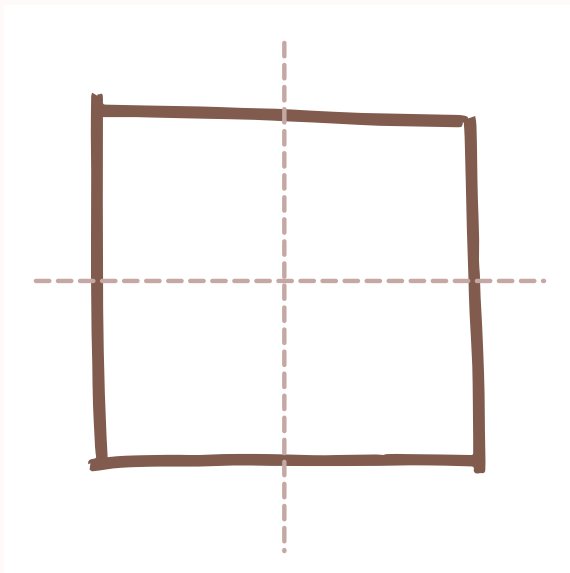
CHOOSE YOUR LAYOUT

STEP 01 KNOW YOUR DIMENSIONS


What you need:

- Tape measurer
- Painters tape (*tape it out*)
- Boxes
- Graph paper (*one square = one foot*)

STEP 02 FIND YOUR BALANCE:



- Draw a box.
- **Balance lines** are lines that intersect in the middle on the room vertically and horizontally, leaving 4 quadrants.



Balance = weight
(Furniture, materials,
and details)

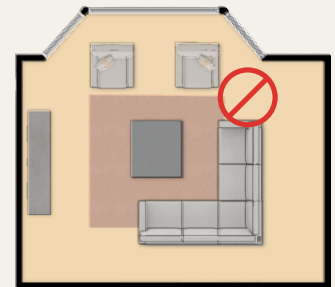
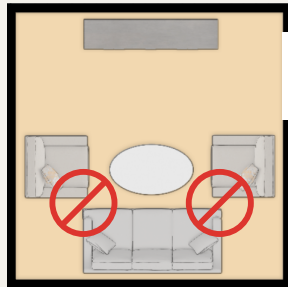
L-shaped
