# FAMILY NIGHT – MIRROR MIRROR ON THE WALL

## Resources

- ★ Toolkit
- ★ Printout crowns
- ★ Blue-tac or sticky tape

## Activity

Suggested to do the activity and the discussion over dessert.

Hand out a few crown cut outs to each family member.

Write on them phrases from this week's Memory verse, or Bible Study that talk about who we are in Christ or how God sees us.

Try and come up with as many different ones as you can.

For younger children use the picture cards instead of the crowns. Read the words on the card to them and have them colour the card.

Blue-tac or sticky tape these around each mirror in the house to be a reminder of who we are.

Examples:

I am a Child of the King | God's love is unchangeable

Heir with Christ | Loved Forever | Called to Shine

Make in God's Image | Spirit of Adoption | Led by the Spirit

Prince | Princess | Nothing can separate us

I do what's right | I have a clean heart | I make good choices

## Discussion



As you fill in or colour your cards, talk about who we really are verses who Satan says we are.

Make these age appropriate and use what your kids are writing down as the springboard for discussion.

Eg.

Satan says we are worthless – We are children of the King

Satan says we have not power – we have the power of Christ

Satan says we are not worthy of God's love – God says His love is freely given to us

Satan says we too weak to be useful – God says He gives us all the strength we need

Satan says we don't fit in – God says we are a part of His family
