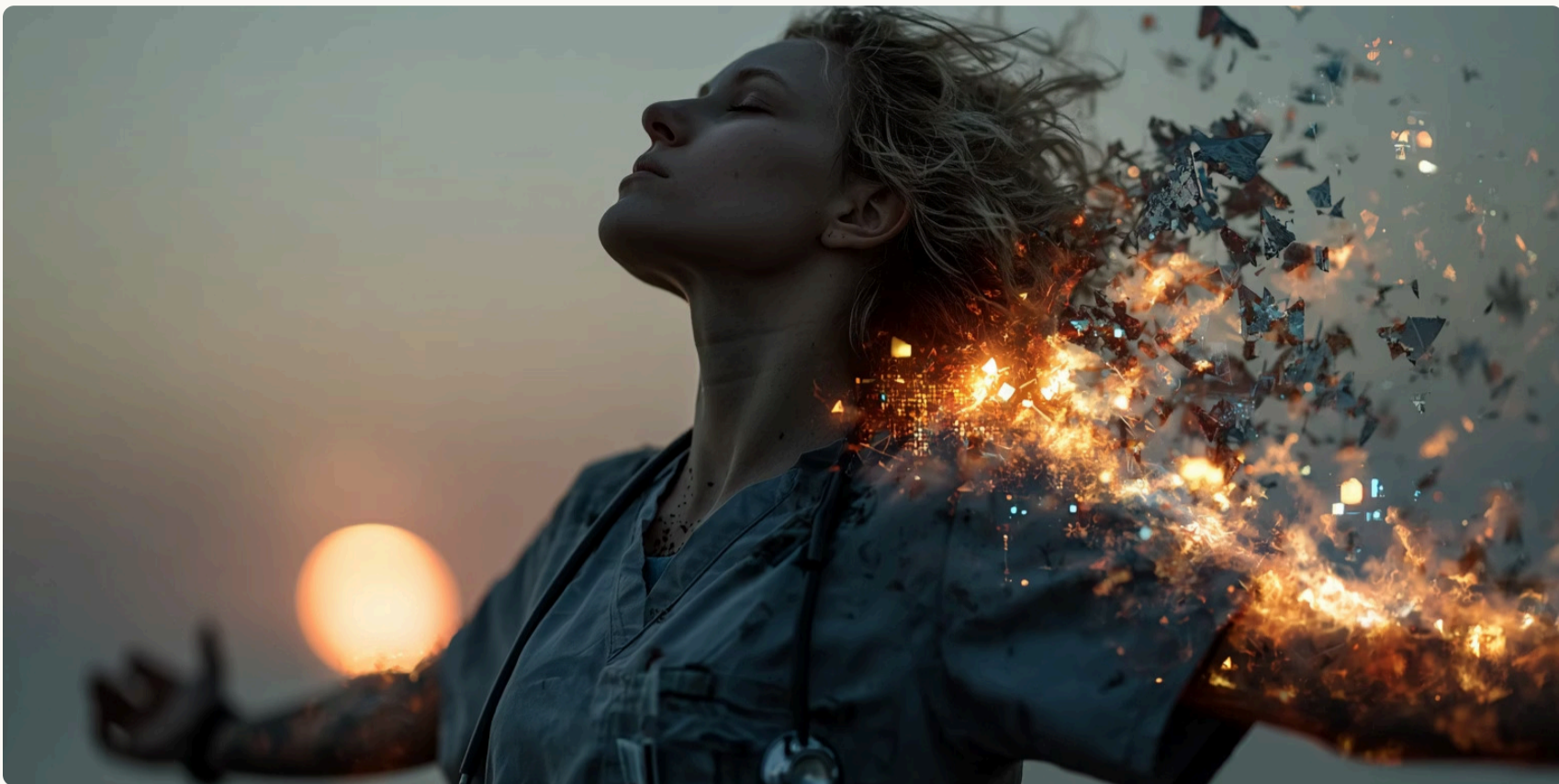

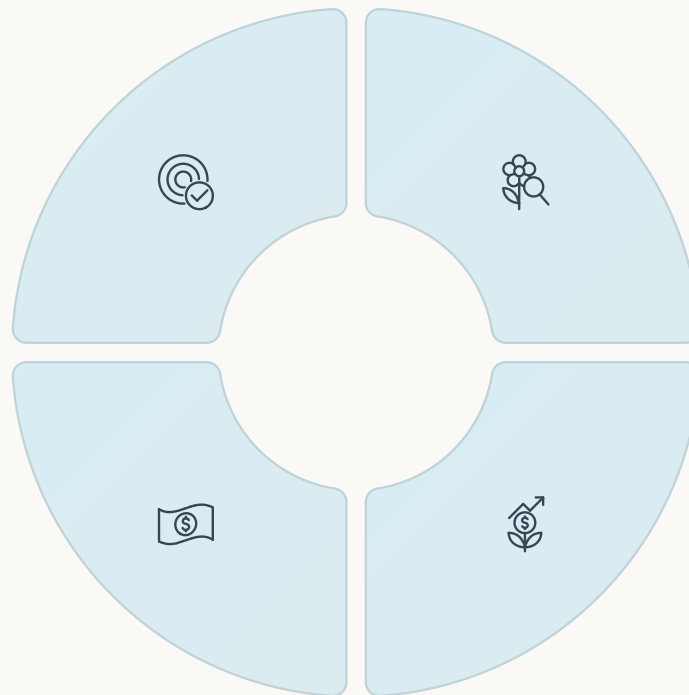

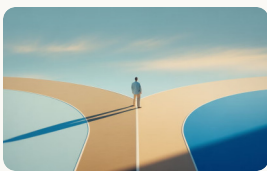

Check Amazon Kindle bestsellers, Etsy digital products, or online course platforms. If similar products exist and sell well, the market is proven.

## Rule 4: The Audience Wants Fast Help

The best niches solve problems people want fixed immediately—stress relief, better sleep, time management, anxiety reduction.

## Validation Strategy

1. Search TikTok hashtags for your niche
2. Check Instagram for engagement on similar content
3. Browse Amazon Kindle for related books
4. Look at Etsy digital products in your category

