GOSPEL GROUPS (2-4)

Ask questions for each point on the cross on
Being Disciples: Loving God (Vertical Axis)
Making Disciples: Loving Others (Horizontal Axis)

Jesus: *How is your life in Christ?*

Do you have any sin to confess (James 5:16), promises to claim (1 Cor 1:20), burdens you are carrying (Gal 6:2), vices to put off and virtues to put on (Eph 4:22-24)?

Word: *How are you rooted in the Word?*

What have you been reading and learning from God's Word? How has Christ been convicting or encouraging you from his Word? What Scriptures have you been memorizing and memorizing? Recite any?

Prayer: *How is your life of prayer?*

When and where have you been praying?
 What have you been praying about?
 What prayers has the Lord been answering?
 What are prayers you are lifted up to him?

World: *How are you witnessing?*

How have you shown love to you neighbor?
 What opportunities have you taken to speak of Jesus to your "F.R.A.N.S." list or others?

Church: *How are you serving the Church?*

How have you loved the saints? How have you used your gifts to build up the Body?
 Are you living at peace with all people?

Commitment:

What is a specific and measurable commitment you can make to train for godliness (1 Tim. 4:7)

Putting "Titus 2" into Practice:

Who is my Paul (Mentor)?
 Who is my Barnabas (Peer)?
 Who is my Timothy (Mentee)?
