Screen Recording Success Tips



Plan First

Use a script or bullet outline to avoid costly rework and ensure your message flows smoothly from start to finish.



Quiet Environment

Background noise kills video quality. Find a quiet space and/or use noise-canceling tools.



Good Lighting

Natural light or a quality ring light dramatically improves your video recording.



Clean Background

Keep your background tidy and professional, or leverage virtual backgrounds.



Test Before Recording

Save time by checking all your setting before hitting record.



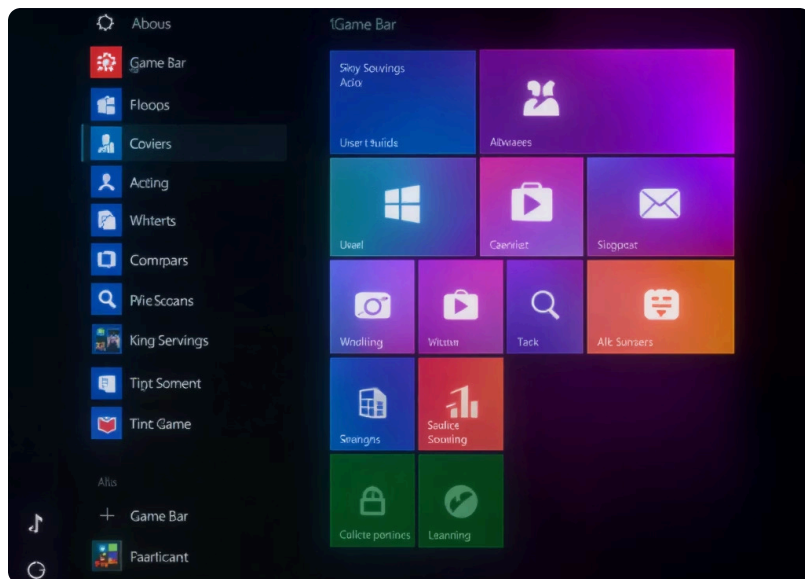
Pro Tip: Consider using teleprompter apps like Teleprompter Pro, BigVu, or PromptSmart for on-screen guidance during longer recordings.

Use annotations to emphasize key points during tutorials.

Built-in Screen Recording Solutions

Before investing in third-party software, explore the recording tools built into your operating system. Both Windows and Mac offer native solutions that can handle many recording scenarios.

Windows: Xbox Game Bar



The Xbox Game Bar is ideal for recording games or simple screen activity with minimal setup required.

- Built into Windows 10 and 11
- Quick access with Windows + G
- Simple one-click recording

⊗ **Limitation:** Cannot record screen and webcam simultaneously

Mac: QuickTime Player



QuickTime Player supports simultaneous webcam and screen recording, making it more versatile than the Windows option.

- Pre-installed on all Macs
- Supports multiple input sources
- Easy-to-use interface
- Export in various formats

⚠ **Note:** May produce inconsistent video/audio sync in longer recordings

Recording with Zoom: A Complete Walkthrough



Zoom is a powerful video conferencing platform, you may already use. It also doubles as an excellent screen recording tool. It enables users to capture high-quality recordings locally or to cloud storage, with options to stream directly to platforms like YouTube.

1

Prepare Your Environment

Review the **Screen Recording Success Tips**, Open Zoom (desktop app), prepare your presentation in windowed mode, enable microphone and optional webcam.

2

Start Solo Meeting

Start a new Zoom meeting (solo).

3

Share and Record

Click "Share Screen" and select your slides, etc, then click "More" → "Record on this Computer" to begin capturing your presentation.

4

Deliver Content

Present your material, smile at the end to make post record trimming easier.

5

Finish and Process

Stop recording and end the meeting. Zoom automatically creates both an .mp4 video file and an .m4a audio-only file .

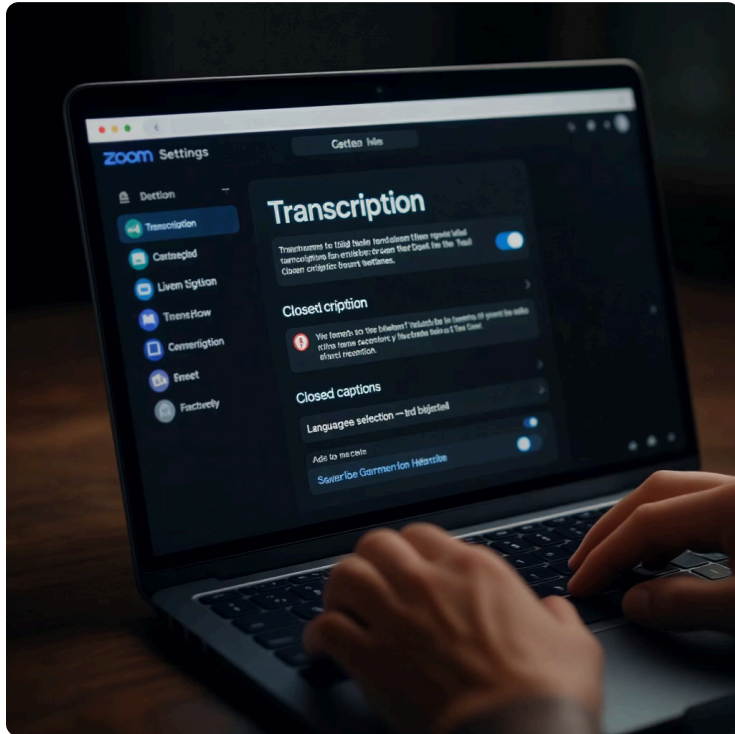
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Trim /Edit your video with QuickTime or your preferred editor for a polished result.



