What's all this love stuff? Why bother? Does anyone really love anyone anymore?

First, please know that every day I am pressing to live this 'Love Driven' life to God's glory!

Today we all want the perfect FICO Score, the best credit. We take classes, employ attorneys, file bankruptcy, destroy our credit cards, downsize, and alter our lifestyle to achieve it. But what about the debt we owe in the Kingdom of God? The one in *Romans 13:8*, that says, *'owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.* What is our love credit rating in the Kingdom of God credit? Now, let's do the work....





The entire mission was and is all about LOVE,
God's LOVE for us.

I believe that those who do not know
the Lord Jesus Christ as their
personal Savior and Lord, and maybe
some who do - still have not known
God's love!

For centuries individuals have done
all types of things to acquire love, but
love does not need you to work for it!
Not the kind of love I am referencing.
**We cannot buy this love! But this love is
available to you all the time.**



You do not have to perform for this love or be perfect for this love. This type of love loved you before you knew it.

This type of love loved you before you knew it," is deeply rooted in the Biblical concept of God's unconditional love. Ephesians 2:4-5 supports this beautifully:

"But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved."

This passage emphasizes that God's love and salvation are not contingent upon our actions or perfection; rather, they are gifts freely given, even before we are aware of them. It highlights the grace and unconditional nature of God's love, affirming that it precedes our own knowledge or acceptance of it.



This kind of love impacted the Prophetess Anna found in Luke 2:36 – 38. “Now there was one, Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of a great age, and had lived with a husband seven years from her virginity; and this woman was a widow of about eighty- four years, who did not depart from the temple, but served God with fastings and prayers night and day. And coming in that instant she gave thanks to the Lord and spoke of Him to all those who looked for redemption in Jerusalem.”

Luke 2:36-38

The prophetess, Anna interceded and prayed at a level of devotion that can only be born out of love and pure intimacy with the Lord.



I am talking about God's love. The agape' love.
The unconditional love of God.

This is the love I want to demonstrate in my own life and this is the love we need in ministry and the world. Can you imagine the power of this type of demonstrated love? It would be the answer and witness of John 13:35, which says, "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." This verse is a direct command from Jesus to His followers, emphasizing love as the defining characteristic of Christian discipleship. It underscores the importance of love among believers as a testimony to the world of our relationship with Christ.



In 1 Corinthians 14:1, we are exhorted to prioritize love above all else, while also being encouraged to earnestly seek spiritual gifts, particularly prophecy. This passage underscores the supreme importance of love as the foundation of Christian life and ministry, emphasizing that spiritual gifts should be pursued not for personal edification but for the edification of the church and to foster a deeper communal bond in love. It highlights the balance between pursuing the spiritual empowerment for service and ensuring that love remains the central motivating force behind all spiritual endeavors.

To pursue means to follow or go after quickly with the intention of laying hold of.

Can you imagine if we were able to press toward this mark, and move in every area of our lives intentionally with the love of God as the motivator?



How do you think the world would be different?
What would relationships look like? What would
everything look like.

It is my invitation to ask each of us to pray from
the position of God's transforming love. If we
can remember how His love has transformed us
when others thought we would never make it,
there is the knowing hope that God will do it for
others too, as we pray!

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That you and I will always remember it was love that truly did lift us, and we are now able to operate from that same love to lift others, serve others and serve our God.

And, I am not talking about love that permits sin, but a love so powerful it can make each of us desire to live victoriously and faithfully before God.

Did you know that from the beginning it has always been about LOVE? I am certain you do!

John 3:16 shows the truth of the above statement: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

The transformation of love is recorded in John 1:1-5 – In the beginning was the Word and the





Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

According to Scripture God gave His only begotten Son, because He loved us.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. John 3:16

According to Scripture "God is love" "He who does not love does not know God, for God is love." 1 John 4:8



We have to pray in faith and love, it's a principle!
“. . .but faith working through love.” Galatians
5:6b

In Scripture, love is portrayed as the foundational principle that powers and directs the life of a believer in various aspects. Here are key aspects that are influenced or work by love according to biblical teachings:

Faith: Galatians 5:6 mentions that in Christ, the only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love.

Spiritual Gifts: 1 Corinthians 13 emphasizes that spiritual gifts must be exercised in love to be effective and meaningful.



Obedience to God: John 14:15 and 1 John 5:3 highlight that love for God is demonstrated through keeping His commands.

Relationships with Others: John 13:34-35 commands believers to love one another as a testament to their discipleship.

Moral and Ethical Behavior: Romans 13:8-10 discusses how love fulfills the law by guiding us to act rightly towards our neighbors.



These references collectively show that love is not just an emotion but an active force that drives faith, spiritual service, obedience, relationships, and ethical conduct in the life of a believer.

Love is one of the key identifiers for followers of Jesus Christ: “A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.” 1 John 13:34-35

God’s complete motivation for our redemption was driven by His love for us.

WHO DO WE PRAY TO?



We pray to our Heavenly Father, and we pray in
Jesus' name because

He is our High Priest and we have access!

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest
who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the
Son of

God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do
not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize
with our weaknesses, but was in all points
tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us
therefore come boldly to the throne of grace,
that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help
in time of need.

Hebrews 4:13-16

WHY DO WE PRAY?

