Responsibility For Your Data Held By Us

BIWC understands the responsibility and commitment to protecting the data relating to its members and contacts. Our Privacy Policy applies to the personal data that is collected and stored in our Membership Information spreadsheet, as well as personal data that has been sent in emails. We carefully control how your personal data is acquired and the purposes for which it is used.

Definition Of Personal Data We Have About You

When using the term 'personal data' in our Privacy Policy, we mean information that relates to you and allows us to identify you. Your personal data includes your name and your contact details, for example, your full name, email address, and telephone number.

Use Of Personal Data

The data we hold about you is used exclusively for the purpose of contacting you to notify you about BIWC events and activities through our emailing system / WhatsApp channels and to improve the types and quality of the events we offer our members (Monthly Meetings, Annual Events, Activity Groups, etc.). The data is held on our Membership Information spreadsheet and is not shared with any other institution or organisation. We do not collect personal data from Cookie files via our website.
