It's the 13th day of Advent and we see that the angels gave the shepherds a sign to find baby Jesus who is The Christ!

Do you know what "The Christ" means?

It comes from the Greek word Christos, meaning "anointed one" or "chosen one." The Hebrew word that is similar in meaning is "Mashiach" meaning Messiah.

There are hundreds of prophecies regarding Jesus being the Christ or the Messiah, and He fulfilled every single one of them perfectly!

And the sign that the angels gave the shepherds was that they would find baby Jesus in a manger wrapped in swaddling cloths.

PARENT NOTE: to set up for the next activity, use the image on the next page (or you can use your own nativity figurine) and hide the baby Jesus somewhere in your home! It'll be a game of warmer/colder as your children search for Jesus!

Game: You're going to go on a treasure hunt for the greatest treasure in the world! Jesus! He's been hidden somewhere and you'll find Him wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger! Begin searching for Him and as you get closer to where He's been hidden, mom/dad will say "warmer" and as you get farther away from where He's been hidden, they'll say "colder". Listen to the voice of mom/dad and the directions they give you to find Jesus!
