



How to Download Your Dataset from Google Sheets

Step 1 — Open the Google Sheets Link

Click the dataset link given to you. It will open directly in your browser.

Step 2 — Go to “File” in the Top Menu

In Google Sheets, click **File** in the top-left corner.

Step 3 — Choose “Download”

Hover over **Download** to see file format options.

Step 4 — Select “Comma-separated values (.csv)”

This is the correct format for Python and your Starter Kit.
Google Sheets will automatically download the CSV file.

Step 5 — Find Your Downloaded File

Windows: Check the Downloads folder in File Explorer.

Mac: Open Finder → Downloads.

Chromebook: Files → Downloads.

Step 6 — Use the Dataset in Python or Jupyter Notebook

Make sure the CSV file is in the same folder as your Starter Kit files.

Example code:

```
import pandas as pd
df = pd.read_csv("monthly_raw.csv")
df.head()
```

Important: If your file downloads as “monthly_raw (1).csv”, rename it to **monthly_raw.csv**
