted my thinking, only allowing positive life-speaking people into my space. I began asking God to show me the gifts He had placed down on the inside of me to bring my family wealth. I began asking myself "if my

Heavenly Father owns the cattle of a 1000 hills" ...why am I always acting so broke?

Somehow I can't help but think that so many churches miss a golden opportunity to teach about God's expectation for a life of abundance as oppose to placing such an emphasis on not preaching "the LOVE" of money. The temple that was built in the Bible wasn't cheap, the Kings and Queens lived abundant lives and were wealthy enough to provide for others. God's word says that we're lenders and not borrowers right? So girl, how can you lend without the financial resources? Every good thing comes from above and the fact that we're here today with another opportunity to reinvent us the way God intended is more than a blessing.

This book is going to teach you five Kingdom principles about wealth that will change your life. You might feel like you're working with crumbs, but baby, God does BIG things with a little!" Walking into God's purpose, we soon learn that this isn't just about cash—it's about purpose, stewardship, and obedience.

## Chapter 3:

### Intellectual Property - Use What You Have

## Chapter 4:

Faith comes by hearing (Romans 10:17), but so does fear.

You can't binge fear-based content all day and expect to operate in faith. You can't gossip about people behind their back and then expect God to trust you with a platform.

It's time to grow up your words and guard your gates.

### Set Boundaries With Your Mouth

Yes, even in your relationships. Especially in your relationships.

- Speak life over your family, even if they don't get your vision.
- Don't curse your job or your business—speak purpose into it.

- Don't drag yourself with "I'm so lazy," "I'm dumb," or "I can't."

#### Write the Vision—For Real, Not Just in Your Notes App

Let's be clear: it's not enough to think about the vision.

God said in Habakkuk 2:2, "Write the vision and make it plain..."—and He meant that. That dream that keeps showing up in your spirit? That's not just cute imagination. That's divine instruction.

Write it down, sis. Journal it. Type it. Sticky note it on your bathroom mirror if you have to.

Because when life gets loud—and trust me, it will—you'll need a visual reminder of why you started.

## Focus Is a Weapon

When you remember your “why,” it becomes easier to say:

- “Nope, not today, distraction.”
- “No, I can’t go out. I’m working on my dream.”

- Time-blocking – assign certain hours to tasks or projects.

"Does this help or hurt my purpose?"

If it's not serving your calling, it's just noise.

