This is the assessment referenced in my book “One Church One Day.” The goal of these questions is to position you to apply the first principle of war authored by Yahweh Saboath, the LORD of Hosts, which is the principle of objective. I pray the LORD grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation as you seek to discover not only God’s will for your assigned area, but also His specific plan for your area. I trust that the Holy Spirit will lead and guide you, and as you answer these questions, you'll discover His strategic plan for the church in your area.

## **The One Church One Day Assessment**

This PDF is the free download referenced in the book “One Church One Day – A Modern Application of an Ancient Blueprint for Prayer, Unity, and Cultural Transformation.”

The following questions are designed to challenge you to discover and then act on God’s will. As you work through these questions, you will start gathering the necessary spiritual and natural intelligence, establishing a baseline to apply the principle Jesus taught in Luke 14:28–33: no one should begin a war or start building without first counting the cost. So, let’s begin the process.

### ***Is This God’s Will for Your City or Territory?***

1. Do you have a vision or a passion to establish 24/7 prayer, to unite congregations to work together for the sake of the harvest, or to connect the leaders in the seven spheres of society with strategic prayer to transform a specific territory like a city, county, or region?
  - a. What is the territory?
  - b. Is the vision written down, and have you shared that with others?
2. Who are your allies and what are their roles, offices, positions, capabilities, resources, and anointings?
  - a. Are these people or organizations within the same territory or jurisdiction?

- b. The allies should include other community leaders, business leaders, church leaders, ministers, and others who fill roles such as mayor, city council member, police chief, fire chief, business owner, doctor, editor, reporter, teacher, or school principal.
    - c. Do they share your vision, or are they at least aware of it?
- 3. Who are your adversaries and what are their capabilities and intentions?
  - a. Adversaries could include people and/or organizations who are enemies of our LORD and or who seek to implement laws, policies, and actions that are contrary to God's word.
  - b. It is wise to identify the ideology that undergirds their actions, as this often reveals the demonic or spiritual root, providing critical spiritual intelligence.
  - c. Adversaries could also include natural conditions such as the lack of resources, lack of relationships, lack of people, lack of understanding etc. List anything that serves as an obstacle to achieving God's desire for your assigned territory.
- 4. Do you believe it would please our heavenly Father to see:
  - a. His house of prayer for all nations established through night and day, 24/7 prayer, praise, and worship? (Isaiah 56:7, Mark 11:17)
  - b. The elders, leaders representing the seven spheres of society, formed into councils, or strategic teams of leaders? This is an expression of His government, collaborating together to discover what He would want prayed and done to accomplish His will and serve His purpose in the city or region you are called to? (Lamentations 5:14-18, Isaiah 9:6-7)
  - c. A wall of prayer built and congregations, believers, united, connected and working together as one to pray and present His gospel of the kingdom for the sake of the harvest? (Amos 9:11-13, Acts 15:16-17)

If the answer to number four is yes, then metaphorically, you'll find yourself in 1 Chronicles 13, which I like to refer to as the key of David, because it was the first decision he made as king of all of Israel. He consulted with the leaders, and they decided to bring God's presence into their city and nation. By answering the first three questions, you have just begun a process of applying the first principle of war. It's called the principle of objective. Until you and the leaders with you have answered those questions, you are ill-equipped to develop the best strategy for your area. Now you have a better idea of how to move forward.

So, where do you go after this? It starts with answering a simple question: “Is this our heavenly Father’s will?” You decide. Catalytic leaders decide and if that is you, then it is time to begin to count the cost of moving from the vision to your decision. These questions will take you through a variety of steps to help you count the cost as you and the team who share your passion begin to develop a strategic action plan to move from theory and vision into operational reality.

