



A Beginner's Guide: Upload a 5X5 Photo Book to Blurb

Printing a photo book through **Blurb** is a straightforward process once your pages are designed. Whether you created your layout in Photoshop, Affinity Photo, Canva, or another design program, the final step is preparing and uploading your files for print.

Below is a simple step-by-step overview.

Step 1. Prepare Your Photo Book Files

Before uploading, make sure your project meets [Blurb's basic printing requirements](#).

Key things to check:

- Your book has **at least 20 pages** (the minimum for Blurb photo books).
 - Image resolution is **300 DPI (300 DPI recommended)**.
 - Images are **JPG** format files
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Step 2. Create a Blurb Account

If you don't already have one:

1. Go to **Blurb.com**
2. Click **Sign Up**
3. Create a free account

Once logged in, you'll be able to upload and order your book.

Step 3. Choose How You Want to Upload Your Book

Use Blurb's Free BookWright Software

- Import layouts
- Add text
- Arrange pages

- Upload directly to Blurb

Step 4. Preview the Book

Blurb provides a preview tool so you can check:

- Trim edges
- Bleed areas
- Page order
- Image quality

Blurb recommends reviewing every page carefully because **they do not edit or correct files before printing.**

Step 5. Order Your Photo Book

Once everything looks correct:

1. Choose the number of copies
2. Add the book to your cart
3. Complete checkout

Your printed photo book will then be produced and shipped to you.
