



TECH TOOLS for Artists UPDATED!

A quick start guide to apps, platforms and sites that can help artists save time, and effort, organise admin and present more professionally.

Welcome

As an Artist, there is a lot to juggle to have a thriving practice.

From conceiving the work, creating the work, planning exhibitions, marketing the work, packaging work to send, entering prizes, developing proposals, applying for residencies, liaising with buyers, gallery owners and staff, collectors, framers, couriers and photographers, website building, social media management..... so much.

I have seen artists get bogged down at the computer doing all these things while the studio waits patiently. Often feeling overwhelmed and out of their depth. Or avoiding it (the business side) altogether because it was just too hard.

I wanted to change all that for you. In 2020 I launched The Artists Business Lounge and created the first Tech Tools for Artists Guide sharing with you some of my favourite apps and websites that make my life easier. Some are free and some come with different paid plans.

These tech tools help you:

- 1) Reduce time spent on admin 'stuff'
- 2) Better organise your information making your life easier
- 3) Present you and your work more professionally
- 4) Grow your audience and your sales
- 5) or a combination of the above

Over 1,000 artists have downloaded that guide!

Since then there have been more great apps on the market and changes to what's possible - especially as AI changed the game.

But more than ChatGPT and other AI programs, software, platforms and apps you may already be familiar with started to upgrade with AI features too.

Four years is a long time in tech and so this overdue update has been created. I have tested more tech than I could put in this guide. I have avoided overly expensive apps, software that didn't deliver to the promised standard (the reject list is long!), and software that isn't readily useful for most artists.

In this guide, I have provided references to a few other resources I have created and the option to book a call with me so look out for those.

All the Tech Tools listed here are ones that I have tested, that I use or have used and am comfortable to recommend.

Some may be more useful to you than they are to others, and some won't be of interest. Have a read-through, find ones that interest you and click the links in the guide to visit the websites and learn more.

Bookmark the ones you are curious about and add something to your mix today.

I truly hope you find something that serves you so that you can avoid the feeling that you are simply 'too busy' to do what matters - making your Art and sharing it with the world.

Show The World

01 WEBSITES

One of the main things Artists use to showcase their work is a website.

I use WordPress.org for my websites. It's great for artists who prefer customisation and flexibility in their website design. WordPress offers a wide range of themes and plugins, including WooCommerce (see tool 17) making this option the most flexible.

It's also free, you just pay to host.

Other popular options, that are bit simpler on the backend and suitable for artists are [Shopify](#), [Squarespace](#), [Wix](#) and [Weebly](#).

02 DOMAIN NAMES

You'll need a domain name for your website.

I use [GoDaddy](#) to buy mine, [NameCheap](#) is another great option.

If you already have a website builder, check if they include a domain name and an email address linked to the domain. You can have multiple domains and even subdomains.

Collect emails, create automated welcome messages and communicate with your subscribers about upcoming exhibitions and offers.

05 PLANOLY

Planoly, is another favourite because it is so visual. It's a great app for planning and scheduling Instagram posts, stories and reels, and cross posting to Facebook and Pinterest as well. Other scheduling app options include Later, Hootsuite, and

A shout out to Canva (which is tech tool number 09 in this guide) - on the pro plan you can now connect, schedule and post straight from Canva.

06 META

Did you know you can plan and schedule posts for free for Facebook and Instagram using Meta?

If you have a Facebook page and link your Instagram account, you can schedule posts across both platforms through your Meta Business Suite from a computer (not the mobile app).

07 LINKTREE

A handy way to manage multiple links in your Instagram profile. Use it to promote newsletter sign ups, upcoming exhibitions, your other social accounts, your website etc. It's super easy to change the links in Linktree without editing your bio. Pro version gives you detailed analytics.

Don't want to use Linktree but want to achieve the same thing? You can create a linktree style page as a hidden website page.

