Retreat Agreement | June 12–14, 2026 | Hocking Hills, Ohio

This Agreement is entered into by and between Jennifer Johnson, Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC, and the Attendee (Client). By registering for and attending the Wild Exhale Retreat, the Attendee agrees to the following terms and conditions.

1. Retreat Overview

The Wild Exhale Retreat is a guided personal growth experience designed to help participants slow down, breathe deeply, and reconnect with themselves through art, meditation, breathwork, gentle movement, and intentional rest.

The retreat includes:

- Accommodations
- All meals, snacks, and non-alcoholic beverages
- Full access to The Arthur property
- All supplies and materials

Any additional personal purchases made during the retreat are the responsibility of the Attendee.

Guided Retreat Experiences

Participants will engage in thoughtfully designed activities that may include:

- Guided meditation and breathwork sessions
- Expressive art sessions including painting, collage, and journaling
- Gentle movement and nature walks
- Group reflection and connection experiences
- Free exploration time and use of all property amenities
- Retreat materials and art supplies

Community and Connection

This retreat is intentionally designed to create a supportive and welcoming environment where participants can connect with other like-minded women while exploring personal growth in a meaningful way.

2. Payment Terms

Full Payment

The full cost of the retreat must be paid no later than June 1, 2026, unless otherwise agreed upon in a payment plan agreement.

Payment Plan

A payment plan option is available as follows:

- Payment 1: Due at registration (secures your spot)
- Payment 2: Due May 1, 2026
- Payment 3: Due June 1, 2026

Non-Refundable Policy

The Wild Exhale Retreat is non-refundable. No refunds will be issued for cancellations, schedule conflicts, personal circumstances, or changes in plans.

3. Photo and Video Release

By signing this agreement, the Attendee grants permission to Jennifer Johnson and Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC to use photographs and video recordings taken during the retreat for marketing, promotional, and educational purposes.

These images may be used in:

- Social media
- Websites
- Promotional materials
- Future retreat marketing

Personal stories or deeply personal content shared during retreat sessions will not be used publicly without additional and explicit consent.

Participants who prefer not to appear in photos or videos should notify Jennifer Johnson in writing prior to the start of the retreat.

4. Waiver of Liability

Participation in retreat activities involves inherent risks. By attending this retreat, the Attendee agrees to release and hold harmless:

- Jennifer Johnson
- Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC
- Any contracted facilitators or support staff
- Assistants or volunteers supporting the retreat
- The property owner or management of The Arthur
- Any third-party service providers associated with the retreat

...from any liability, claims, damages, injuries, or losses that may occur during participation in the retreat. Attendees assume full responsibility for their physical, emotional, and personal well-being during the retreat.

5. Health and Personal Responsibility

By participating in the Wild Exhale Retreat, the Attendee acknowledges that they are voluntarily participating in retreat activities and accepts full responsibility for their own physical, mental, and emotional well-being during the retreat.

The Attendee understands and agrees that:

- The retreat is designed for personal growth, reflection, and connection, and is not intended to replace medical, psychological, or therapeutic care.
- Jennifer Johnson and Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC do not provide medical, psychological, or mental health services.
- The Attendee is responsible for determining whether participation in retreat activities is appropriate for their personal health and well-being.
- If the Attendee has any medical conditions, dietary restrictions, physical limitations, or mental health concerns, they are responsible for consulting with their healthcare provider prior to attending.
- The Attendee agrees to notify Jennifer Johnson in advance of any serious medical conditions, allergies, or accessibility needs that may affect their participation.

6. Property Rules and Responsibility

The retreat will take place at The Arthur, a privately rented property in Hocking Hills, Ohio. By attending the retreat, the Attendee agrees to:

- Respect all property rules established by the property owner
- Respect the space, furnishings, and belongings within the property
- Follow all house rules communicated before or during the retreat

If an Attendee causes damage to the property, the Attendee agrees to assume responsibility for any resulting fines, repair costs, or fees charged by the property owner.

7. Substance Policy

The Wild Exhale Retreat is a drug-free environment. Participants agree not to bring or consume illegal substances during the retreat.

Violation of this policy may result in removal from the retreat without refund.

8. Right to Remove Participant

The Wild Exhale Retreat is designed to be a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all participants. Jennifer Johnson and Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC reserve the right to remove any participant from the retreat at their sole discretion if the participant engages in behavior that is disruptive, unsafe, inappropriate, or violates the policies outlined in this Agreement.

Examples of behavior that may result in removal include, but are not limited to:

- Disrespectful or inappropriate conduct toward other participants or facilitators
- Violation of property rules or retreat guidelines
- Behavior that compromises the safety, well-being, or experience of other participants
- Violation of the substance policy

If a participant is removed from the retreat, no refund will be issued, and the participant will be responsible for any costs related to their early departure.

9. Cancellation and Attendance

Participant Cancellation

If the Attendee cancels their participation for any reason, the retreat fee remains non-refundable.

Late Arrival or Early Departure

If an Attendee arrives late or leaves early, no refunds, credits, or rescheduling will be provided.

10. Confidentiality

Participants agree to respect the confidentiality of all individuals attending the retreat. Personal stories, experiences, and conversations shared during the retreat should remain private unless permission is given by the individual who shared them.

This commitment helps create a safe, trusting, and supportive environment for everyone involved.

11. Limited Liability

Except as expressly stated in this Agreement, Jennifer Johnson and Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC make no guarantees or warranties regarding specific outcomes or results from participation in the retreat.

Under no circumstances shall Jennifer Johnson or Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages. Maximum liability shall not exceed the amount paid by the Attendee for the retreat.

12. Force Majeure

Neither Jennifer Johnson nor Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC shall be held liable for failure to perform obligations under this Agreement if such failure is caused by events beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to:

- Natural disasters or severe weather
- Government restrictions or public health emergencies
- Facility closures or property issues beyond control
- Acts of God

In such circumstances, Jennifer Johnson reserves the right to reschedule the retreat, modify the retreat format, or provide alternative arrangements.

13. Entire Agreement

This document constitutes the entire agreement between the Attendee and Jennifer Johnson / Jenn Johnson Coaching LLC. It supersedes any prior communications, representations, or agreements related to the retreat. This Agreement may only be modified in writing and signed by all parties.

14. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio.

15. Binding Agreement

By registering for and attending the Wild Exhale Retreat, the Attendee acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agree to the terms outlined in this Agreement.
