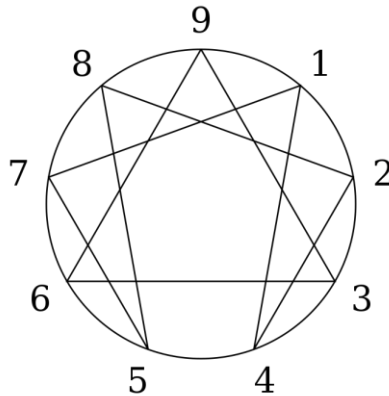

INTRODUCTION TO THE ENNEAGRAM

Origin Of The Enneagram

The word Enneagram is built up of two Greek words: ennea which signifies nine and grammos, point. The Enneagram is a nine-pointed shape star diagram.



The Enneagram is a millennial tool that has arrived to us thanks to Sufism. Its understanding is constantly evolving. It describes the typical functioning of human beings and the conscious and unconscious mechanisms at work in each one of us. The plethora of information provided is incomparable, both in the area of self-knowledge and personal and spiritual development.

Personality Types

The Enneagram describes 9 personality types. Each profile shows behaviors, character traits and emotions specific to its type, which take place in all kinds of situations, while feeling safe or stressed. Among these 9 personality types, there are three instinctive personalities (types 8, 9 and 1), three emotional personalities (types 2, 3 and 4) and three mental personalities (types 5, 6 and 7). The instinctual personalities are dominated by anger, the emotional ones worry about their appearance, while the mental ones are dominated by fear.

Each type has its own fears and sufferings from which it seeks to extricate itself. In order to get there, it acts compulsively in a way specific to its type and by using conscious and unconscious dominant defense mechanisms.

The Enneagram, A Personal Development Tool

The Enneagram allows us to become aware of our defense mechanisms and thereby induces a profound transformation of oneself and allows a more compassionate perception of others.

Facing your fears is the only path to free your soul.

THE ORACLE STRUCTURE

The **Mystical** Enneagram Oracle has 108 cards, a symbolic number that is particularly close to my heart. The number 108 is a perfect sacred number. The symbolic strength of this number is found everywhere in spirituality. In yoga, the 1 represents higher consciousness, the 0 represents nothingness and the 8 represents infinity. The combination of these 3 numbers results in the perfect number 108 which symbolizes awakening.

Since the Enneagram has 9 personality types, I divided the number 108 by 9 to get 12 categories. I decided to build my oracle on the basis of 12 categories comprising the 9 personality types. These categories refer to behaviors and attitudes of each type, whether in ego, evolving or regressing.

Cards Background Colors

Cards with a **black** background (1 to 54) are those based on everyday ego behaviors. The color black symbolizes a foggy mind that has difficulties to see clearly.

The cards with an **orange** background (55 to 81) are those representing behaviors based on a declining attitude. The color orange refers to two concepts. First, it gives you a warning about the direction you are heading to. But regressing behaviors are sometimes beneficial as their lively energy can help you to get out of difficult situations.

The cards on a **white** background (82 to 108) represent behaviors based on an evolving personality. The color white symbolizes a clear and alert mind.

Card Border Colors

Each Enneagram type has its own color to symbolize it:

Type 1: silver - color of sobriety, deep transformation, growth, but also coldness

Type 2: red - color of love, life, strength, passion but also aggression

Type 3: yellow - dynamism, shining, a radiant color that makes it visible, but also the color of betrayal, falsity and madness

Type 4: purple - color of synthesis, mediation, balance, but also of melancholy and suffering

Type 5: blue - color of introversion, calm, distance, but also passivity and stillness

Type 6: beige - color of security, adaptation to the environment, but also of self-denial

Type 7: green - color of vitality, joy of living, health, but also of naive and immature behavior

Type 8: white and black - colors of extreme polarities, but also of lack of compromise and nuance

Type 9: gold - color of the Gods, kings and saints, but also of the need to dive into oneself to find oneself

Card Groups

The **Mystical** Enneagram Oracle cards are divided into three broad groups: **ego** level cards, **stress** level cards, and **growth** cards.

