# When is the best time to visit?

The most popular times for tourism in Sedona is Spring and Fall. Monsoon season is June-Aug.

Expect more crowds and traffic from 2/15-5/15 and Labor Day - Thanksgiving.

Other times of the year are also very enjoyable, and temperatures are fairly moderate.

Sedona sits at 4,500 feet so cools down at night and even snows in the winter.

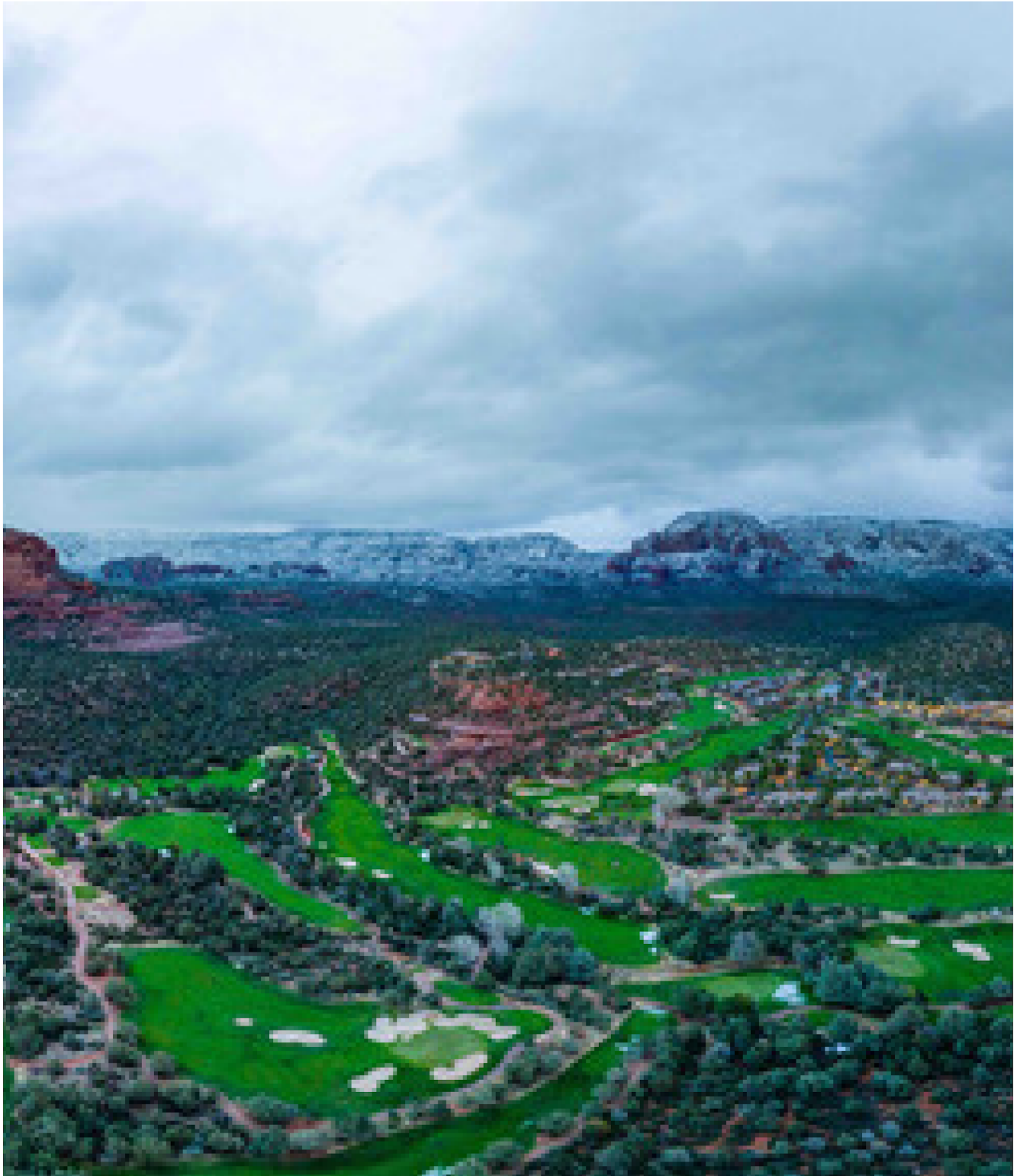

## DEVIL'S BRIDGE

THE MOST POPULAR TRAIL IN SEDONA FOR THE VIEW AT THE END. PARK AT MESCAL TRAILHEAD FOR AN OVERALL BETTER HIKE AND LEAVE AT SUNRISE TO AVOID CROWDS.

## BELL ROCK/COURTHOUSE BUTTE

2 LARGE PARKING LOTS ON THE BEGINNING OF TOWN MAKE THIS AREA A POPULAR DESTINATION. EASY FLAT HIKING AROUND THESE FEATURES UNLESS YOU CHOOSE TO SCRAMBLE UP BELL ROCK.



## BOYNTON CANYON

A GORGEOUS CANYON WHERE YOU CAN HIKE 6 MILES ROUNDTrip TO THE END OF IT. IT GETS CROWDED BUT IT'S A LARGE CANYON SO IT OFTEN DOESN'T FEEL AS CROWDED AS IT IS ONCE PEOPLE SPREAD OUT.

## SOLDIER'S PASS

THIS TRAILHEAD HAS A TINY PARKING LOT AND IS MOSTLY ACCESSIBLE BY THE FREE SHUTTLE. SOME NICE FEATRES ALONG THIS HIKE INCLUDE SEVEN SACRED POOLS AND DEVIL'S KITCHEN.

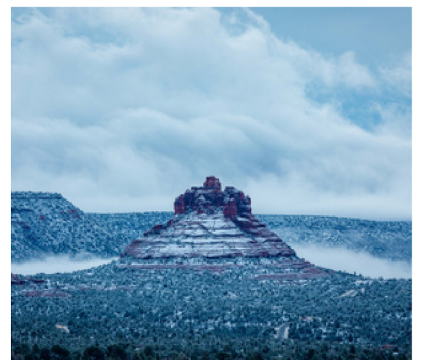


## GRASSHOPPER POINT

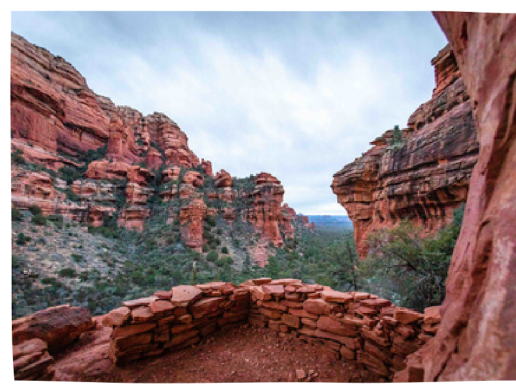
## THE CRACK AT WET BEAVER

SEDONA HAS A RICH HISTORY OF ANCIENT CIVILIZATIONS WITH EVIDENCE OF HUMANS LIVING HERE AS FAR BACK AS 10,000 YEARS AGO.

THE AREA IS HOME TO HUNDREDS OF ANCIENT RUINS DATING BACK 1,000 YEARS OF MORE.
