

Materials list for the Sew for Nature Journey

To make shopping easier we have a tool kit with:

- Sew Nature's Activator, 2 oz.
- Fabric Color Chart
- Printed Color chart and blending Instructions
- Fantastix (2)
- Kneadable Eraser
- Paint brush
- Stick for dipping in activator

In addition to the tool kit, you will need:

1. [Inktense Derwent pencils](#) 12 pack or 24, 36, 72 pack
2. Inkjet Fabric Sheets (I like [jacquard](#) because they are economical, but unfortunately not always available, [EQ Printables](#) work well, but are expensive. You can also use white fabric and iron **freezer paper** to the back so it's stiff and will go through the printer). Don't have a printer? Trace the templates using a window of light box onto **white fabric**.
3. A small container for water
4. A rag like an old t-shirt or kitchen towel
5. Pencil sharpener— [Prismacolor](#) is a brand that works great for these pencils.
6. Clip board and binder clips to hold your fabric sheet while painting

If not buying the tool kit you will also need:

7. Kneaded eraser or white eraser
8. Paint brushes - small round brushes sizes #2 - 4 +/-or Fantastix, (2 brushes and 2 Fantastix in kit)
6. Activator: Sew Nature's or Aloe Vera or Textile Medium (Sew Nature's comes in the Inktense Tool kit 2 oz.) You can also order this in a 4 oz. container. [Sew Nature's Activator Link](#)



For quilted sheets that can be made into a wall quilt, pillow, etc. you will also want: Batting approximately 9" x 12" and Fabric backing about 11" x 14" Muslin works well or any scrap material you have on hand