Ego Level Cards: 1 to 54

This group of cards on a black background is divided into 6 categories: the veil of ignorance, the inner call, the awakening of consciousness, the quest for answers, spiritual practices and purification. These categories represent, in order, the first steps of the mystical path. They are experienced at the beginning of the path, the **ego** still dominates the personality. Each card mentions in detail each stage according to the Enneagram personality type. Each card can be interpreted for its positive and negative sides.

These cards therefore have a priori rather neutral energy.

Stress Level Cards: 55 to 81

This group of cards on an **orange** background describes the trials, failings and **regressive** behaviors that each person may encounter on their mystical path. Regression can correspond to the negative aspects of one's own type or to the negative aspects of the personality corresponding to one's regression type. However, it should be noted that sometimes, these energies considered negative can be adequate, appropriate or even salutary in particular circumstances.

Therefore, apart from exceptions, these cards mainly have a rather negative energy.

Growth Level Cards: 82 to 108

This group of cards on a **white** background describes the culmination of the mystical path when mystical experiences are lived, consciousness has awakened and it is time to share this awakening with the rest of Humanity. This **growth** can correspond to the positive and evolved aspects of the own type or to the positive aspects of the personality corresponding to its type of evolution. These cards highlight qualities of being and soul in their pure and conscious aspect.

Therefore, these cards mainly have a positive energy.

Keywords

Each card contains one **primary keyword** written in a large uppercase font and six secondary keywords written in a smaller lowercase font.

The leading keyword refers to the major energy and is the main message of the card. The image illustrates this keyword.

However, as the Enneagram gives many messages, some others more subtle, nuanced or even different are transmitted through **secondary keywords**. Thus, on the stress level cards, you will often read a word more nuanced and more positive than the others.

Take the time to feel the illustration, the leading keyword and also the secondary keywords, there may only be one that contains the message you need. Also, feel free to broaden your perception of each word to make it relevant to your situation.

Card Categories

Cards 1 to 9 - Ego Level: Veil of Ignorance

This category presents how each personality type functions when it is in its ego, its compulsions, its illusions and its erroneous perceptions. The veil of ignorance incites it to act automatically without allowing it to become conscious of its actions and to understand them in the light of enlightened consciousness.

The veil of ignorance represents the very beginning of the mystical path and prevents union with the divine. It can last for years, being stable until the day the person feels an inner call.

Cards 10 to 18 - Ego Level: Inner Call

This category evokes the deep aspiration to seek a higher truth and connect with the divine. It arises from a frustration and a sense of incompleteness in ordinary life, as well as the inability to find serenity and obtain answers to existential questions.

The inner call is considered a manifestation of the soul or higher consciousness which guides the being towards spiritual evolution and awakening.

Cards 19 to 27 - Ego Level: Conscious Awakening

This category presents for each personality type the sudden or gradual realization of its true nature beyond the illusions and limitations of the ego. The reality of the facets of the ego is thus exposed.

Awakening of consciousness is a crucial step in the spiritual journey, marking the beginning of a transformed life aligned with profound spiritual truths.

Cards 28 to 36 - Ego Level: Quest for Answers

This category presents the deep and personal search for understanding and truth concerning the nature of existence, the purpose of life, and the connection with the divine. Each personality type pursues this quest according to their affinities.

The quest for answers involves a deep inner exploration to transcend superficial knowledge and conventional beliefs and reach deeper, more universal truths.

Cards 37 to 45 - Ego Level: Spiritual Practice

This category presents the various disciplines and techniques intended to encourage inner growth, purification of the soul, and union with the divine. They aim to discipline the mind, transcend the desires of the ego, and develop qualities such as love, compassion, and wisdom.

Mystics thus seek to awaken their consciousness, to free themselves from material illusions, and to progress towards a deep and lasting spiritual realization.

Cards 46 to 54 - Ego Level: Purification Path

This category presents the various processes of inner transformation aimed at eliminating impurities from the soul, such as material attachments, selfish desires, and negative thoughts. Each personality type may be led to favor a specific path of purification.

