NOTES FOR PARENTS

This Bible Study is a compliment to the Middle School / Teens and Adult Studies.

The Bible reading and discussion points are the same, but the answers are single words / drawings or activities.

Very young children will learn a lot from being in the room while the family discusses biblical principles, while being occupied with their own activity when the older members of the family are writing down their answers.

You may like to give younger child, just the pages for that nights study rather than the whole booklet.

Young children can learn to sit and listen as the bible passages are read and then to add their answers to the questions that are asked.

Keep these pages in a file or folder, as some you will need for more than one night.



3 Your Child can, of course, stick any of their pages on their bedroom walls. However, that pages with this symbol in the bottom left corner, are designed specifically to go onto the wall when complete. The number is the number of days it will take to complete, so you do not pin them up before they are done. These can then be used as prayer prompts when praying.

Choose the appropriate booklet for your child. Booklets are labelled A, B, C, D so that you can choose a level that is appropriate for you child. (eg: a teenager, who is a new Christian, may benefit more from the middle school booklet, as the language is simpler. Or you may have a year 3 (Junior) who is a very competent reader and would benefit from the middle booklet, and a year 1 (Junior) who would benefit more from the Pre-School level booklet.)

Booklet A = Toddlers/Pre Schoolers (Age under 5 years)

Booklet B = Junior Schoolers (Age 6-9 years)

Booklet C = Middle Schoolers (10-13 years)

Booklet D = Teens/Adults (Age 14+ years)

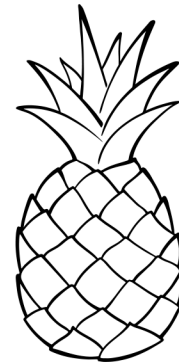
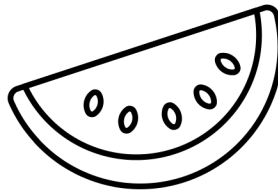
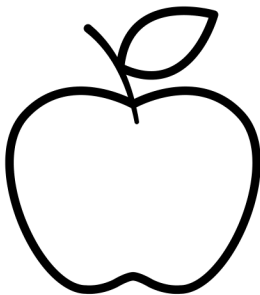
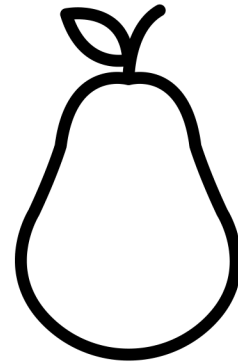
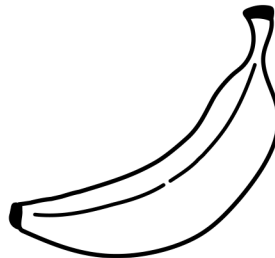
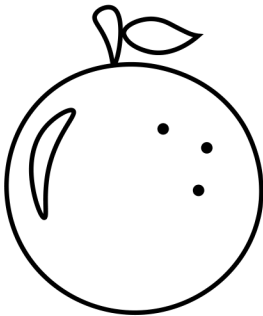
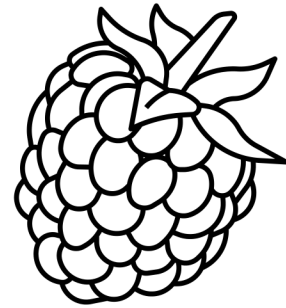
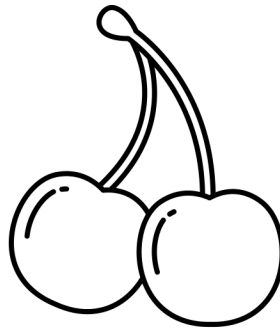
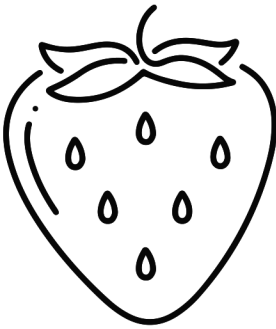


