Zero Tolerance for Life-Threatening Behavior Awareness Training

The Challenge

Our client needed to roll out critical safety training tied to their Zero Tolerance for Life-Threatening Behavior program on a compressed timeline.

At the same time, their Learning & Development team was down to a single person supporting the full organization.

They had an approved script and clear requirements, but needed a partner to turn the content into a structured video training experience that could be deployed in their LMS.

The Approach

IDLance supported our client as an extended production team, managing execution end-to-end while aligning to their standards and safety expectations.

IDLance:

- Segmented a 4,780-word master script into a series of short training videos
- Wrote unique openings and closings for each video to improve flow and clarity
- Produced narrated videos using an AI voice approved by our client, paired with visual pacing and branded layouts

The Approach (continued)

- Sourced stock visuals aligned to our client's requirements
- Developed knowledge checks aligned to each video, including feedback for all answer options
- Provided project management support and timeline oversight
- Supported deployment in Cornerstone OnDemand (CSOD) through guided screenshare sessions, mobile testing, and completion logic validation

Our client received a complete, ready-to-deploy training package that supported consistent rollout across project sites without increasing strain on internal L&D capacity.

Segmenting the content into shorter videos supported engagement, reduced cognitive overload, and made it easier for learners to complete training on mobile devices and revisit specific topics as needed.