The path of purification helps to clarify the mind and open the heart.

Cards 55 to 63 - Stress Level: Ego's Pitfall

This category presents the major pitfalls to spiritual realization, consisting of excessive identification with the individual self, its desires, fears, and illusions. Each personality type will have a different tendency to fall into these pitfalls.

The ego creates barriers between the individual and divine truth by fostering attachment to material pleasures, personal success, and social distinctions.

Cards 64 to 72 - Stress Level: Initiatory Ordeal

This category presents a phase of intense challenge offered by life and profound transformation that the mystic must go through in order to progress to higher levels of realization. These ordeals may be emotional, mental, or physical in nature, and are intended to test the faith, determination, and sincerity of the aspirant.

Initiatory ordeals serve to purify the soul, strengthen character, and detach the individual from illusions and worldly attachments.

Cards 73 to 81 - *Stress Level*: Dark Night of the Soul

This category describes a period of profound spiritual crisis and inner desolation, where the aspirant experiences an intense sense of loss, emptiness, and separation from the divine. This stage is marked by doubts, emotional suffering, and a feeling of abandonment, but it is also a purifying and transformative process. By going through this ordeal, the soul strips itself of its illusions, attachments, and ego, opening the way to greater clarity, renewed faith, and a more intimate union with the divine.

The Dark Night of the Soul is often seen as a necessary step in reaching higher levels of spiritual awareness and mystical realization.

Cards 82 to 90 - *Growth Level* : Mystical Experience

This category presents various direct and transformative perceptions of divine reality, characterized by a feeling of profound oneness with the universe and the divine. These experiences transcend the limitations of the ego and the material world, offering an intuitive and immediate knowledge of spiritual truth. They can occur spontaneously or as a result of dedicated spiritual practices and are generally described as ineffable and overwhelming.

These experiences strengthen faith, modify the perception of reality, and lead to a lasting transformation of the individual.

Cards 91 to 99 - *Growth Level*: Mystical Union

This category presents the culmination point where the individual experiences a total fusion with the divine, transcending all duality and separation. It is an experience of deep and direct communion with ultimate reality, usually described as a fusion of the individual soul with the Absolute or with God. This mystical union goes beyond the limits of rational thought and words, offering a direct perception of universal truth and infinite love.

Mystical union is considered the supreme culmination of the spiritual journey, marking a radical transformation of consciousness and a profound spiritual accomplishment.

Cards 100 to 108 - Growth Level: Return to the World

This category describes the phase in which the individual, after having had mystical experiences or attained high levels of consciousness, re-enters daily life with new spiritual discernment and a renewed mission. This return involves applying spiritual insights in daily interactions, serving others with compassion and wisdom, and contributing to the betterment of the world.

It is a process of practicing spiritual teachings in actions and relationships, while maintaining a balance between inner contemplation and active engagement in the world.

Cards Illustrations

The paintings that illustrate each card were carefully chosen by me in order to best represent the dominant notion of the card, the one conveyed by the main keyword. Indeed, it should be noted that each card mentions several different ideas and concepts while the image only represents one.

The first category is illustrated with characters from daily life because it evokes human life under the veil of ignorance and dominated by the ego.

The categories inner call, spiritual awakening and pitfall of the ego are illustrated using images of saints or religious persons, thus evoking the beginning of their mystical path, the desire of the saints to achieve awakening as well as the difficulties encountered at the level of their ego, in memory of their mystical path.

Finally, all the following categories are illustrated with paintings relating the life of Jesus. I made this choice because the character of Jesus touches me deeply and represents for me the culmination of a mystical path to its most ultimate awakening, thus embodying true unconditional love.

Each illustration is cropped in a square format. None show the entire original painting. In addition, the contrast has been adjusted on all images. Please find the complete index and references of each image at the end of this booklet.

The Enneagram Figure On Each Card

All cards show the basic Enneagram figure as shown on page 2. In order not to overload the cards, only a simple representation of the Enneagram diagram illustrates each card.

In addition, the number of the personality type corresponding to the message on the card is in a larger font than the other numbers and in the symbolic color of the type concerned.

