WHAT IS E-RATE

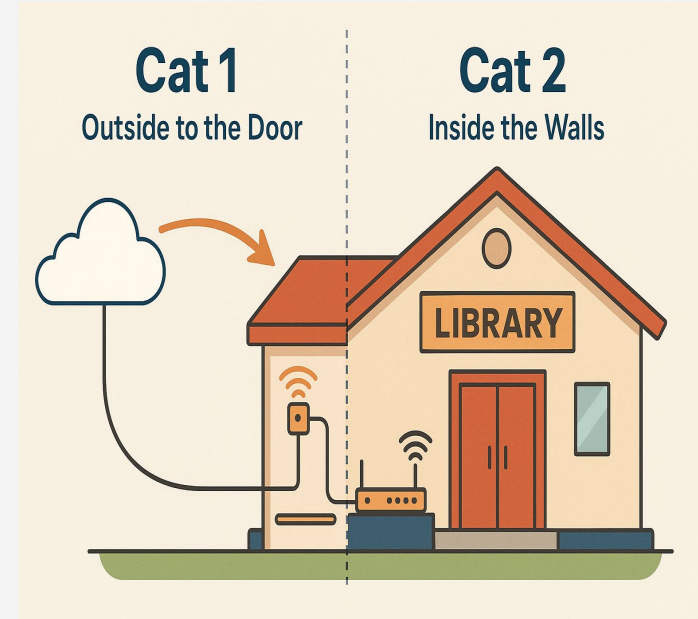
The E-Rate program provides up to 90% discounts on broadband and telecommunications services to ELIGIBLE schools and libraries within the Navajo Nation, funding vital internet access and infrastructure projects that help close the digital divide.

This funding is managed by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) under the supervision of the FCC.



Eligible services

- Category One —Covers the services needed to bring internet **to the building** .
- Category Two —Covers the services and equipment needed to bring internet **inside the building**

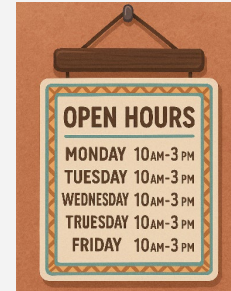


HOW TO BE AN ACTIVE CHAPTER LIBRARY

- **Library Implementation**

- **Requirement:**

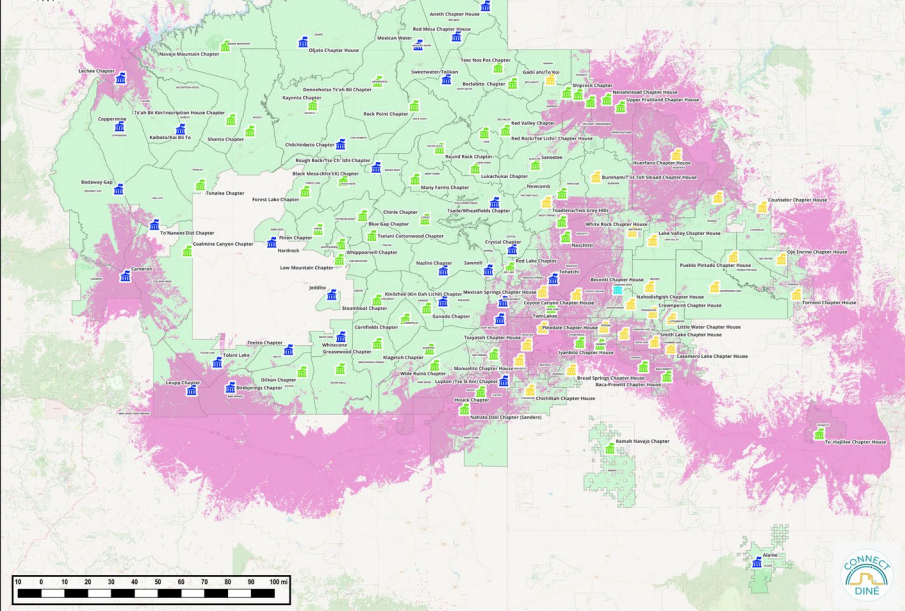

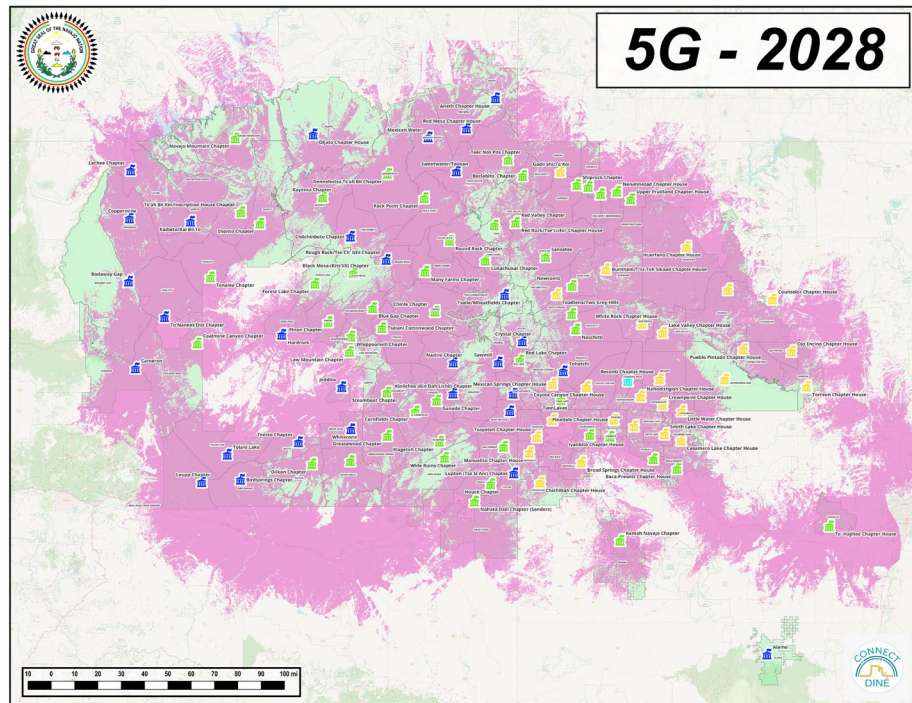