### Quick Prayer to Stay Focused

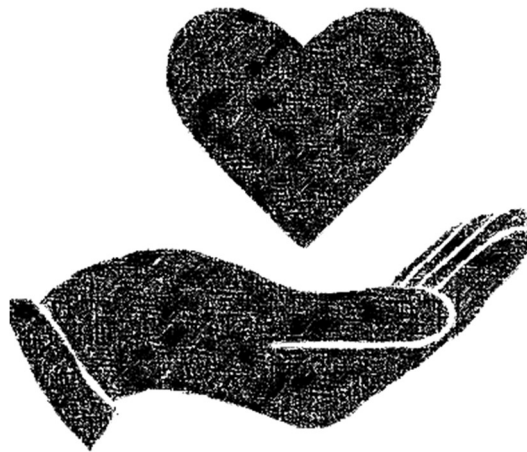

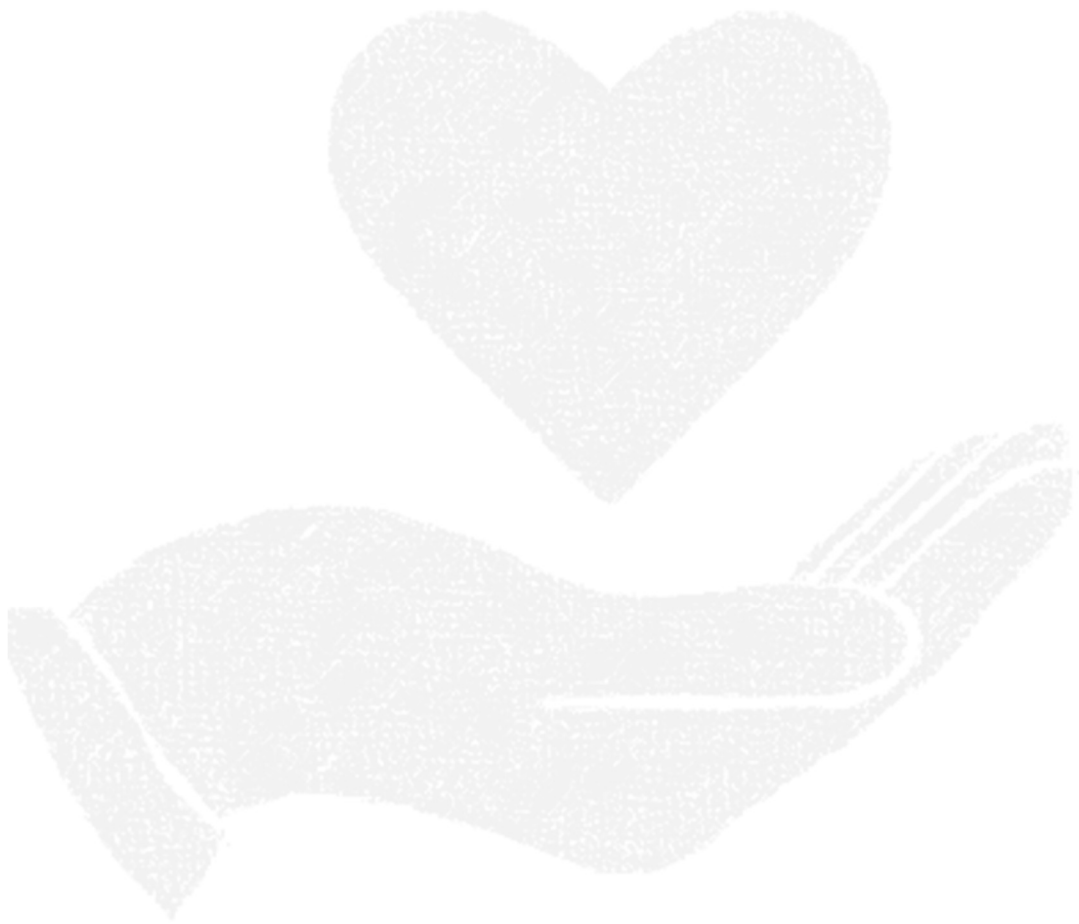

2. The widow woman in Mark 12 reminds us that even when we may not feel we have much, she used all she had to give to the offering with a humble spirit. (Mark 12:41-44)
3. The women with a little oil in 2 Kings 1-7 was an example of how God supplies our needs. He provides for us even when we're in debt over our head and our hearts are grieving over one thing or another, He always turn our little into so much more if we trust his instruction. The Lord used Elisha the Prophet to instruct the woman on how to multiply what The Lord had already blessed her with (little oil poured into multiple vessels).

## PRAYER

*Dear Lord, Thank You for being so loving and so gracious. You loved me so much that when I was conceived, You already had a plan for my life to prosper me and do no harm. You placed gifts within me that no one can take away. Help me to always be mindful to be a good steward over the abilities you have given me and to use every talent to glorify you. Lord, I am thankful that my ability to obtain wealth comes from you. Everything I need to live a prosperous life is already within me. Show me each day to showcase my gift and bring additional streams of income into my home. Enlarge my territory Oh God...that I may gift has and endless span of all I can reach. Thank You for divine connections at the right time. I thank You for divine disconnection at the right time, so that I am not deterred from my assignment(s). I thank you Lord that my mind, will, imagination, emotions and intellect align with Your Word.*

# Guard Your Mouth & Your Ears

1. Stay away from negative people.
2. Watch the words you speak because they feed your spirit. >Negative self-talk can be so detrimental to killing vision. Do you know that you hear the words you speak the loudest. The thoughts you think about you can shift the trajectory of your self-image, your capability, your whole life. What you say about yourself matters. You can't not expect other to be kind to you when you are so disrespectful and verbally abusive to yourself.
3. Faith comes by hearing...be mindful of what and who you're listening to. Everyone and everything is not meant to take up space in your head, heart and your spirit.
4. Make meaningful connections.

Enable me to turn away from anyone that speaks against your promises over my life. ## Stay Focused: Remember Your Why

1. What is your purpose for seeking wealth? Is it to build a better life for your family, to leave a legacy for your children and their children, to become a philanthropist or all of the above?
2. Staying focused means that you are clear of distractions, blowout anything and anyone else who can pull your attention away from what God is calling you to birth.
3. Know that you are in competition with no one because what God is calling you to do, only you can do it. There are certain people assigned to you for you to help.
4. EVERYBODY CAN'T GO! Those of us with pure intentions to serve God and help others want to see everyone prosper. The truth of the matter is that everyone can't go where God is taking you. Their journey, their path is theirs alone. This piece right here is so invaluable because you can be pulling dead weight right at the finish line.

4. Pray and ask The Lord to direct you to someone you can help.