HOW TO START

Getting Ready For The Oracle Spread

When spreading the Oracle cards, respect this special moment in which you enter, your own privacy or that of the person for whom you are consulting. A serene and relaxed atmosphere will be appreciated in order to enhance the receptivity of your mind, your openness to receive and understand the messages transmitted during the reading.

Thus, it is recommended to find a quiet place and to cut yourself off from any distractions that may interfere with the consultation. Settle down into a comfortable chair in front of a clean table. You can also, if you wish, place a small mat on the table in order to place the Oracle cards on and light candles or incense to create an atmosphere conducive to welcoming messages.

You can also set up a ritual to allow you to step out of your daily routine and enter the spiritual world of fortune telling. Take a moment to relax before the session, take a few conscious breaths, and let your body, mind and emotions calm down. Then hold the deck of cards in your hands and summon the Spirit of the Oracle to guide you as you read and understand the revealed cards.

Spreading The Oracle Cards For Yourself

It is possible to have a reading for yourself. Take care to phrase your questions avoiding the first-person singular. When spreading the cards, use your first name, in order to distance emotionally from yourself, so that the appropriate response will reveal itself.

Tips For Asking The Right Questions

First of all, be aware that you don't have to ask the Oracle a question. Sometimes, simply trusting the spontaneous message can be meaningful and relevant. As an illustration, in the morning, you can start your day by reading a card which will reflect your mood or, before a meeting or a particular event read a card to better understand the vibration in which the event will evolve.

You can, of course, ask a question, if you please. It is therefore recommended to ask a clear and precise question in order to obtain a clear answer. Thus, be careful that your question contains only one subject. Set your priority and keep the question simple and short.

Reading Of The Oracle Spreads

The reading is above all very personal and can be done using keywords, images, as well as your intuition and your own feelings. Let go of your intellect and trust gut feeling.

ORACLE SPREADS

Three-card oracle spread



Three-card oracle spread is used to quickly clear up a situation. Shuffle the cards well, spread them out on the table or keep them in one hand and arrange them as shown above. You can cover each of the cards with additional cards to get more accuracy.

There are several options available to you:

Your Path to Spiritual Awakening: Taking Stock

This spread is intended to take stock of your mystical journey towards the awakening of consciousness. Here is the interpretation of your situation:

card 1: difficulties or blockages

card 2: the current energy

card 3: evolving aspects

Your Mystical Journey: Evolution

This spread allows you to take stock of the progress of your path towards awakening:

card 1: the past, what is behind, what is accomplished or what is finished

card 2: the present, the current energy, the dynamics of awareness

card 3: the future, what is coming, the challenges to be taken up, the possible or probable evolution

Stagnation on Your Path: Advice

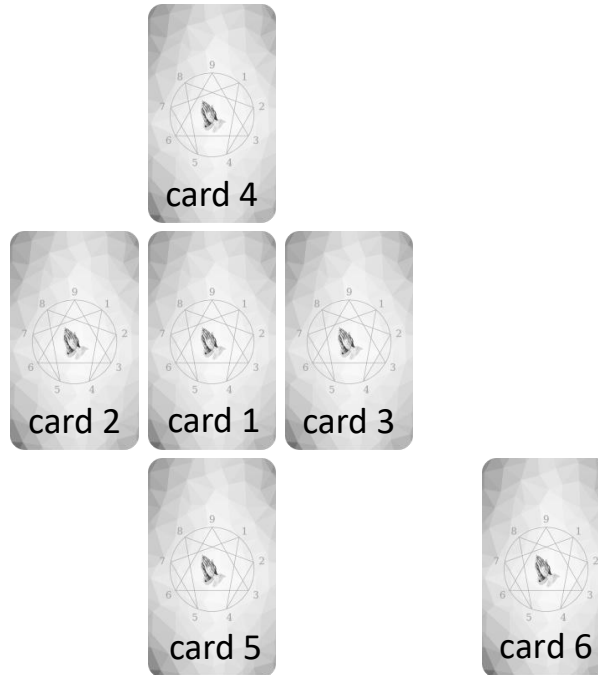
This spread is intended for people who are struggling on their path to spiritual awakening and who wish to take a quick look. Here is the interpretation:

card 1: the person's current state of mind regarding their path

card 2: the advice

card 3: the probable short-term evolution of the situation of the person in difficulty if they follow the advice