We pray because we have been commanded to:

Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, 2 saying: "There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. 3 Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.' 4 And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man, 5 yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.'" 6 Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said. 7 And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? 8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily.



Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?" Luke 18:1-8

This woman in Luke 18 did not stop petitioning the judge, and we must continue to go to God in prayer on behalf of others and ourselves. The prayers of the righteous will always make a difference!!

Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

We pray because God hears and answers us!





The following Old Testament and New Testament Scriptures testify to this truth:

Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear. Isaiah 65:24

Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known. Jeremiah 33:3

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.



John 15:7 “And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that if we ask anything according to his will he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests that we have asked of Him.” 1 John 5:14-15

I believe it is important to pray the Word of God,
no, not just important but mandatory because of
this Scripture:

So, shall My word be that goes forth from My
mouth; it shall not return to

Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and
it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.
Isaiah 55:11

God's Word will not return to Him void. The Word
of God will always agree with God and the answer
is always 'yes and amen'.

It is important to always search our own hearts
before the Lord first and if confession is necessary
to let God forgive and cleanse us. God has
promised this:



31 “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9

It is also important to pray in the Holy Spirit: “But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.” Jude 20-21

When we pray in the Holy Spirit we keep ourselves in the love of God!



WHEN SHOULD WE PRAY? “praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.”

Ephesians 6:18 “Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, . . .”

Luke 18:1 “desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting; . . .” 1 Timothy 2:8



I am not talking about 'sappy' love.

I am talking about the kind of love that ends in obedience even in the worst of circumstances.

I am talking about the kind of love that will keep you, strengthen you, purify you and completely cause you to surrender to the One Who gave

His life for yours.

The Garden of Gethsemane is a wonderful picture of love driven prayer. Not only that, but we are witnesses who see it demonstrated by the greatest Intercessor Who has ever lived – JESUS!



THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

“The Garden of Jude 20-21

Because of God’s grace, you and I are given a sacred audience to the transformation of God. In this passage of Scripture God voluntarily wraps His deity in the form of man in Christ Jesus, and all of this because of His great love for us.

Jesus is fully God and fully man!

His love is affirmed in John 3:15 and provides the missive of Jesus’ journey to earth. “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever would believe on Him would not perish but have everlasting life.”



Can you see this? Can you see that

LOVE was always the reason?

God's intention beginning in the book of Genesis, in the Garden of Eden was that You and I would always be in a loving and righteous relationship with Him.

After the fall of Adam and Eve in the garden, God did not change His intentions toward us as written in

Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.” These bears witness to the truth that God keeps loving us and demonstrated it in His provision of reconciliation and redemption through Jesus Christ.





Through it all LOVE remained faithful to the mission. “And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.” 1
Corinthians 13:13

I love the word ‘abide’. Abide means to remain, to be sure, to be firmly in place, to dwell. Love will remain and of all the threefold; faith, hope and love – LOVE is the greatest!!

Again, it has always been about love!

And so, it is with us, when we pray we need to follow the standard of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in the Garden of Gethsemane by allowing our prayer to be ‘love driven’.

42 “Love will always remain faithful To God’s mission and assignment.” drcpgivens



Love's absence from our prayers makes them unfruitful. 1 Corinthians 13:1-3 – "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal!" • Prayer without love is performance, it is a religious discipline absent true relationship vertically and horizontally).

- Prayer without love is the evidence of disconnection from the Vine.

In John 15:10 – Jesus says, “I am the true vine and My Father is the vinedresser. Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

What fruit? The fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22-26 – “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self- control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the faithfulness, gentleness, self- control.

Spirit. Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

Then in John 15:3-9, Jesus continues, by saying, "You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.



If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. “As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

Abide in My love, there is such fruitfulness in remaining Jesus’ love and that same fruitfulness is made manifest when our prayers are ‘love driven’.

The selflessness of LOVE praying in the Garden. When you and I pray, we have the example of LOVE praying in the Garden. Praying for



God's perfect will, and sacrificing the possibility of being able to do it in a less painful way. When we pray love must be the leading motivation.

We have to pray with love as the motivator or we will tire in our pursuit to see the nations, regions, cities, families, individuals come to the saving knowledge and fullness of salvation. Remember, LOVE never fails!

If you and I can remember nothing else, this is the most important.

Jesus' entire mission was because of love. The love of God for His creation. His example in the Garden of Gethsemane through prayer was because of love. His intercession for us is because of love!



Jesus lived a life of love, and is still praying for us from the position of love.

Read Hebrews 7:25 below: “And inasmuch as He was not made priest without an oath (for they have become priests without an oath, but He with an oath by Him who said to Him: “The LORD has sworn and will not relent, ‘You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek’”), by so much more

Jesus has become a surety of a better covenant. Also, there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing. But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable Priesthood. Therefore, He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.



As you can see in Hebrews 7:25,

Jesus is still praying for us because of His love of God and the love He has for His bride!

In closing, I repeat Ephesians 5:1 – “Therefore be imitators of God as dear children And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given

Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

Father, we each come to You and ask that You would continue to reveal Your magnificent love, Your indescribable love, Your love that is irresistible, so we may become Your love manifested in everything we do!



May this Scripture be alive in us as we pray. Every day may we let our prayers be love driven.