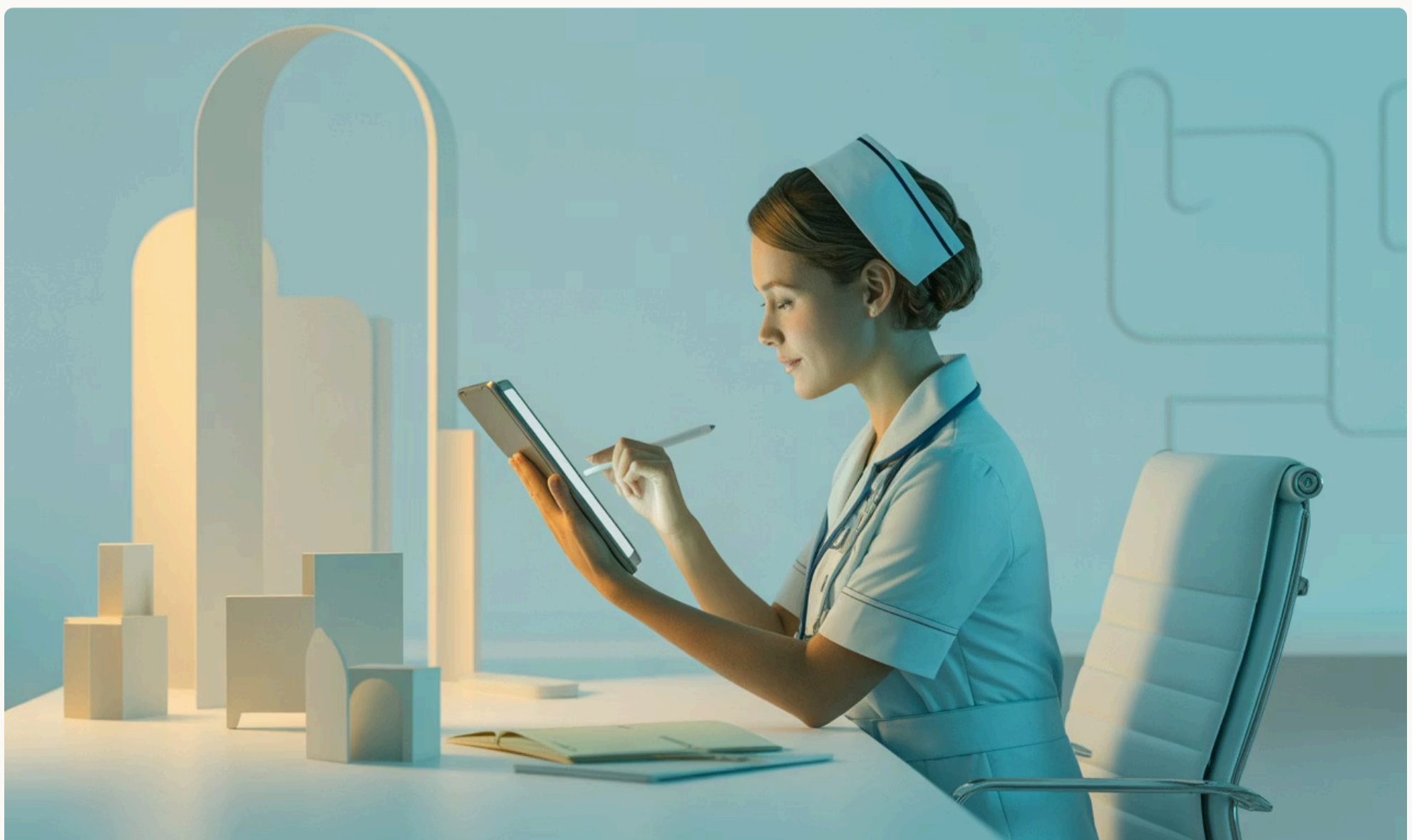