Cross Oracle Spread



The cross oracle spread is very powerful as it symbolizes the human being between heaven and earth. It allows you to have a detailed answer to a question. You have several options:

During an ordeal on the path: answer to a question regarding your spiritual evolution by questioning the strengths and obstacles

card 1: redefines the question, specifies it or targets it.

card 2: what is favorable to the situation or to the resolution of the ordeal. Interpret this card in its positive aspect.

card 3: what is unfavorable to the situation or the obstacles encountered. Interpret this card in its negative aspect.

card 4: the advice to follow or the warning to take into account.

card 5: the answer to the question or the resolution of the ordeal.

A look at your spiritual path by revealing the unconscious and the conscious

card 1: your current situation.

card 2: what influences you on an unconscious level, what you are not aware of on your path. Interpret this card in its positive or negative aspect.

card 3: what influences you on a conscious level. Interpret this card in its positive or negative aspect.

card 4: influence of the Universe on your path.

card 5: the possible or probable evolution.

card 6: the advice.

Material or professional ordeal: how to interpret it in the light of the mystical path

card 1: unconscious blockage to the flow of money or professional development

card 2: conscious blockage to the flow of money or professional development

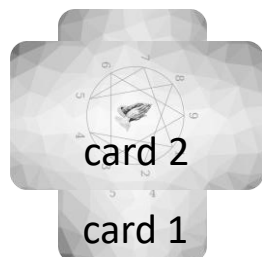
card 3: your desires, dreams, projects and wishes

card 2: the blockages

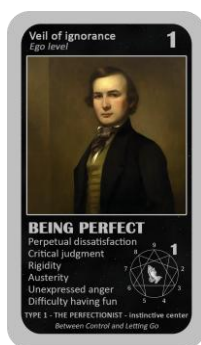
card 3: the influences from the recent past

CARD 1: BEING PERFECT



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to act in the hope of achieving a certain perfection. You may behave in a critical, austere, or even rigid way. Chronic dissatisfaction or unexpressed anger can thus manifest itself in a roundabout way. This card also sometimes evokes the fact of having difficulty allowing yourself pleasures, due to a certain requirement towards yourself.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true notion of perfection and the hidden reasons that motivates you to want to be perfect. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

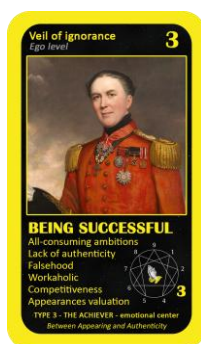
CARD 2: BEING USEFUL



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to act in the hope of feeling useful to others. A need for recognition, a misplaced pride can also push you to want to save others, sometimes against their will. You can also fall into the trap of emotional dependence. This card also evokes the fact of forgetting yourself for the benefit of the needs of others which may appear to be priorities.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true reason that motivates you to want to feel useful and to help others at all costs. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

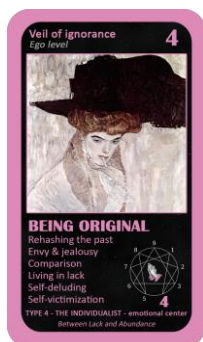
CARD 3: BEING SUCCESSFUL



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to do everything possible to succeed or to have the feeling of success. Your ambitions and your taste for competition can lead you to work extremely hard to the point of neglecting other aspects of your life. You may also lie in order to succeed. This card also evokes the valuation of appearances and external image.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true reason that motivates you to want to succeed at all costs, to shine brighter than others. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