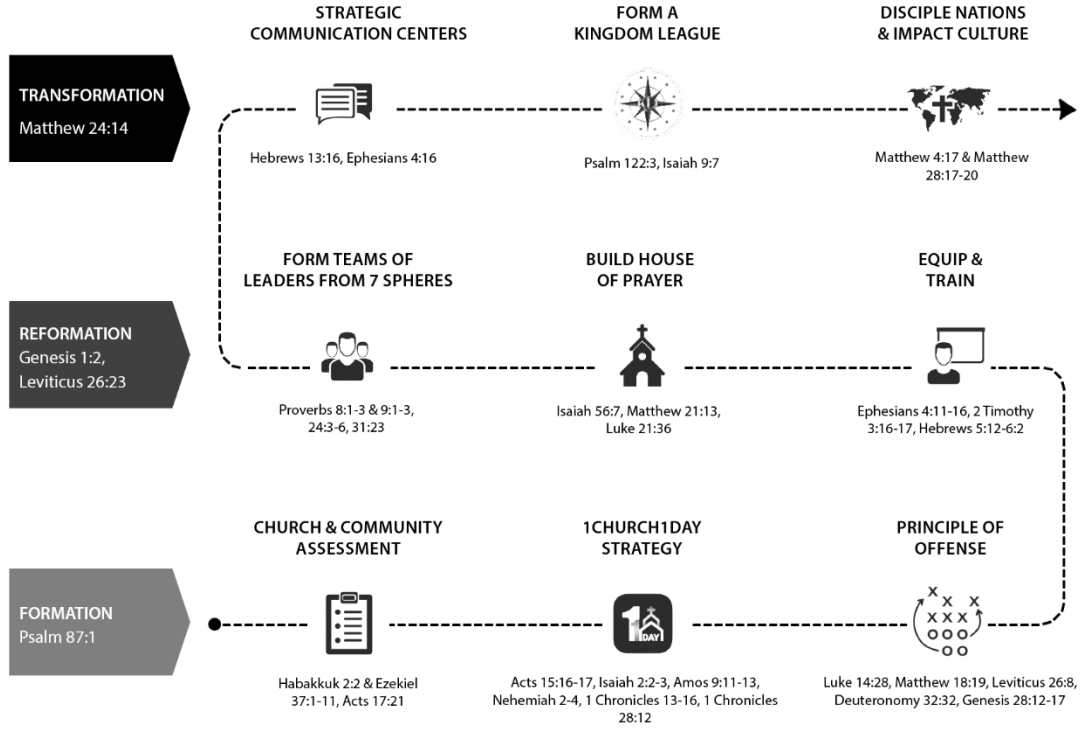
8. Who are your allies and what are their roles, offices, positions, capabilities, resources, and anointings? You'll likely need a separate document for this.

The allies could include other community leaders, business leaders, church leaders, ministers, or fill other roles, such as a mayor, city council member, police chief, fire chief, business owner, or school principal.
  - h. Do these leaders share the vision?
9. Who are your adversaries and what are their capabilities and intentions? You'll likely need a separate document for this as well.
10. Adversaries could include people and or organizations who are enemies of our LORD and or who seek to implement laws, policies, actions which are contrary to God's word.
11. If possible, identify the ideology or demonic stronghold that lies behind these laws, policies, or actions.
12. List any additional conditions, such as a lack of a leader, resources, or skills that serve as an obstacle.
13. Do you, the catalysts, the leaders whom Christ sent to this area, believe One Church One Day would serve our heavenly Father's purpose in your AOR/jurisdiction?
14. Note that you do not have to wait to launch the One Church One Day strategy in your area. You can begin at any time. In fact, your implementation of the strategy in your area will be one of the qualities we will examine when determining who qualifies to use our 508 to help launch a Kingdom League in your area.
15. In addition, there are performance standards, character qualifications, and agreements inspired by scripture, which will be examined to qualify for a Kingdom League. As a Kingdom League is another expression of the Church, it is expected that its people, the local congregations and ministries, are to be treated as holy unto the Lord. They are a sacred assembly.

If the catalysts, like the kings and prophets of old, determine this is of the LORD, then it is time to prepare, like King David did in 1 Chronicles 13:2, where he said to the leaders, “if it seems good to you, and if it is of the LORD our God, let us send out to our brethren everywhere...” (NKJV).

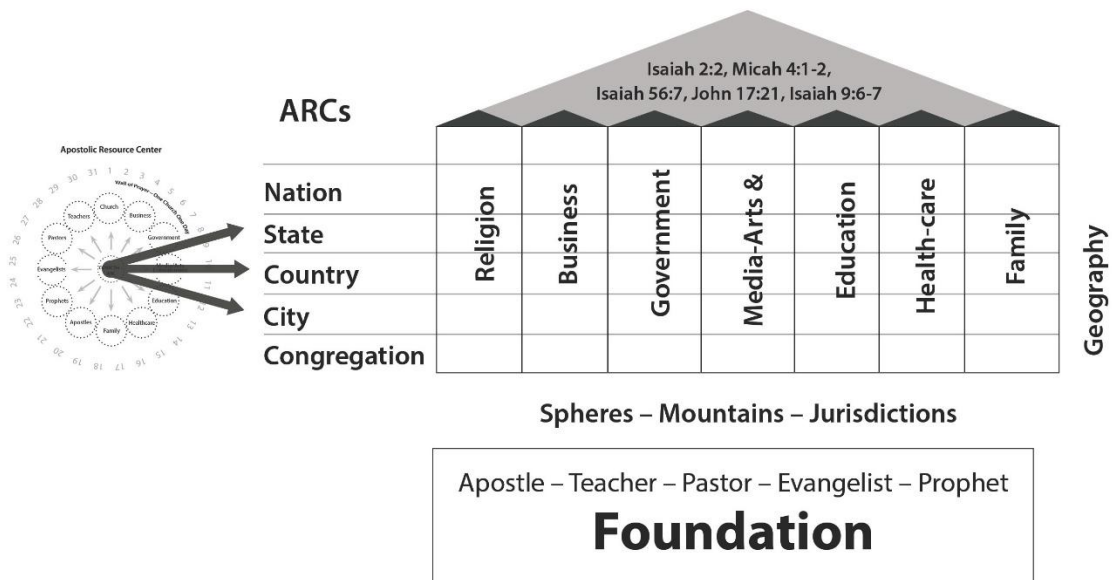
The goal of this assessment is to help the Transformation Task Force Team begin developing its own implementation plan. The following graphic is an overview of the nine steps.

