**Let’s talk about God’s power for a minute. How big is God? How powerful is God? How strong is God? Is there anything that God can’t do? God is all powerful, He is the beginning and the end! He spoke this earth into existence, and He could have come into this Earth in all His splendor and glory, in a mighty storm, in a roaring flood, in a fierce fire, with a booming trumpet sound surrounded by an army of angels, right? But He chose to come to be with us in the form of a sweet, humble, miraculous little baby.**