**Draw Leaves on this tree, so the
branches are healthy.**



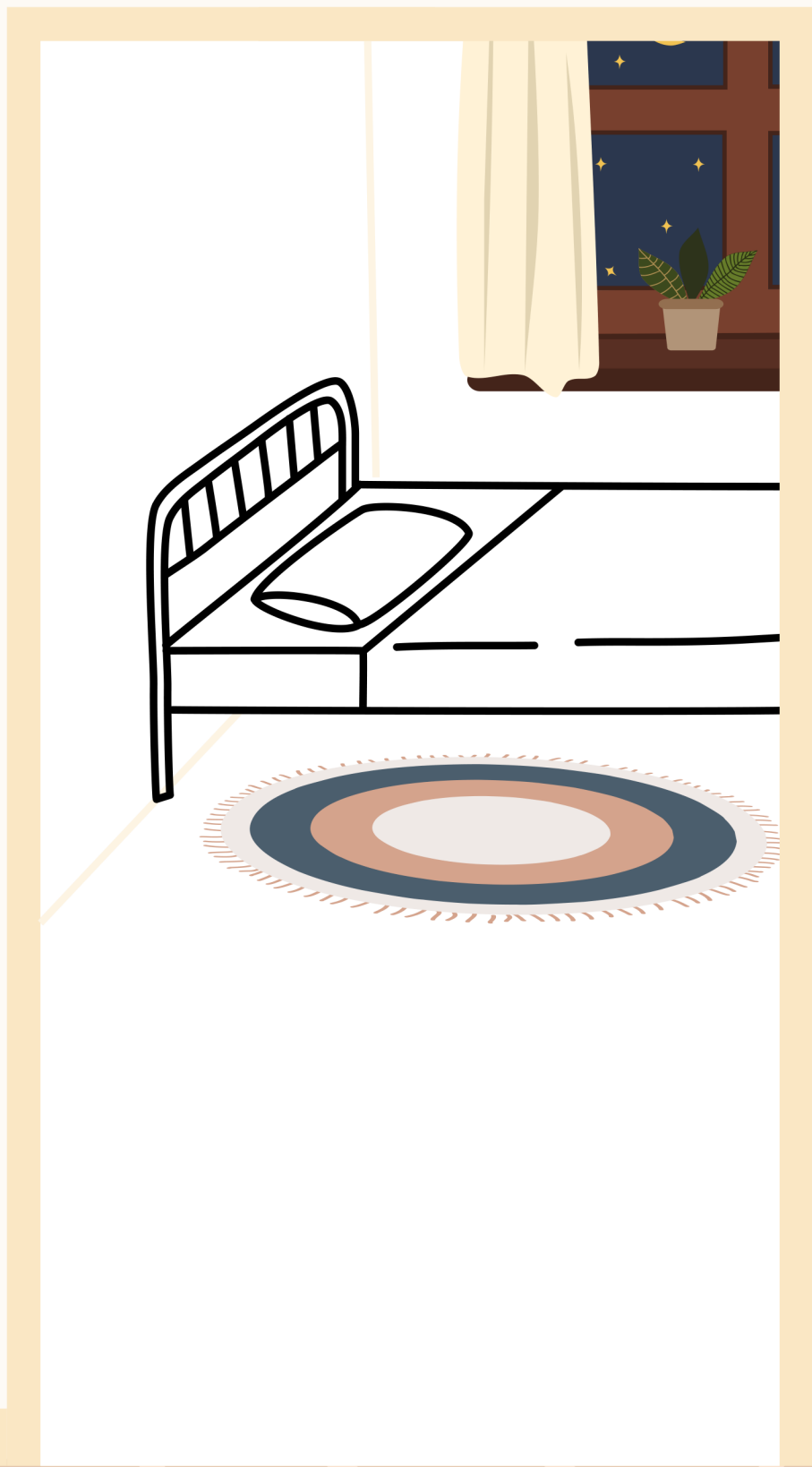

Colour in these fruit. Cut them out and glue them onto your tree. Listen to the discussion and tell your family what fruit you want to have in your life.