1. Church and Community Assessment Completed
2. Catalytic Leaders Choose to Employ One Church One Day Strategy
3. A Strategic Implementation Plan is Created
4. Roles are Identified and People Trained
5. The House of Prayer is Built as Each Church Takes a Day of Prayer Each Month
6. Strategic Teams Leaders or Councils of Elders are Formed to Give Direction
7. A Strategic Communication System is Established and Overseen by a CONECTer
8. A Kingdom League is Formed for that Jurisdiction
9. Establishing God’s Will on Earth, Impacting Culture and Discipling Nations Commences

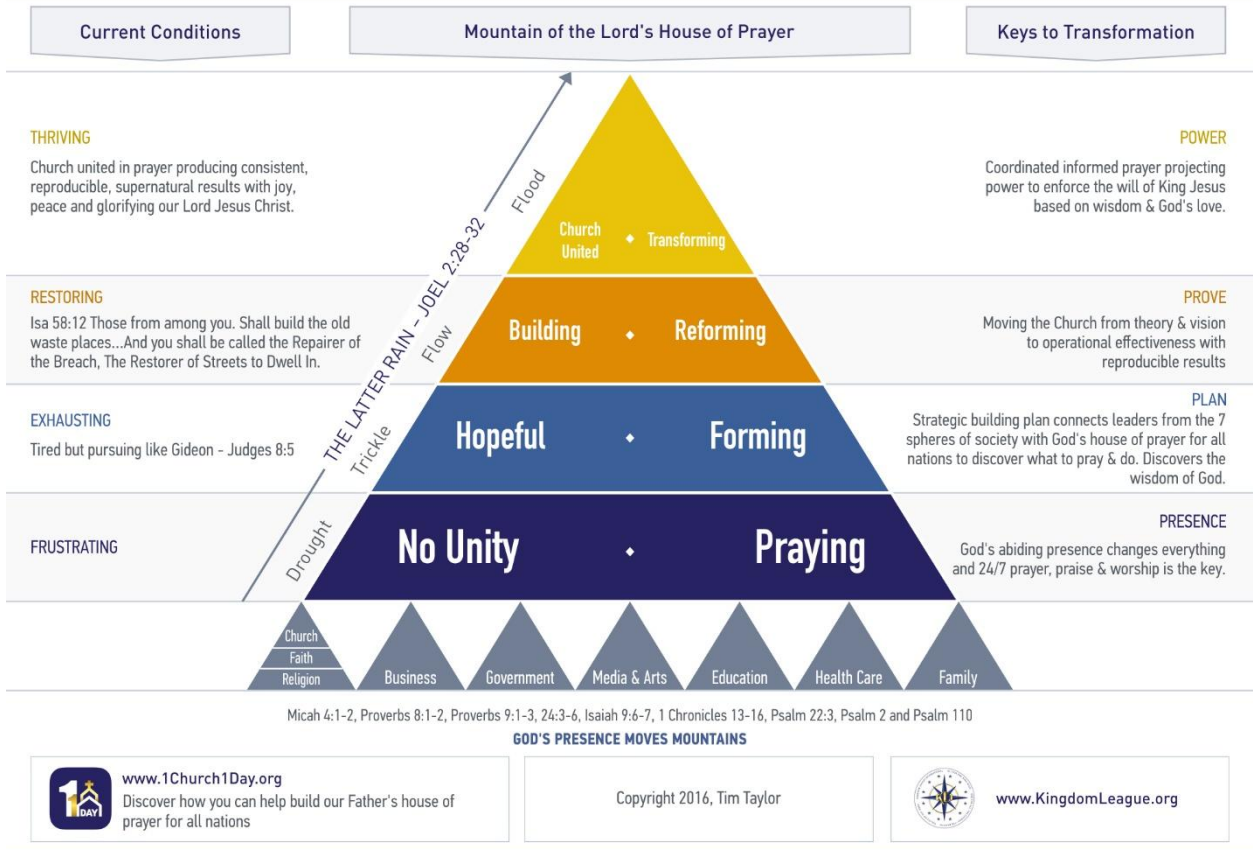
