I once worked with James, a business owner in retail, who faced some real issues in this area. His emails were long, meetings unfocused, and instructions overly detailed.

His frustration boiled over when his team started missing key deliverables. "Why can't they just follow what I'm saying?" he exclaimed to me once during a coaching session.

Here's how to simplify:

- Cut unnecessary details: Stick to the essentials. Check with your team what is absolutely necessary and what can easily be left out.

- Use Clear Language: Avoid jargon and technical terms.

- Focus on Key Points: Identify the 1-2 takeaways your audience needs.


When James started practicing concise, actionable language, his team responded much better. When I visited him, a while later, he had become convinced: "If it's not clear, it won't stick."

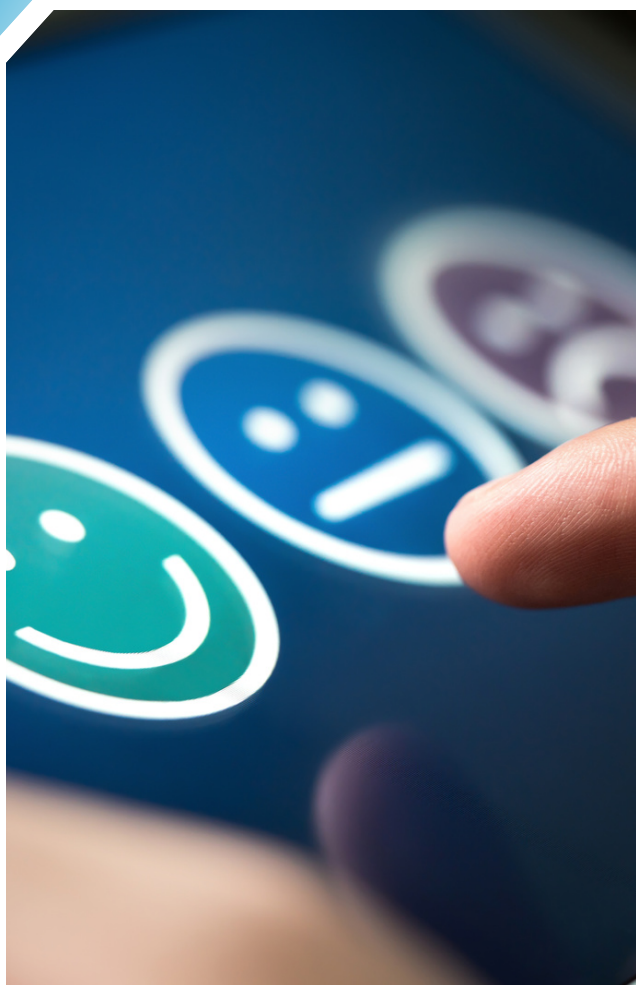

-  Be open to feedback and improvement. Model the behavior you want to see.



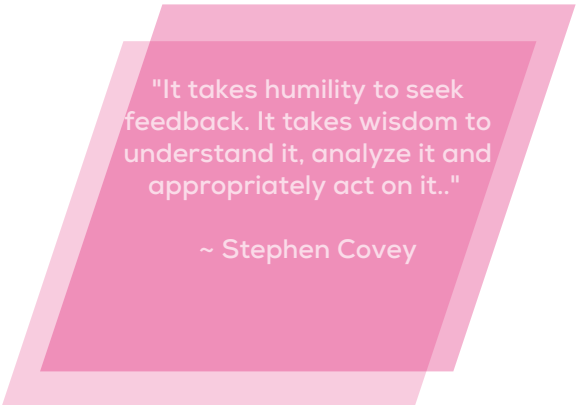
