

# CREATE YOUR MINI-SCENE

## Bonus sheet

Now that you've learned how to build a mini scene, let your imagination run wild and create your own mini scene by following the 6 steps below:

- 1. Choose a general theme that represents a place:** at a restaurant / in a clothing store / in the mountains / at the swimming pool / in a park / at the circus...
- 2. Choose your characters. Who do you want to draw?** An adult / a child / a couple / a group of friends...
- 3. What action are your characters taking? Give your characters movement:** A person who is walking / sitting / waiting / holding something...
- 4. Add some meaningful details to your characters (related to the chosen theme):** a bag / a hat / a glass / a balloon / a bouquet / a dog...
- 5. Choose your decorative elements (be careful not to overload your scene):** Bicycle / bench / cafe / shop / tree...
- 6. Build your scene :** place the elements on different planes by layering them. This will give your scene more depth and realism.

Remember that the most distant elements should appear smaller and higher in the drawing than the elements that are closer.

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