I now use a bio page on my systeme.io account (see tool 16) to achieve the same result

Showcase II

08 ARTWORK ARCHIVE

This tech tool works on so many levels - I almost put it under Organise It, but decided to go with Showcase It - it's both and it's more. This is a fantastic inventory management system, that is also a portfolio, a quick and easy way to display your work, create invoices, and share 'private curated collections' with special collectors. and so much more. It's one of my Must Have tech tools.

09 CANVA



Quick easy promotional graphics for your social media and to design brochures, postcards, invitations, or to create a visual catalogue of your work for events like open studios and pop-up exhibitions.

Canva has mock ups - interiors and products, background remover and even AI image creation.

You can use Canva to create and edit all sorts of content, there are scheduling capabilities on the pro plan and you can print your designs.

Canva continues to evolve into so much more than a design tool.

I use Canva for Lead Magnets, Reels, Social posts, Presentations, and Templates for Artists.

10 IARTVIEW

Bring your collection to your clients' walls anytime, anywhere with your iArtView gallery app. Other options include ArtRoom and Canvy. Canva also offers mockups

11 MOO

For printed postcards, invitations, business cards, stickers, labels. I love Moo.

If you appreciate quality and beauty, unboxing a Moo order will make your day.

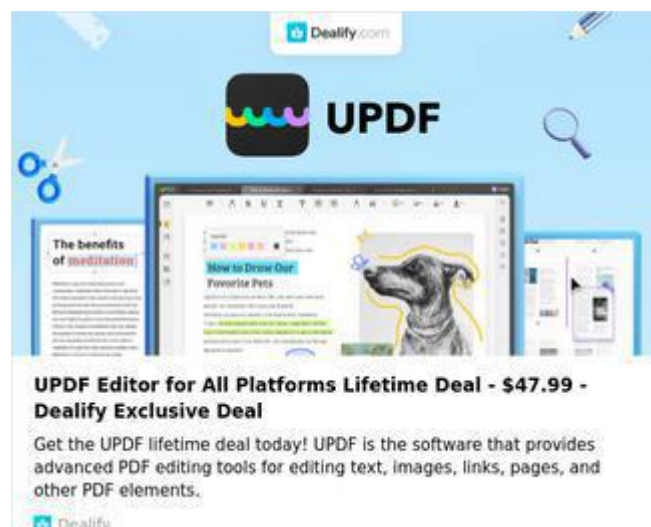
You can have multiple images so can turn your business cards into a portable mini portfolio.

(Vistaprint is a good lower budget option without the thrill).

Canva which I've already mentioned also prints cards and documents like flyers and catalogues.

12 UPDF

Update and Edit pdf files. Create fillable forms.



You can use UPDF to edit presentations and catalogues, to bring downloadable guides up to date.

*Use it to update details, create customised catalogues for different buyers. It has endless possibilities - **by far the best and cheapest pdf editor I have found to date.***

Write It - with AI help

Grammarly is great for checking spelling and grammar - where normal spellchecking may not pick up you have typed form instead of from, Grammarly identifies the context and will note it. You can use the free plan to check your spelling on websites (great for website editing).

You can also upload files for checking and improvements.

I wouldn't be without this tool!

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Content creation - from reworking and improving your written content to getting ideas for how to arrange content, marketing copy etc.

AI is here and it saves a lot of time if you use it well.

ChatGPT is the one I use (though I have tried many others)

Jasper.ai is frequently cited as one of the best

CoPilot from Microsoft

Gemini (previously Bard) from Google.

Tools to help you rank higher and get more traffic. The paid plan is a bit exxy for a single user but there are free AI enabled tool that you can use to write SEO, Meta Descriptions, social captions, Hashtags and more.

Money - Make It

For building funnels and automations for online sales. You can use this for courses, communities, funnels and your email campaigns and newsletters. You can even use it to create a Linktree style bio, a blog and more. Mindblowing!!

Speaking of funnels...

If you want to sell online, optimise your cart value through upsells and downsells, you'll need funnel software.

Funnels allow you to create focused promotions without the distraction of everything on your website.

Aside from Systeme.io other options for funnels include Clickfunnels and LeadPages.