Pro Tips: Your face appearing in the corner of the screen significantly increases viewer engagement.

Enable Zoom Transcription



Enable Auto-Generated Transcripts

Zoom Pro plans and higher offer automatic transcript generation, making your content more accessible and searchable.

- Navigate to Settings → Recording
- Turn on "Audio Transcript"
- Receive .vtt transcript file after processing

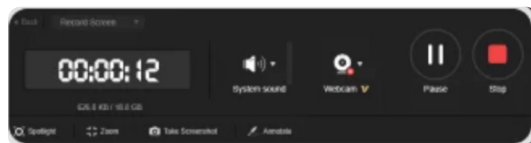

WPS Office Screen Recorder

WPS Screen Recorder is a free, high-quality screen recording tool available across multiple platforms including Windows, Mac, Linux, iOS, and Android. It's designed to capture comprehensive content including entire screens, specific windows, or custom areas while supporting simultaneous webcam, system audio, and microphone recording.

What You Need

- WPS Office - Recording feature is included in WPS
- No additional installation required
- No watermarks or time limits



Simple Recording Steps

1. Launch via WPS > Tools > Screen Recorder
2. Configure recording area, webcam, and audio settings
3. Click REC to begin your capture
4. Use built-in editing tools to trim and annotate
5. Stop Recording and Export in MP4, AVI, or MOV formats
6. Use built-in editing tools (trim, annotate) or your favorite editor if needed



Pro Tip: Smile at the end of your recording to make trimming easier, and consider showing your face in the corner to boost engagement.

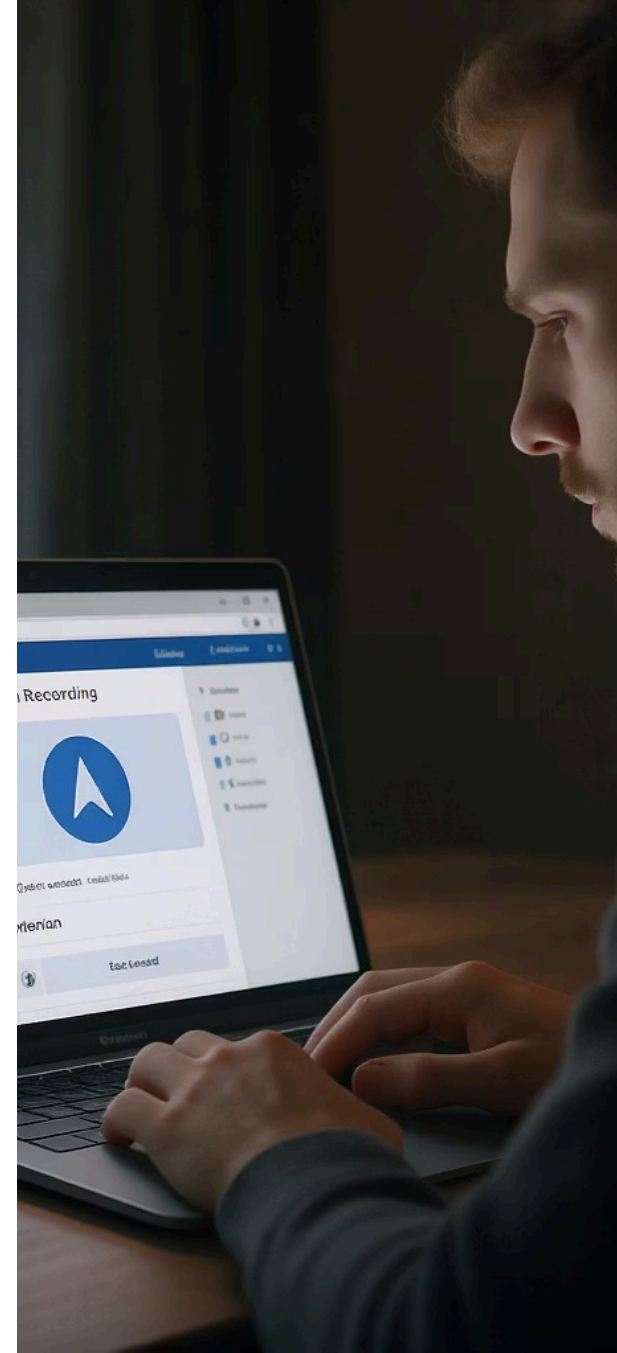
