## AT to Support Attention, Cognition, and Memory

Block distractions, use voice-activated assistants and simplified phones, store info in the cloud, and embrace calendars, photos, and contacts.

## AT to Support Hearing and Auditory Comprehension

Try hearing aids, amplifiers, loop systems, alerting devices, captioning, and video calls.

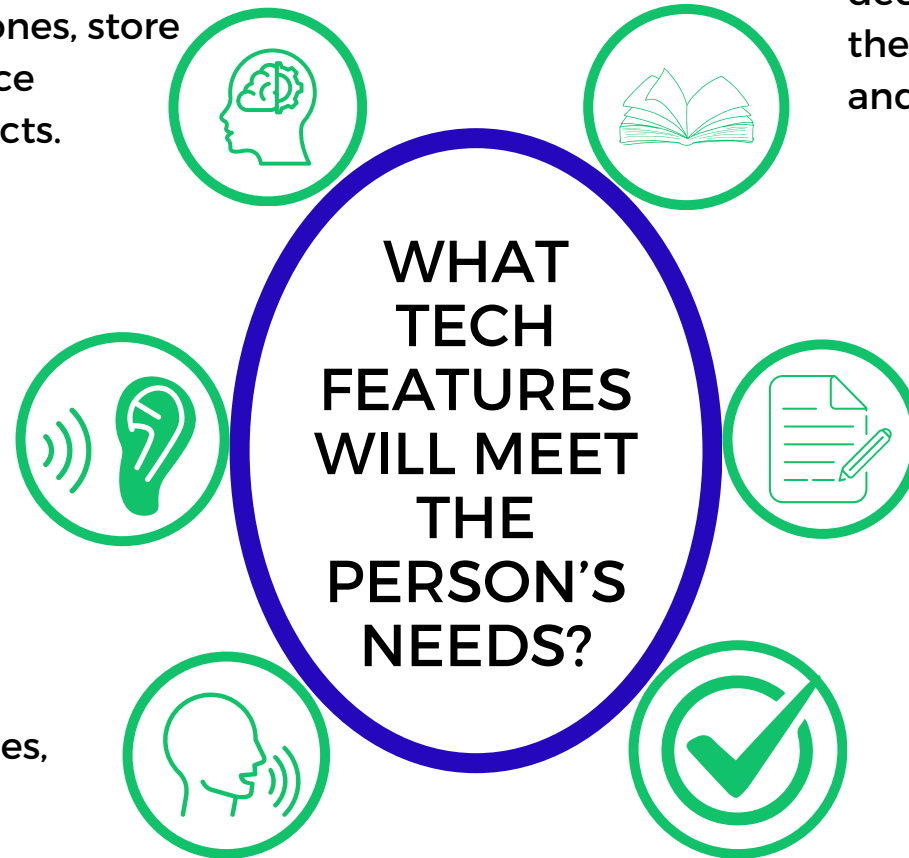
## AT to Support Speaking
