GRID FUNDRAISER

A grid fundraiser, also known as a "grid raffle" or "sweepstake board," is a simple and engaging fundraising concept. The basic idea involves creating a grid of squares, each of which is sold to participants for a fixed price. Once all the squares are sold, a random drawing is held to determine the winner, who receives a prize.

Here's a step-by-step explanation of how a grid fundraiser typically works:

1. Determine Prize (cash from ticket sales or a donated prize)
2. Create the Grid
3. Set the Price per Square
4. Promote and Sell Squares
5. Fill the Grid
6. Hold the Drawing
7. Announce the Winner



WINE SURVIVOR

Here's a step-by-step explanation of how an online wine survivor fundraiser typically works:

1. Choose an online platform (Facebook works well)

4. Assign each participant a unique identifier or number
5. Schedule elimination rounds where participants are randomly drawn, and those selected are eliminated from the competition.

TRIVIA NIGHT

Here's how a 50-50 fundraiser typically works:

1. Decide on the date, time, and venue for the 50-50 fundraiser (it is easiest to incorporate it into an existing event)
2. Buy or create and print tickets to be sold at the event
3. Set Ticket Prices and packages
4. Promote the Fundraiser
5. Sell Tickets until predetermined time
6. Determine cash prize (1/2 of proceeds from ticket sales)
7. Draw the Winning Ticket by random draw
8. Name the winner and award cash prize

BAKE SALE

A bake sale fundraiser is not only an effective way to raise funds but also an opportunity to bring the community together to contribute to a meaningful cause.

Here's how a bake sale typically works:

1. Determine the date, time, and location for the event
2. Assemble a team of volunteers to help organize and run the bake sale
3. Collect donations of baked goods
4. Package and price baked goods
5. Set up the sale area in a high-traffic location
6. Promote the bake sale
7. Run the bake sale and accept payments
