Dear Catalytic Leader,

This workbook is the free Church & Community Assessment referenced in Chapter 6 of One Church One Day. Its purpose is to help you and a small group of trusted leaders prayerfully discern whether Christ is calling you to employ the One Church One Day strategy in a congregation, city, county, province, region, state, nation, or relational network. Will this strategy help fulfill your and our heavenly Father's assignment for the Ecclesia, the Church, in your city or region?

The assessment applies the principle of objective - the first timeless principle of war authored by YHWH Sabaoth, the LORD of Hosts. Before building or entering a campaign, wise leaders clarify the objective, count the cost, gather spiritual and natural intelligence, identify the people God has positioned, and determine the next faithful action (Luke 14:28-33).

THREE QUESTIONS THIS WORKBOOK HELPS YOU ANSWER

1. What is Christ asking His Church to do in our assigned territory?
2. Who has He already positioned to help accomplish it?
3. What is the next measurable and obedient step?

Recommended Use

- ☐ Pray before you begin and ask the Holy Spirit for wisdom and revelation.
- ☐ Complete the first section individually, then discuss it with 2-7 trusted leaders.
- ☐ Separate verified facts from assumptions, impressions, and questions that still need research.
- ☐ Honor confidentiality. Do not use this assessment to accuse, expose, or target individuals.
- ☐ Focus opposition analysis on policies, ideologies, spiritual resistance, relational barriers, and practical obstacles.
- ☐ Finish by choosing one clear 90-day objective and registering your interest at 1Church1Day.org.

THIS IS NOT A PASS/FAIL TEST

You may conclude that the time is now, that more preparation is needed, or that another strategy better serves your assignment. The goal is faithful discernment - not pressure. Completing this assessment and registering interest are free; training resources are available when you are ready to get equipped.

Begin with the burden, assignment, or opportunity the LORD has placed before you. Clarity at this stage prevents activity without direction and helps leaders unite around a shared objective.

Catalytic leaders do not stop with a general vision. They define the jurisdiction, establish a baseline, and describe what faithful progress would look like. This provides the foundation for a strategic implementation plan.

The first team does not need to be large. It needs to be prayerful, trusted, complementary, and willing to take responsibility. Begin with people who carry apostolic, prophetic, strategic, pastoral, evangelistic, teaching, intercessory, administrative, or community leadership grace.

START SMALL, BUT START WITH CLARITY

A core team of 3-7 aligned leaders can complete this assessment, obtain the field manuals, pray through the objective, and prepare a first 90-day action plan before inviting a larger group.

Sound strategy requires an honest understanding of the operating environment. Gather information humbly, lawfully, and prayerfully. Distinguish what is known from what is assumed, and resist the temptation to label people carelessly.

A CHRISTLIKE STANDARD FOR OPPOSITION ANALYSIS

Pray for people. Test ideas and policies. Address falsehood with truth. Confront injustice lawfully. Avoid slander, exaggeration, and personal targeting. The purpose of intelligence is wise intercession and faithful action - not accusation.

Jesus taught leaders to count the cost before building or entering a conflict. Readiness does not mean perfection. It means the team understands what the next step requires and is willing to steward it faithfully.

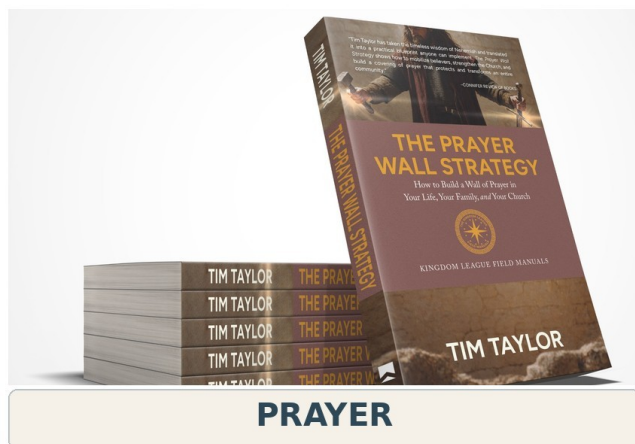

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FOUR PRACTICAL WAYS TO START

Choose the entry point that fits your present capacity

1. CORE TEAM LAUNCH

Invite 3-7 catalytic leaders. Each person obtains the field manuals individually or through the digital bundle. Complete this assessment, meet for prayer and discussion, and produce one 90-day objective.

2. LEADERSHIP OR BIBLE STUDY

Use one field manual at a time as a leadership development or Bible study curriculum. Read assigned chapters before each session, discuss the biblical principles, and apply them to your congregation or territory.