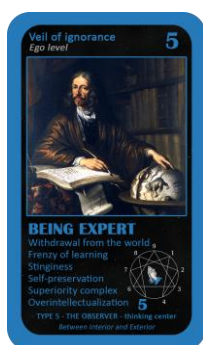
CARD 4: BEING ORIGINAL



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to act in the hope of standing out from others and being noticed for your originality and difference. You may have a tendency to compare yourself to others and feel envy or jealousy, which makes you live in lack and feeling like a victim. This card also evokes rehashing the past or living in illusions.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true reason behind wanting to stand out from the crowd and having a constant feeling of lack. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

CARD 5: BEING EXPERT

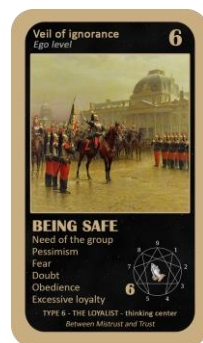


When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to want to explain everything with your mind and to do everything to understand what you are experiencing. You may learn and inform yourself a lot, to the point of overintellectualizing events. Doing this, you may tend to isolate yourself too much.

This card also evokes the possibility of behaving greedily, whether with material goods, but also with your time and your knowledge.

Here, the veil of ignorance here does not allow to understand the true reason behind the need to understand and know everything. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

CARD 6: BEING SAFE

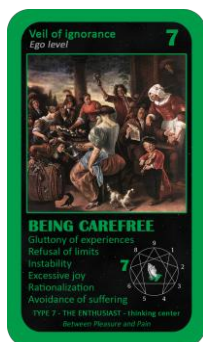


When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to do all you can to feel safe and protected from all possible risks. Fear and pessimism inhabit you, so you refuse to doubt and put everything in place to reassure yourself.

This card also evokes the excessive need to belong to a group, whether it is a family or a circle of friends. Out of loyalty to this group, you may behave in a very obedient manner.

Here, the veil of ignorance here does not allow to understand the true reason behind this strong need for security and belonging to a reference group. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

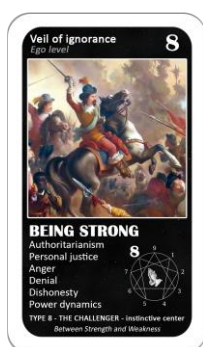
CARD 7: BEING CAREFREE



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to act in a carefree and light-hearted way, without headaches. Suffering does not interest you, you prefer the pleasures of life and living as many exciting experiences as possible. You claim to be an epicurean, joyful, positive and optimistic. This card also evokes the fact of being unstable in one's projects, one's relationships and one's desires in general. Also a tendency to rationalize.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true reason behind chasing the pleasures of life. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

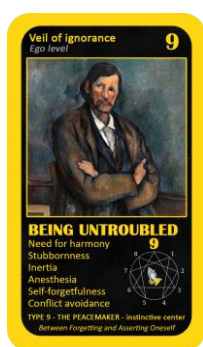
CARD 8: BEING STRONG



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to want to appear strong in all circumstances. Your relationships can be dominated by power dynamics, and also be tinged with anger and authoritarianism. This card also evokes the possibility of behaving dishonestly, driven by a sense of justice that is yours. You can also fall into denial of reality and only see what matches your vision of things.

Here, the veil of ignorance here does not allow to understand the true reason behind the need to appear powerful, strong and dominate others. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

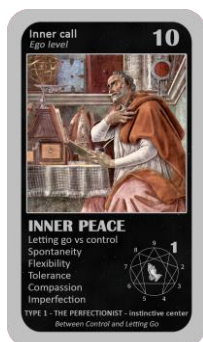
CARD 9: BEING UNTROUBLED




When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, the veil of ignorance prompts you to do everything possible to feel calm and at peace. You don't want to be disturbed, rushed or destabilized. You seek comfort and harmony, and avoid any conflict. You may also be passive, or even display unflinching inertia. This card also evokes the possibility of being stubborn or headstrong. You don't easily change your opinion or idea.

Here, the veil of ignorance does not allow to understand the true reason behind this need for tranquility. Awareness-raising work is necessary.