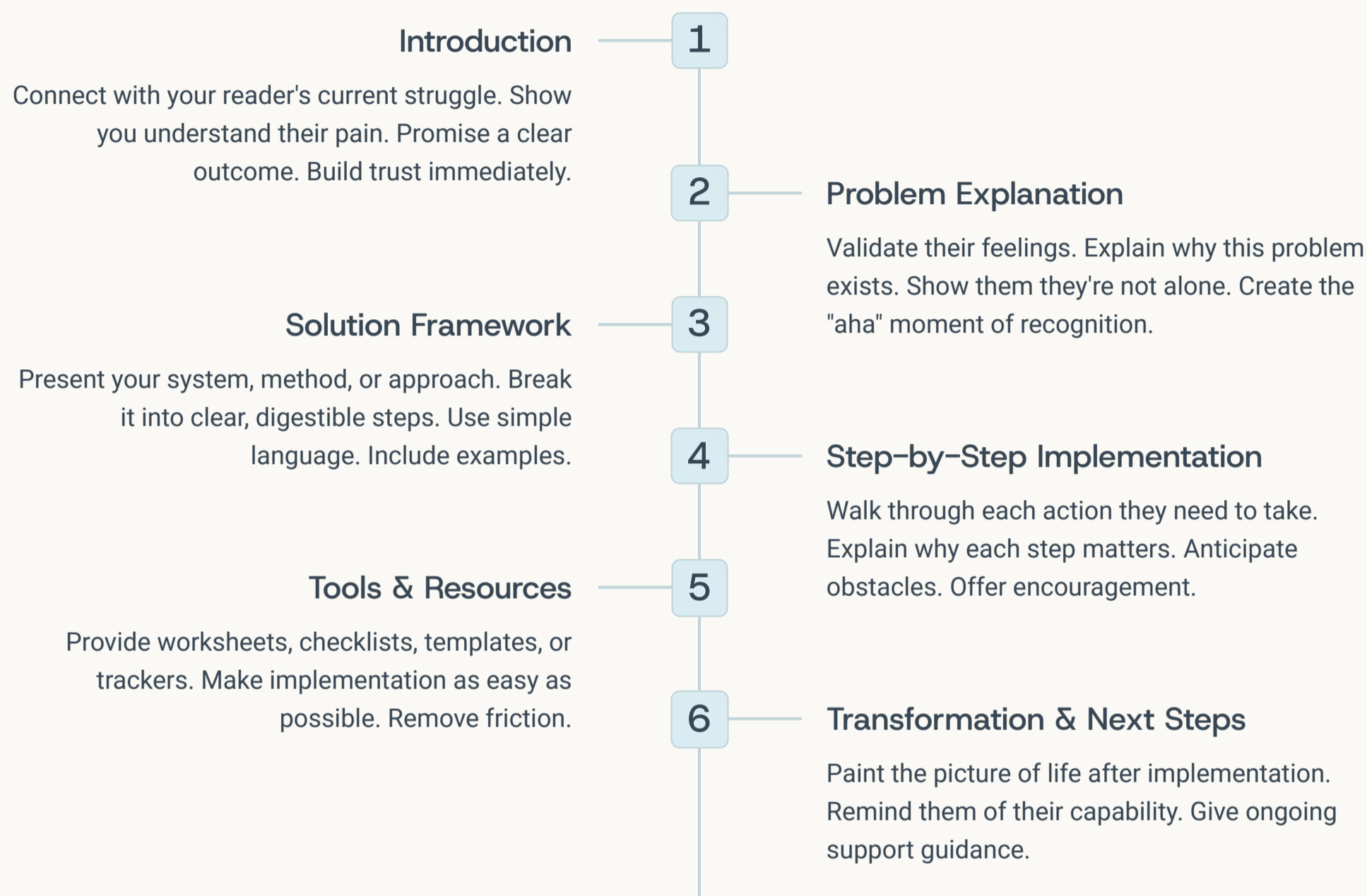