17 WOOCOMMERCE



If you want to sell online you'll need shopping cart software.

Shopping cart software allows you to create an online store and add and manage products, services, and digital downloads.

WooCommerce which I use and is a PlugIn for WordPress sites it has a ton of flexibility and the ability to grow with you. Did I mention, it's free?,

Other shopping cart software suitable for artists include BigCartel, Shopify, and website Builders such as Wix, Weebly, Squarespace all have shop options available on their higher plans.

Money - Get Paid

If you are selling online, you'll want secure online payment options. I use Stripe for this. There is also Square. And of course, PayPal.

Money - Managing Finances

Make your tax and bookkeeping so much easier by having accounting software that allows you to track and manage your finances.

Connect your business bank account to your software, get some rules created for frequent expenses and give your accountant access.

This will save you hours of preparation and give you more real-time information.

I use [Xero](https://xero.com), other options suitable for artists include [Quickbooks](https://quickbooks.com), [Zoho Books](https://zoho.com) and [Freshbooks](https://freshbooks.com).

Video - Create, Edit & Host

DESCRIPT is a super easy handy video recording and editing tool.

You can use it to make short clips for reels, full length videos, instruction videos, or just to edit video you've already shot.

Editing video in Descript is as easy as using docs and slides.

It offers Podcasting, Screen recording, Transcription that is highly accurate (I replaced Rev.com paid service and Otter with Descript)

Clip creation, and a selection of templates.

Edit video by editing text and automatically remove ums and aahs. They even have AI voice cloning

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LOOM is a great site to use when you are working with someone else on online content, a website update, or catalogue design. Simply open what you are working on, open loom and talk as you walk through and talk about what you need done. Send the link and the person has very clear and instant information.

Up to 25 videos up to 5 minutes each are free. Once you've shared the instructions and it's been viewed you can simply delete the file to keep you under the paid level if you like.

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VIMEO & YOUTUBE

If you want to store and share videos online, the two big players are Vimeo (my choice because Vimeo video ends without sending you to someone else's content)) and YouTube (great for traffic).

Get in touch for a special link if you would like 25% off an annual Vimeo plan.



Transcribe II

24 [REV.COM AND OTTER.AI](#)

Does your work involve interviewing others?

Do you think better when you are talking? You can use Rev.com transcription service to translate your spoken thoughts to documents, emails, blog posts.

You upload an audio file and Rev.com transcribes it into a written document.

(Rev costs and Otter is free but Rev is much more accurate)

You can also use Descript to transcribe videos.

Outsource II

25 [UPWORK.COM](#)

This site allows you to outsource everything you don't want to do/aren't good at, but need to have done.

Facebook ads, Graphic design, data entry, copywriting etc. You don't HAVE to be an expert at everything

This site offers affordable options for one-off, short term or long-term contracts.

[Fiverr.com](#) is another option (though quality can be variable).

Organise II

TRELLO



Project management software allows you to plan, manage, and track projects, exhibitions, launches and more. Project management options include Basecamp, Monday, Asana and the one I use and recommend, Trello.

Want to plan out your exhibition? Trello is a handy tool for managing projects, creating content and schedules, organising priorities. It not only makes your life easier, but it streamlines your time too.

I have used Trello to create templates for Artists too - like the *Plan and Build Your Artist Website Trello Board* and the *Exhibition Planning and Preparation Trello Board*.

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ZAPIER

Zapier is an integration tool that enables you to communicate between applications to make something happen, like adding buyers details to your email list, adding sales information to a spreadsheet, generating invoices, creating calendar reminders and so much more. Pabbly is another tool that does the same thing.

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EVERNOTE

Researching a topic or artist? Use evernote to save web articles and clips into notebooks with topics you define. Make notes using images, text, uploads and share notes with others. Use tags for easy retrieval and pick up your notes on any device and integrates with Microsoft Outlook Calendar. OneNote is another useful tool to store and organise your notes, research and inspiration.



