This Monetization Map gives you the easiest ways to make money from your Facebook Theme Page – no product, no camera, no ads required.

## 1. Affiliate Links

Promote digital products related to your theme (like dog training courses, fitness eBooks, or travel gear).

Use platforms like WarriorPlus, Digistore24, or ClickBank to find offers.

Add affiliate links to high-performing posts or in pinned comments.

## 2. Shoutouts and Paid Posts

Once your page grows, smaller brands or influencers may pay you to feature their posts or links.

Set up a basic pricing sheet and offer shoutout bundles.

Promote pages, Instagram profiles, YouTube channels, or Etsy stores.

## 3. Content Upgrades / Lead Magnets

Offer a free PDF, checklist, or guide and collect emails.

Promote affiliate products through follow-up emails.

Example: “Comment ‘YES’ to get our Free Travel Checklist” – then deliver it via email or DM.

## **4. Digital Products or Printables**

Sell simple eBooks, templates, planners, or printables related to your niche.

Use Gumroad, Payhip, or Etsy to deliver products.

Theme examples: dog training guides, motivational quote bundles, printable fitness trackers.

## **5. Facebook Stars & Bonuses (For Reels)**

Eligible pages can receive Stars (tips) from viewers of Reels and livestreams.

Post short videos consistently to become eligible through Facebook's bonus programs.

## **6. Linktree or Bio Pages**

Create a single landing page with multiple monetization links.

Use free tools like Linktree, Beacons, or Carrd to organize offers, downloads, and signups.