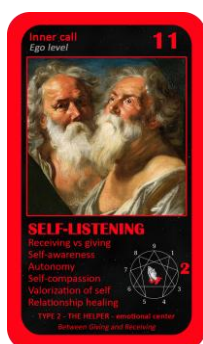
CARD 10: INNER PEACE




When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to precisely find your inner peace. You realize that your usual attitude and behavior keep you away from this peace. Now you want to learn how to be more tolerant, flexible, compassionate and spontaneous than you currently are. You would like to know how to let go and no longer be pushed to control everything.

 *The inner call for more inner peace pushes you to question your usual behavior. You are on the verge of a great change.*

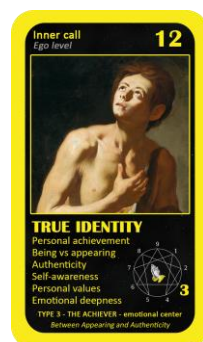
CARD 11: SELF-LISTENING




When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to listen to yourself more. You feel that it is time and that you need to turn your gaze and attention towards yourself in order to learn to value yourself, to be more aware of yourself, to have more compassion for yourself and to become more autonomous. You realize that your way of being in relationships needs to change, to evolve and that a new balance between giving and receiving must be found, without you feeling guilty.

 *The inner call to listen more to yourself pushes you to question your usual behavior. You are on the verge of a great change.*

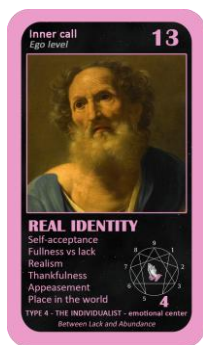
CARD 12: TRUE IDENTITY



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to find your true identity. You feel pushed to become more aware of who you really are, to discover your true authenticity and to dive deeper into your emotional life. You feel that it is also time to question your personal values, your achievements but also the difference, as it begins to appear to you, between the true being that you are and what you appear to be.

 *The inner call to find your true identity pushes you to question your usual behavior. You are on the verge of a great change.*

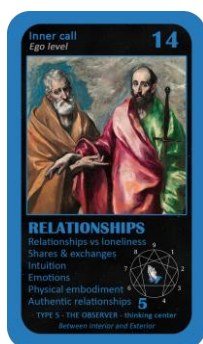
CARD 13: REAL IDENTITY



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to find your true identity. You feel pushed to accept yourself more as you are and to find inner peace. In continuity, you begin to question your place in this world and want to be more connected to reality. You would finally like to feel a fullness inside of you and be able to let a natural feeling of gratitude emerge.

The inner call to find your true identity pushes you to question the vision you have of yourself and the world. You are on the verge of a great change.

CARD 14: RELATIONSHIPS



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to further develop your relational skills. You feel pushed to open up to more authentic relationships, to share and exchange more with others as well as to more consider the emotional aspect of your life and your relationships. On the other hand, you begin to realize that it would also be important to consider your body more and the fact that you are physically incarnated in this vehicle for the duration of your existence.

The inner call towards more relationships and respect for the body pushes you to question your usual behavior. You are on the verge of a great change.

CARD 15: TRUST



When this card shows up, it means that in the current situation, you feel an inner call to find a way to feel more confident. 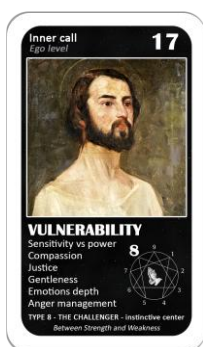
CARD 16: IN-DEPTH

