- Be specific with industry, location, and demographic details
- Combine multiple prompts for comprehensive ideation
- Use follow-up prompts to refine promising ideas
- Keep an idea journal to track all generated concepts
- Research existing solutions before getting too attached to an idea

#### **Best Practices:**

- Start with 3-5 different prompt categories
- Generate 50+ ideas before evaluating any
- Focus on problems you personally understand
- Consider your available resources and skills
- Validate ideas with potential customers early