Track II - Traffic

29 WEBSITE ANALYTICS

If you have a website you need to know whether you are getting traffic and it's very helpful to know how much traffic and where it is coming from. This is where Website Analytics comes into play.

Google Analytics is great but there are others such as HotJar, your website analytics tool.

Track II - Time

30 CLOCKIFY

Time tracking software that lets your time. allocate time to projects, run reports to see where time is being spent (or wasted) . Handy for any paid by the hour work or to track time spent on commissions and preparation to help you give more accurate quotes.

Reduce II

31 PDFCOMPRESSOR

A free website that can save you time by quickly reducing large file size without losing quality. Simply upload your file and download the compressed version.

This is great for reducing the size of image heavy files like catalogues, submissions, and presentations. I even use it to compress files other people send me to save storage space on my computer.

32 TINYPNG

Reduce the size of your images for online use without losing image quality. Smaller file sizes can significantly speed up your website. TinyPNG reduces the file size of your JPEG and PNG images. Every uploaded image is analyzed to apply the best possible JPEG encoding. Based on the content of your image an optimal strategy is chosen. The result is a quality image without wasting storage or bandwidth!

Optimise II

33 SNAPSEED

Best Free in phone editing app. phone photo editing. This handy and free app has a huge range of editing features For iOS and Android. It's bene my go-to for years now.

34 ADOBE LIGHTROOM

A great photo editing option, best on the paid plan. If you have an Adobe Creative Cloud subscription you may already have access to this. Adobe Lightroom has a huge range of adjustments and is suitable for both iOS and Android and Mac and PC.



Schedule it

35 SIGN IN SCHEDULING (FORMERLY [10TO8](#))

Need other people to schedule appointments in your calendar without the eternal back and forth? We use 10to8 to share when we are available so customers can book a time with us simply online. [Calendly](#) is another free option.

You could use it to set up studio visits on designated days. How else would a booking calendar help you?

36 [COZI](#)

A simple to use family calendar that lets you sync to all sorts of calendar and lets you keep track of recurring appointments, other people's schedules, and helps with things like meal planning and to-do lists.

Why does this help? Because we have lives outside the studio.

We use ZOOM all the time for The Artists Business Lounge Success System Program, and for individual coaching, But I have also used it for artist interviews (ART500), virtual studio visits around the world and to have 'Wine O'Clock' studio get-togethers with Artists in different countries.

Store It and Share It

38 AMAZON WEB SERVICES

To manage file transfers. Save low res and high res image files organised into folders ready to share with publishers, galleries and others at a moments notice. WeTransfer is another option.



39 DROPBOX

To manage file transfers. Save low-res and high-res image files organised into folders ready to share with publishers, galleries and others at a moments notice. WeTransfer is another option.



40 GOOGLEDRIVE

Google Drive, Google Docs and Google Sheets are all good collaborative tools that avoid the backwards and forwards of emails and allow you to save and share documents. You can also use Google Forms to create and send free survey forms to your audience for feedback and research..

Avoid it

41 RESCUETIME

Do you spend too much time on your computer? RescueTime records how much time you spend on what sites and programs stuck at your computer. If you struggle to find art making time away from your computer, use this.

42 PHRASE EXPRESS

Phrase Express accelerates your typing by replacing abbreviations with frequently used phrases that you define. You write the information once then access it ongoing with a simple code. You can use it for any phrases you like. Handy if you write research papers, grant applications and the like

43 SANEBOX

AI for your email. Sanebox identifies important messages, hides distractions, has Do Not Disturb, reminds you to follow up and more. According to Sanebox the average SaneBox customer saves 100+ hours/year.

44 FREEDOM

Is an app and website blocker for Mac, Windows, Android, iOS, and Chrome with a host of features to help you manage distractions. Choose the sites you want to limit or block so you spend less time absorbed in your computer.

45 FOCUSWRITER

Is an app and website blocker to save you from distraction and give you dedicated writing time, FocusWriter blocks out everything on your screen except what you're writing. It uses a hide-away interface so that you can immerse yourself in your work.