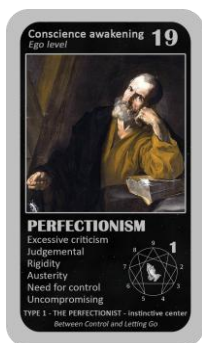
CARD 18: SELF-AWARENESS

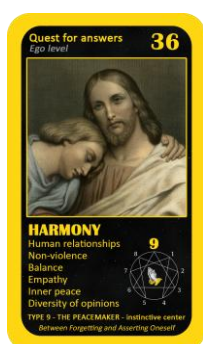
CARD 35: POWER

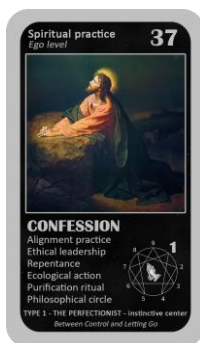
CARD 36: HARMONY

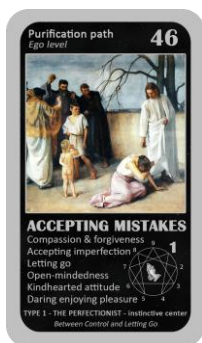
CARD 45: BAPTISM

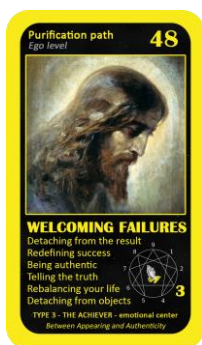

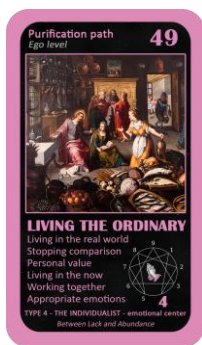

Accepting ordinary life and the present will allow you to maintain your connection to reality, to remain grounded and to realize that you are worth as much as others in this experience shared by all.

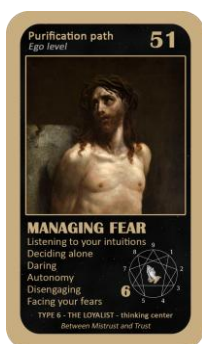
CARD 50: SHARING KNOWLEDGE

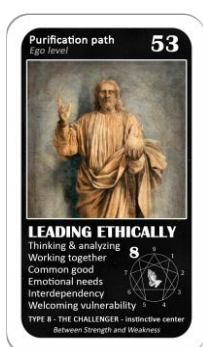

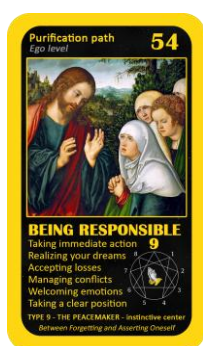
CARD 53: LEADING ETHICALLY

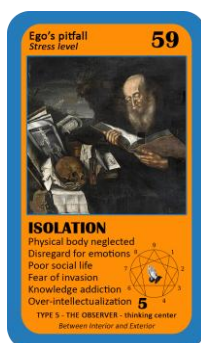
CARD 58: NEGLECTED DAILY LIFE

Isolating yourself too much, neglecting your body and your emotions and over-intellectualizing are ego traps to prevent you from evolving in consciousness. Be vigilant.

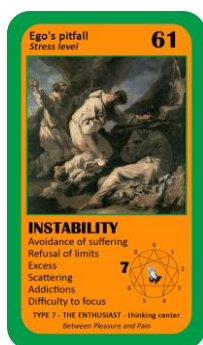
CARD 60: CONFUSION

Being unstable, unfocused, prone to addictions and refusing suffering are ego traps to keep you in superficiality. Be vigilant.

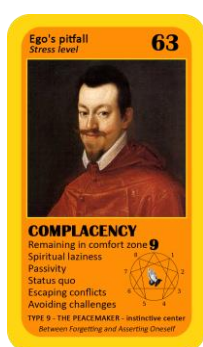
CARD 62: DOMINATION

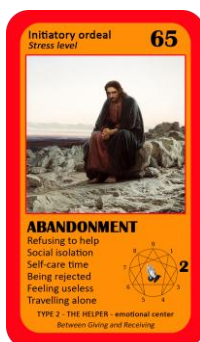
CARD 64: MISTAKE

- The original color has been modified several times to obtain 10 different variations: gray, red, yellow, purple, blue, green, white, gold and black.

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The Mystical Enneagram Oracle features 12 themes and 9 cards in each thematic. In total, there are 108 cards, a symbolic number. The number 108 is a perfect number, it is sacred. The symbolic strength of this number is found everywhere in spirituality. In yoga, the number 1 represents higher consciousness, the number 0 is emptiness and the number 8 is infinity. The combination of these 3 numbers results in the perfect number 108 which symbolizes awakening.