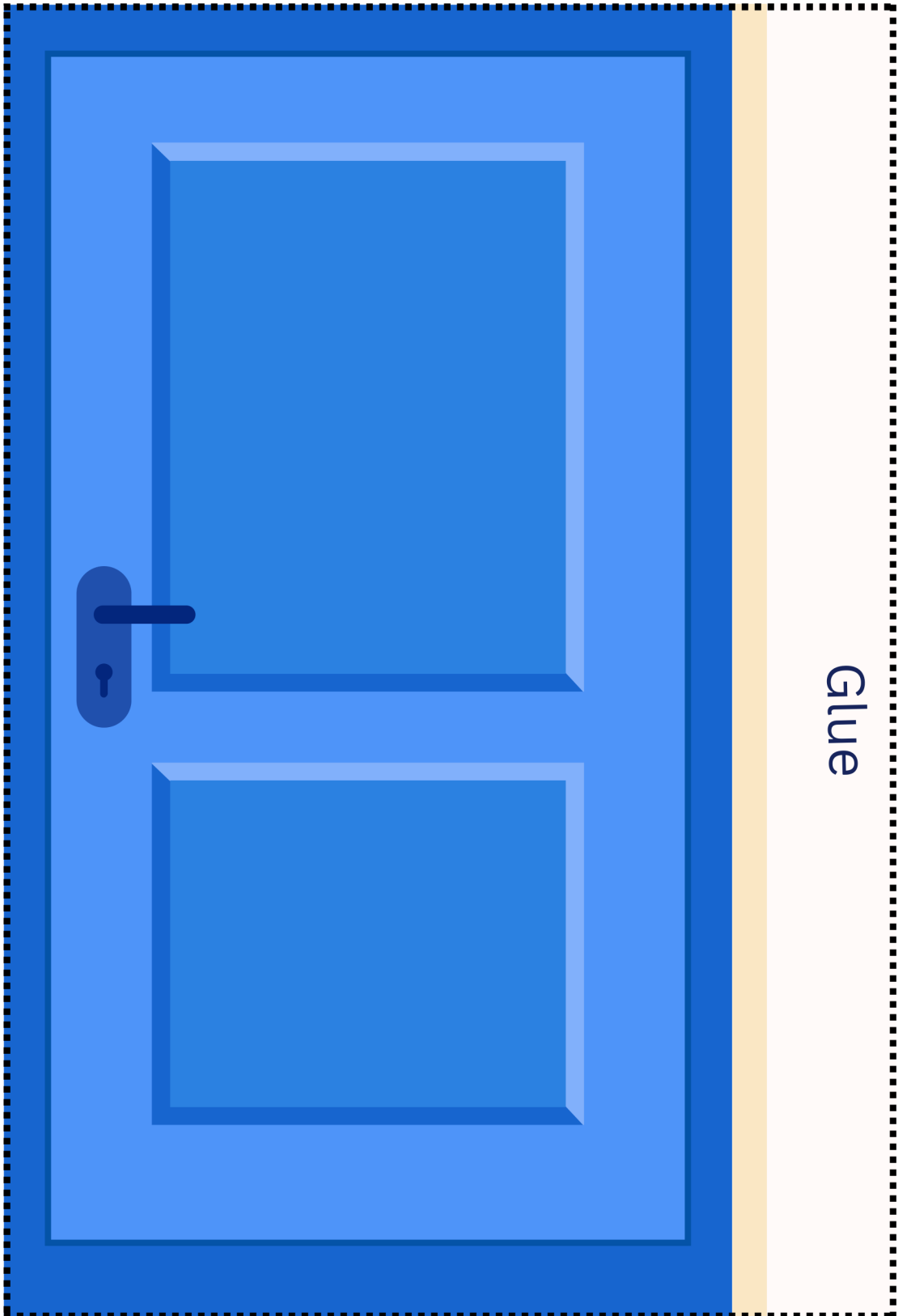
WEEK 4 - DAY 1