3. CHURCH OR CITY TRAINING COHORT

Invite pastors, intercessors, ministry leaders, and sphere leaders into a structured cohort. Use bulk ordering to place books in every participant's hands and establish a shared language across organizations.

4. PRAYER WALL PILOT

Begin with one practical expression: mobilize families, ministries, or congregations to take assigned prayer watches or days. Learn from the pilot, document participation, and expand the wall over time.

It empowers the Church, composed of many unique and diverse congregations and leaders, to work together as the Church in a city or region. Formation or affiliation is not automatic. 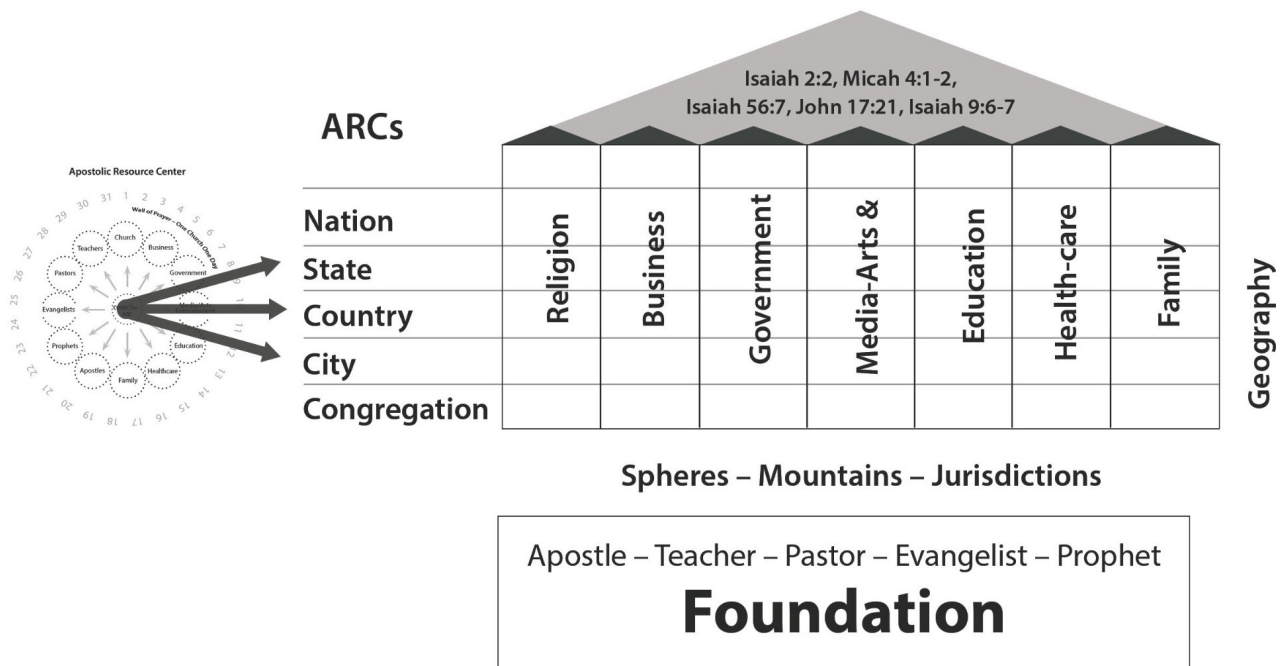

One Church One Day is designed to help the Church think beyond a single meeting or congregation. The strategy connects Christ's fivefold ministry gifts, leaders in the spheres of society, and the geographic or relational jurisdictions they are called to serve.

**FOUNDATION**

Apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers equip the saints and provide complementary leadership grace.

SPHERES

Prayer and service extend into the Church/religion, business, government, media and arts, education, healthcare, and family.

JURISDICTIONS

The assignment may focus on a congregation, city, county/province, state, nation, network, or another clearly defined region.

THE STRATEGIC QUESTION

Who has Christ assigned to this territory, what grace and authority do they carry, which spheres do they influence, and how can they pray and work together to serve His purpose?

Your assessment becomes valuable when it leads to obedient action

You do not need to wait until every condition is perfect. King David consulted with the leaders and took action to bring the ark of God's presence into the center of the city of David, the capital of Israel, and into a tabernacle (1 Chronicles 13:1-4). Similarly, catalytic leaders pray, consult, decide, prepare, and act to invite God's abiding presence into their communities. Acts 15:16 and Amos 9:11 reveal that this is the key to the end-time harvest.
