

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Generative AI- Large Language Models

- Generative Artificial Intelligence is a type of AI that is capable of generating text, images, or other media, using generative models.
- Generative AI models learn the patterns and structure of their input training data and then generate new data with similar characteristics. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Generative_artificial_intelligence
- We offer a **prompt**- then it searches the info it has access to and **predicts text** to offer based on feedback from the user.

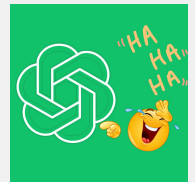


ChatGPT can make mistakes. Verify important information.

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A few statistics...

- ChatGPT had 1 million users within the first five days of being available
- 400 million workers could be displaced because of AI
- Research estimates AI will create 97 million jobs
- A quarter of companies are adopting AI because of labor shortages
- Half of U.S. mobile users use voice search every day
- 97% of business owners believe ChatGPT will help their business
- Over 60% of business owners say AI will increase productivity
- Over 75% of consumers are concerned about misinformation from AI

Equal Access to AI

- Literacy is a prerequisite- need precise language
- Access to tech and quality instruction varies greatly

Biased and incorrect info from Generative AI- "hallucinations"- verify info-- 80/20 rule

Cheating and plagiarism- establish rules

Data privacy concerns- Don't use personal, proprietary or sensitive info



Using AI as AT- what does a person need? Features?

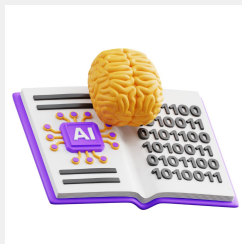
- **Read text aloud-** help with **reading and vision challenges**
- **Transcription & captions-** help with **hearing issues, ADHD, auditory processing/comprehension**
- **Declutter web pages-** reader view- help with **ADHD, reading, cognition**
- **Summarize and simplify written content-** help with **new learning**
- **Speech recognition-** use smart assistants- Echo Show, Siri, Hey, Google- **access info and control environment**

Using AI as AT- what does a person need? Features?

- **Speech-to-text-** support **writing**
- **Text-to-image-** help with **memory and learning**
- **Image-to-text-** help with **word retrieval, communication**
- **AI powered tutoring-** support **new learning**
- Get help **brainstorming solutions-** figure out next steps- get feedback
- **Break down** projects into smaller steps- help with **executive functioning**
- **Learn new skills with the help of apps that change based on responses.**

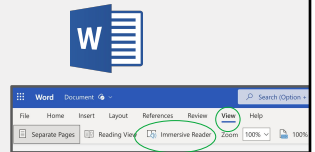

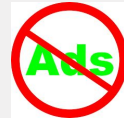

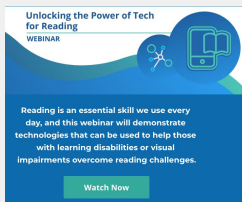
- **Settings** > Accessibility > Spoken Content
- **Speak selection**- select text then touch "speak"
- **Speak screen**- swipe down with two fingers from the top of the screen and then press play (use assistive touch)

Google Lens

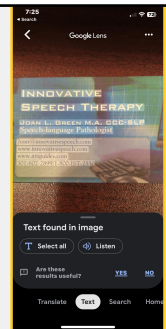


This app uses the camera on a tablet or smartphone

On iOS use the Google app and tap on the Lens icon.

Take a picture of text in environment (a sign, book, handout) and it reads it out loud immediately! It can also translate.

Generative AI- ie Chat GPT- to support reading

- Summarize and/ or simplify content being read
- Get the gist and framework for help deciding if you want to read the entire article.
- Supports text-based input

Chat GPT Prompts

- "Please summarize this article and simplify the content so a 5th grade student can understand it."
- "Please create an outline of this article and create 5 bullets for key ideas."
- "Summarize the following text in 500 words."
- "Provide a concise summary of the book..... In an easily understandable format highlighting the themes."
- "Please suggest a few books I might like to read that are similar to"
- "Create a list of books to read to help me learn about..."
- "Can you suggest an image I could use to help me remember a main lesson in this book?"

Summarization in Bard

How can I use you to help me generate summaries of websites, PDFs and documents?

You can use me to help you generate summaries of websites, PDFs, and documents in a few different ways:

Google Search
When you search for a website, PDF, or document on Google, you will often see a summary of the content in the search results. This summary is generated by me, and it is designed to give you a quick overview of the content so that you can decide if it is worth clicking on.

To use me to generate summaries of websites, PDFs, and documents in Google Search, simply search for the content that you want to summarize. If the content is available online, and it is in a format that I can understand, then I will generate a summary for you.

Google Docs
If you are using Google Docs to create or edit a document, you can use me to generate a summary of the document. To do this, simply select the text that you want to summarize, and then click on the "Summarize" button in the toolbar. I will then generate a summary of the selected text and insert it into the document.

Google Assistant
You can also use me to generate summaries of websites, PDFs, and documents using Google Assistant. To do this, simply open the Google Assistant app on your phone or tablet, and then say "Summarize this." Google Assistant will then ask you for the URL of the website or the file path of the PDF or document that you want to summarize. Once you have provided this information, Google Assistant will generate a summary for you and read it aloud.

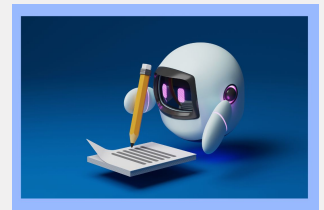





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Using ChatGPT with your voice



- Talk To ChatGPT Chrome Extension or Edge Add-ons
- Allows you to interact with ChatGPT using just your voice.
- Responds with text as well as speech
- Only works in Edge or Chrome desktop browser
- Free
- Works in multiple languages
- Start from ChatGPT homepage and log in- then click "start" to start talking.





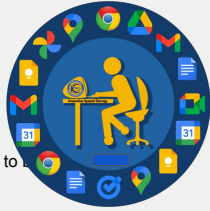
